



MCA Day at Mecum Monterey, Aug 19

13 DVMA members and three of their Mustangs joined up with our Mustang Club of America rep Robin Pausell and members of local Mustang clubs for MCA Day at the Mecum Monterey auction on August 19. The day's activities included a caravan from Contra Costa to the event site at the Del Monte Golf Course, with a stop in Gilroy to meet up with members from other MCA Mustang clubs. A carload of DVMA members joined us at Gilroy in happy coincidence.

Mecum Monterey is part of the larger Monterey Car Week, a decades-old event that includes racing, a concours or two, and the auctions. Upon arrival at the venue, Mecum Auctions provided us with a docent-led tour of the action at hand with a detailed explanation of the collector car auction business. Approximately 800 cars were on sale over the three days of the auction, and plenty of living examples were crossing the block to augment the docent's narrative.

After the docent tour it was off to the auction hall for the "bidwhattawhatta-fiftygrand-whattawhatta" and roaming the grounds to view the cars in the field. Lots of opportunity to get close up with the individual cars lining up for the auction block, and the arranged displays of car collections such as English sports cars, 1960s Ferraris, and the popular pre-war Ultra Luxe Packard-Duesenburg-Cadillac-Lincoln-Rolls. DVMA Member's Mustangs

I am a retired Mechanical Engineer and have always enjoyed working on classic cars. My wife and I have owned classic mustangs for a very long time. Our first mustang was a 1965, springtime yellow, 289 V8, 3-speed, convertible that we bought over 20 years ago.



When I retired in 2015, we sold that mustang to my brother-in-law since we planned to move and would no longer have a large 3-car garage. However, we soon realized that we missed the warm summer evening rides down Main St. in Walnut Creek. So, we tried to buy the Mustang back, but my brother-in-law would not sell.

We both wanted another 1965 so we started looking around and eventually found our current '65 on-line. My wife specifically wanted an automatic this time and the bright rangoon red was the deal maker. The mustang was one car out of a collection of many classic cars being sold off in Wichita, KS and I was able to negotiate the purchase over the phone. We did a lot of field verification, went through a VIN number decoding, and received video tapes of the mustang. We then

contracted to have the car transported to us in Pleasant Hill. It took about a week to get it here and the neighborhood was in awe when the large car carrier came rolling down our small neighborhood street. Only 3 days after receiving the car, we were already showing it at the Shadelands Classic Car Show in Walnut Creek. Shortly after the purchase we joined DVMA and the Mustang Club of America.

Our mustang is an early 1965 convertible, rangoon red, 200 cubic inch six cylinder, automatic, and was manufactured in Kansas City with a build date of August 4, 1964. It was also optioned with factory air conditioning, power steering, and the deluxe "Pony" interior. It had apparently spent all it's time in and around Wichita and there is a sticker in the windshield identifying it as a "Wichita Wheels Featured Car".

I needed the car registered in California, and when I went to the DMV, I was given standard white plates with blue lettering. However, I wanted the classic California look so I used the new California DMV Year of Manufacture (YOM) license plate program, bought unregistered 1963 stamped vintage black and gold plates, and had them registered to the

vintage black and gold plates, and had them registered to the car. It was a fairly simple process.

I am 6'7" and classic mustangs have substantial leg room and head room. You can also modify the seat track rail system, like I did, and add even more leg room. Replacing the standard steering wheel with a slightly smaller wheel, also helps.

Winter weather usually keeps the mustang under cover in the garage, but once Spring comes, we spend a great deal of time enjoying driving it, especially those warm summer evenings still cruising down Main St.






DVMA Car Show Donations Needed




