This scholarship is intended to support tuition needs of furthering one's higher education/schooling in one of three areas: the trades, college/university studies or continuing martial arts studies.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Current resident of Iowa or a student of a Jung's Academy branch school
2. Ranked as 1st Dan (or higher) Black Belt
3. Active in taekwondo by way of attending/instructing at dojang
4. Recommended by individual's Master Instructor (see signature line below)
5. Participant in at least 1 Iowa based Taekwondo tournament within the previous calendar year (preference will be given to those students who attend the Grinnell & English Valleys TKD Tournament)

Applications with completed essay questions, photo AND one letter of recommendation (excludes the individual's master instructor or family member) must be delivered by February 25th, 2019 to our South English address.

Scholarship winners will be selected from the Pilsung Scholarship Committee and announced at the 5th Annual Grinnell & English Valleys Taekwondo Tournament, March 2nd, 2019.
