

New Steps in 2025



We are positioned to maintain our community impact in 2025! We continue our strategic plan in supporting immediate short-term community outreach efforts while building capital for our long-term vision.

Short-term efforts include continued support of local homeless shelters for men, women, and children in the Essex County NJ and Baltimore, MD areas. We are also increasing support of local families based on individualized needs. We will continue our partnerships and drives for organized community outreach efforts to include but not limited to toiletry drives, flip flop/shower shoes and towel drives, coat drives, and other support for shelters/families in need. We will continue to building more connectivity with Kym Konsulting, the City of Newark Homeless Coalition, University High School, Community Assistance Network (CAN), and Hope Village.

From a longer-term vision standpoint, we will also aggressively research affordable housing solutions and the overall HUD housing voucher program. Our goal is to build capital and research grant funding in preparation for purchasing land and breaking ground on an affordable home structure.

We are excited about the possibilities that lie ahead and look forward to your continued support to make our initiatives a success.
