

## **DVMA Member's Mustangs**

Ron Hait is a car guy. And he isn't one of those, "I'd rather walk than drive a \_\_\_\_\_\_" type of car guy. He's owned cars from Alfa Romeo, Porsche, and Mercedes Benz, among others, and he currently owns a red Dodge, a white Chevy, and a blue Ford - how's that for a slice of Americana?



Ron was a DVMA member back in 2003 when he had an '03 Mustang Cobra, and he's a DVMA member again now with his recently purchased 1966 modified coupe. Ron's Nightmist Blue coupe underwent a rotisserie restoration in 2017 at a Mustang specialty shop in Georgia, including the installation of a roller 302 V8, a TKO 5 speed, and a 3.55 geared rear differential. Keeping with the restomod theme of the drivetrain, a hood scoop, custom "Powered by Ford" side stripes, and a

front spoiler were added, and the engine bay was also painted blue. Borgeson power steering and Wilwood disc brakes add safety, and 17" reproductions of 1969 Shelby wheels wrapped in Falken RT660 tires round out the beautiful exterior. If you didn't notice the second set of exhaust pipes on the sides of the car, you will definitely hear them whenever Ron opens the cutouts!

Inside, Ron and his co-pilot Roma ride in a mostly stock parchment interior, augmented with a modern, large-screen stereo system that features a subwoofer and backup camera. Roma has a little booster seat for herself so she can look out the window while she rides along. If you've ever seen her in the car, then you know what a ridiculously cute scene it is.



everywhere, and recently updated the front suspension with tubular control arms and Viking double-adjustable shocks. As often happens with these things, the desire to fix a small 'clunk' in the front end turned into a full suspension upgrade. Now his pony is ready to put even more miles on the clock, attending local car shows and events in style. Ron and Roma are regulars at DVMA events, so come check out his beautiful pony and say hello to the two of them.

## For Sale 2007 Shelby GT500




