## **DVMA Member's Mustangs**

Nicole Melton, DVMA's webmaster extraordinaire, is the proud owner of two Mustangs, which are exactly 40 years apart in age. In April of 2002, at age 16, Nicole's received her 1967 coupe from her grandmother, Reba, who had ordered it new in July 1967. She selected the options for Lime Gold paint, white vinyl top, Ivy Gold interior, 289 A-code engine, automatic transmission, upper and lower consoles, and air conditioning. Grandma Reba had worked in Macy's hat department, and saved up the money to buy the car herself, which she was very proud of. She was a bit of a hot rodder, and took out the A/C in 1972 because "it slowed the car down too much." She also swapped out the Autolite four barrel carb for a more tuneable Holley. She drove it to Reno often, and <u>REBA'S\_1967 MVSTAN</u>

had a mechanic teach her how to adjust the carburetor mixture for higher altitude driving.



When Nicole got the car, she had to promise Reba that she wouldn't sell it, and would get her approval for any modifications. Nicole drove the Mustang throughout High School and College, and then decided to refurbish it in 2008-2009. Grandma approved modifications include Hooker headers and a Magnaflow exhaust, front disc brakes, Pioneer stereo in the glovebox, trunk-mounted subwoofer, and a race-prepped AOD 4 speed transmission. Outside, a Shelby-style fiberglass hood, plus front and rear spoilers were added, and the chrome parts were powdercoated pearl white before Nicole did the bodywork and painted it herself in

Ford Vista Blue with Cadillac White Pearl stripes. This Mustang has a special license plate: VLG 389. Reba always said it stood for "Very Lucky Girl" and that 389 was the horsepower she wished it had. That wish might actually come true, since Nicole has a hot 302 crate engine in the garage, waiting patiently to be installed.



In 2014, Nicole spent six months looking for a very specific stablemate for her 1967 coupe, one that was 40 years younger. She found a Windveil Blue Metallic 2007 convertible with a tan interior and top, 4.6 V8, and an automatic transmission. She has since redone the seats in all leather, had the trans rebuilt to race specs, plus added a cold air intake and an aftermarket stereo. Both Mustangs have been to the drag strip, currently running in the 15 second range. With these two Mustangs at home, Nicole is one Very Lucky Girl indeed.

# Coffee & Clutches in Antioch, Feb 6

The six year anniversary of Coffee & Clutches in the Starbucks parking lot in Antioch was filled with hundreds of cool cars. Everything from old trucks to Lamborghinis were represented, including quite a few Mustangs. There were so many cars that they spilled out into the rest of the parking lot, stretching from the Bed Bath and Beyond at one end, to Panda Express at the other. Regular shoppers must have been stunned by all the classic, sports and exotic cars taking over the whole lot.



Here we have a few examples of the Mustangs on display. First is a mean-looking supercharged notchback Fox body, sporting some wide drag radials on the back. In the center is my friend John's recently rebuilt 390 in his '68 GT coupe. The car is a primered work in progress, but the drivetrain is definitely sorted out, with a fuel injected FE and a Tremec 5 speed. On the right is a beautiful restomod '69 sportsroof, with a custom-made red shock tower reinforcing brace and windsor-based 427 power.



Next up are a pair of CA black plate convertibles: a '65 GT with LeMans stripes and yellow fog lights added, and a '67 in Brittany Blue with an immaculate two-tone blue interior. Next is this menacing '69 Cougar Eliminator, sporting DVMA show sponsor <u>Bill Brandt Ford</u> license plate frames. How cool is that?

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm by Harry Davis, President.


