If you do not have your backflow device tested by a certified tester you are now subject to a **\$250 fine and termination of water service.**

Total water pumped: 446,036,950 gallons

This summer the District will continue to replace old water meters and move meters out of basements to the property line. This will assist in locating additional leakage on individual properties.

Orchard Avenue's source meters were replaced during 2020, saving an estimated 16,816,834 gallons of water.

How You Can Help Save Water

- Listen for the sound of running water in unlikely areas.
- Fix any dripping faucets or leaking connections.
- Fixing running toilets can prevent a water loss of up to 10 gallons per minute.
- Check and maintain your sprinkler system regularly! Damaged lines can lead to extensive water loss.
- Please report any continual pooled water to the district office at 509-926-4563.

Winter Weather Tips

- Remove all hoses from outside faucets.
- Insulate your water meter properly.
- Check for leaks after any thaw.
- If it's extremely cold, trickling water (just beyond a drip) will help prevent your pipes from freezing.

Sprinkler System Users

Per Washington State law

Sprinkler systems must be installed with an approved device that keeps hazardous herbicides and pesticides from back-siphoning into your water supply. Orchard Avenue sends out an annual letter in the spring reminding our patrons to have their devices tested. Our website has a tab dedicated to backflow and cross-connection information.

Meter Reading

Water meter reading begins in the first week of August. If you have a basement meter and you are not home when the meter reader stops by, you are required to submit your reading by phone or through our website.

Summer Water Conservation Ideas

- Evenings or early mornings are the best times to water.
- Instead of sprinkling daily, deep soak your lawn twice a week.
- Don't run the hose continuously while washing vehicles.
- Sweep driveways and walkways instead of hosing.
- Be creative! Our website has a lot of great conservation tips and activates. You can also stop by our office to pick up FREE conservation information.

Fire Hydrants

If a fire hydrant is located on your property please keep it clean and accessible.

Hydrants are for fire protection only! Please report any unauthorized use to the District Office.

Orchard Avenue has a fill station available on a permit basis. Unauthorized use of a hydrant will lead to a **\$1,000 fine for the first offense and \$2,000 for the second.**
