Pool Renovations



Extensive and much-needed work to bring the pool back online has begun. The target reopening is the end of March, but due to the scale of the work, timelines may shift.

The priority is completing the renovation effectively, whilst managing the current cost pressures felt by the village.

All required pool licensing processes have been completed this month, so the legal requirements associated with operating the pool have been addressed.

VRV Air Conditioning
