In order for our neighborhood to maintain its quality visual

appeal and high property values proper exterior home maintenance is essential. It's also important that homeowners complete exterior home repairs in a timely manner and in accordance with Abbotsford's Declarations of Restrictions. Applications for Architectural Review must be submitted for ALL EXTERIOR CHANGES or ADDITIONS to homes. **This includes, but is not limited to new roofs, decks, rebuilding of existing decks, new windows, new doors, all exterior painting, fences, patios, and modifications to front steps.** If you are unsure if approval is needed for your modification, please email the Board of Directors.
