Part 1**Hours of Operation and Permissible Use****§16-101. Hours of Operation.**

The Hunker Borough Community Park, Playground and Parklet and adjoining parking areas shall encompass and include the area of the Borough bounded by Bridge Street, Constitution Avenue and Olive Street, and it shall be unlawful for any person to be or remain in or upon the area within the Borough as bounded and described from dusk to dawn.

§16-102. Permits.

The provisions of this Part shall not apply to any person who is occupying the said property or premises pursuant to a permit issued through the Borough Council of the Borough of Hunker, County of Westmoreland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for activities within the provisions of a valid permit.

§16-103. Parents Responsible for Conduct of Children.

It is hereby made unlawful for any parent, guardian or legal custodian of any such person to allow or permit any such child, ward or other person under age 11 while in such legal custody to go or be upon the premises of the Hunker Community Park, Playground or Parklet and adjoining parking areas or within the said area bounded by Bridge Street, Constitution Avenue and Olive Street during the time permitted in §16-101 of this Part, unless exempt as provided under a permit.

§16-104. Curfew Violation Penalty.

Any child as above designated found within the designated area as set forth in §16-101 of this Part shall be taken into custody and delivered to his parents, guardian or legal custodian and a report thereof shall be made to the Mayor, who shall keep a record of the same. If the parents, guardian or legal custodian of any such child shall again permit such child to violate §16-101 of this Part, such parents, guardian or legal custodian shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.

§16-105. Trespass Violation Penalty.

Any person entering the designated premises in violation of §16-101 of this Part from dusk to dawn and any person remaining on the premises after being ordered to leave by an authorized representative of the Hunker Borough Council is hereby

declared to be trespasser and is guilty of a summary offense and upon arrest and conviction shall be sentenced to a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
