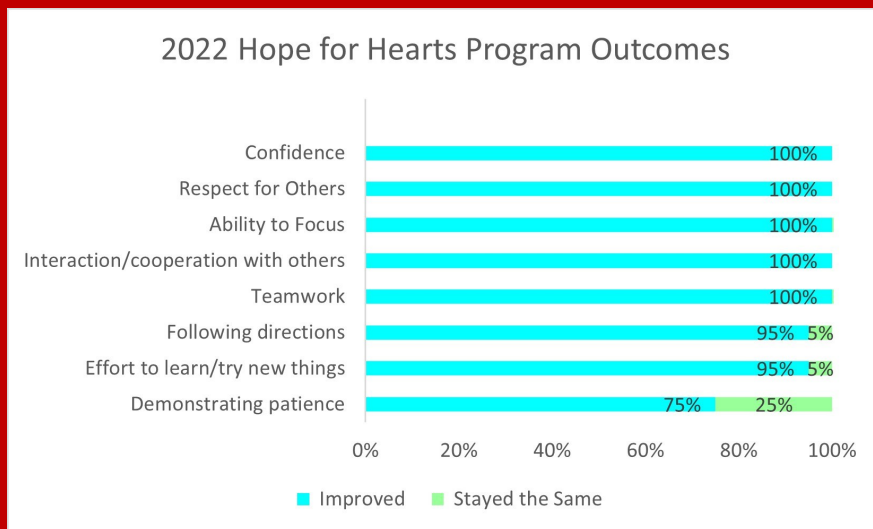

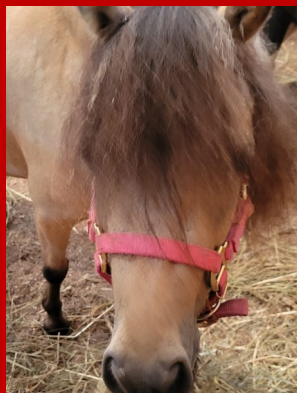

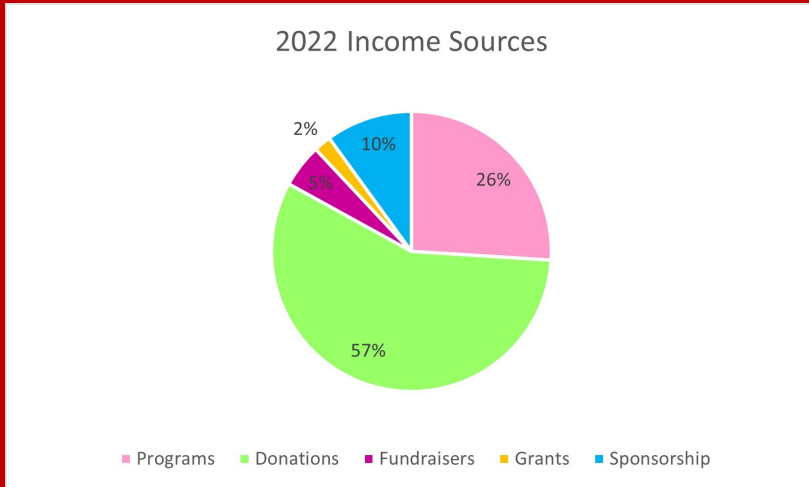


Strategic Initiatives

Part of becoming a TeachingHorse facilitator was the opportunity to observe wild horse herds for 3 days. Such incredible insights that were brought back to incorporate into our programs.

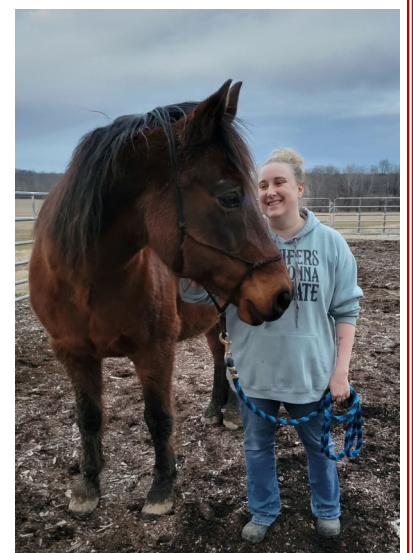
"When I plan ahead and am organized things go much smoother and it is a lot less stressful."

"The horses have shown me that I am a good leader, I never thought of myself that way."



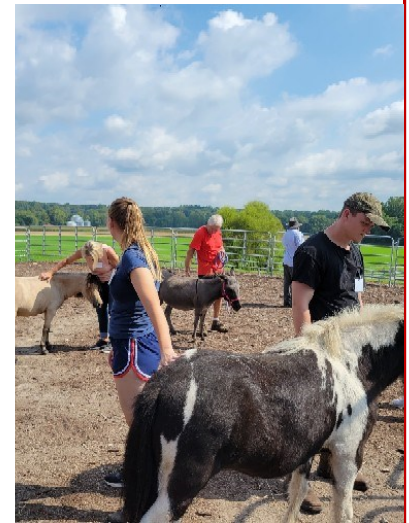

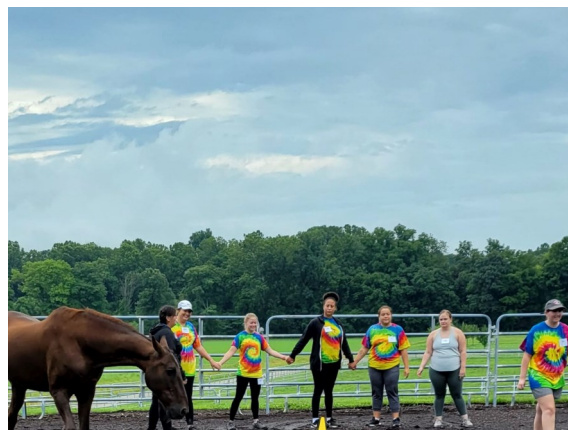
