The featured Mustang for May is this beautiful 2010 Shelby GT500 driven by Bobby Hubbell and Lisi Dennis. Finished in Shadow Black with silver stripes over a matching interior, this pony packs a powerful punch with a factory supercharged 5.4 liter V8 and a Tremec 6 speed transmission. In addition to the stock 540 horsepower, Bobby has added exhaust cutouts and a BAMA Performance tune, plus an upgraded MGW shifter and JLT oil separators.



Having owned both '69 and '89 Mustangs in the past, Bobby was looking everywhere for just the right car when he found this black beauty on the internet in 2017. It was located in Greenville, Illinois and had only 8925 miles on it. When the selling dealer dropped the price he pulled the trigger, and the car was his. Unlike the first owner, Bobby got this car to have fun and drive. And, drive it he does - it now has 26,365 miles on the clock and counting. Allegedly, there might have even been a time when Lisi had to remind him that the speed limit was not 120. Once, when they had stopped at Tower Park in Lodi for lunch, they came out to find two other Shelbys parked right next to them. It was an impromptu mini Shelby car show!

Did we mention this is an award-winning Mustang? Two trophies from DVMA shows and one from the Ponies & Snakes show in Danville attest to the amazing shape that this car is in. Just like the license plate says: it's a 10!
