DVMA MEMBERS “SCAVENGE” FOR A GOOD TIME

Three teams from DVMA entered the online Mustang Owner’s Museum Scavenger Hunt that took place in May. Here’s a writeup about their experience by Dwight Moreland.

“It was fun. I believe there were only three teams of two from DVMA; Barbara & Dwight, Lisi & Bobby and Nicole & Matthew. There were over 400 teams registered of which 32 were outside the country. [How cool!]

Of the 20 items on the Scavenger Hunt list, 6 required pictures of Mustangs from the 6 generations starting with the 1964 1/2 up thru 2020. Another 8 items were various colors. If you found those 8 colors on a Ford or Mustang you got extra points. The remaining 6 items were not Ford, Mustang related.

The Scavenger Hunt started with Lisi and Bobby stopping by our house. They needed a picture of a 2017 (2015-2020) and we needed a picture of a 2010 (2005-2015—check those off). The rules of the Scavenger Hunt also required a “team Picture”. So we took a picture of Lisi and Bobby by their 2010 and they returned the favor for us. Lisi and Bobby went their way and I headed our our way. Barbara was dismayed and disappointed to learn that I do not know what each Mustang looks like in each of the 6 generations. I needed to use the DVMA roster to find 6 cars from each of the generations.

First stop, Sharon and Joe Dearing’s for pictures of Joe’s 2003 Roush (1994-2004—check that off) and Sharon’s RS (color WHITE-and a Mustang-and EXTRA POINTS—check that off).

Next up, Ed Guldner for a picture of his 1965 (1964 1/2-1973—check that off) and what a beauty it is! Boy does Ed have Mustangs, 4 to be exact! We’re on a roll! 4 out of 5 Mustang gens checked off.

Then onto Harry and Karen Davis’ (sorry we missed you) for Harry’s 1985 SVO (1979-1993—check that off) and color BLUE and a MUSTANG for EXTRA POINTS)

After only an hour we had 5 of 6 Mustang gens with 2 of 8 photos.

After 2 hours we headed to the barn...it was starting to rain! The Hunt was completed. We had checked off 18 out of 20 items on the list. Missing only the color Orange and a 1974-1978 Mustang, But who counts a picture of a Mustang II anyway?!
