

Definitions of Palgwes

Palgwe is descriptive of a world made up of elements both conflicting and harmonious. Examples are sky and earth, light and dark, man and woman, good and evil. These elements meet and depart from one another according to the rules of nature, thus everlasting growing and developing.

Palgwe II Jang 1 (Heaven) Means the "heaven and yang". as the Keon symbolizes the beginning of the creation of all the things in the universe.

Palgwe Ea Jang 2 (Lake) Which signifies the inner firmness and the outer softness.

Palgwe Sam Jang 3 (Fire) Hot and bright. This is to encourage the trainee to harbor a sense of justice and ardor for training.

Palgwe Sa Jang 4 (Thunder) Represents the thunder meaning great power and dignity.

Palgwe Oh Jang 5 (Wind) Represents the wind, meaning both mighty force and calmness according to its strength and weakness.

Palgwe Yuk Jang 6 (Water) Represents Water, meaning incessant flow and softness.

Palgwe Chil Jang 7 (Mountains) Represents the mountain meaning ponder and firmness.

Palgwe Pal Jang 8 (Earth) Represents Earth Yin and earth meaning the root and settlement and also the beginning and the end.
