Contra Costa/Solano Food Bank donations will be made in the Cobra Experience Museum parking lot. **Please Arrive By 9:30am!** Address is [777 Arnold Drive, Martinez, CA](http://www.777ArnoldDrive.com).

Signage will be set up to designate the food drop-off location. Drive up to the U-Haul truck, (first entrance on the right side of the parking lot) stay in your vehicle (if possible) and open your trunk.

Volunteers with gloves and masks will remove the food (please have in a cardboard box or equivalent container). Food barrels will be available if needed.

From the North:

THE ROAD TRIP


Once food is donated, follow the signage around the parking lot and park your vehicle on the side closest to the train tracks.

Three lead vehicles for the drive are:

- 2020 Blue Shelby GT350
- 2013 Grabber Blue Boss 302
- 2016 Shelby GT-H

DIRECTIONS

- Please arrive by 9:30am for food drop off
 - Depart the Cobra Experience at 10:30am
 - **Right** onto Arnold Drive from the Museum exit
 - **Left** on Howe Avenue
 - **Left** onto Center Ave.
 - Immediate **Right** to 4 West - stay in on/off lane
 - **Left** on Alhambra Ave
 - **Right** on Alhambra Valley Road
 - At the "T" **Right** turn (Alhambra Valley Road continues to the right)
 - **Left** on Bear Creek Road
 - **Left** on Camino Pablo, turns into Moraga Way
 - Follow Moraga Way until it ends
 - **Right** on Canyon Rd.
 - **Left** on Pinehurst Road
 - **Right** on Redwood Road
 - End of trail Hwy 13
- At this point you we have reached the end of the group drive. Stay happy and healthy!
