This year Mustang Club of America's Grand National Car Show was held in—wait for it—Mustang, OK! How fitting is that? It's actually a suburb of Oklahoma City, and the Oklahoma Mustang Club really did this event up right. They had "all the bases covered", as they say. The very hot and humid weather was countered with easy-access air-conditioned buildings, free ice-cold water and lots of shade trees. The event was held in the parking lot of their community events center and all the amenities were available there. My husband, John Haugrud, is a gold card judge for MCA for 1969-1970 Mustang 429, 351 and 302's and attends several shows a year to keep up his certification. There are teams of judges for all the many different classes and John's team spent at least 2 hours on each of the 7 or 8 cars in their particular class.



It's hot work and these guys go over everything in, on and under the cars in these high-level categories— Concourse trailered, and Concourse driven—with a fine-toothed comb. John decided to test out the readiness and efficiency of the paramedic team on site when he was underneath one of the cars and developed a "gullywasher" of a nosebleed. He had a mask on and he described "filling up my whole mask with blood". The paramedics quickly decided he would survive without any treatment other than administering a couple of sniffs of Afrin nose spray—a decongestant that constricts the blood vessels, which totally stopped the bleeding. Who knew?



John describes the various entries on the show field as being "the best of the best" and many spectators were snapping pictures of the cars that resembled their own so they would have an image of what theirs ought to look like when they'd finished their own restoration.
