## **Frequently Asked Questions**

Q: How much will this camp cost?

A: \$0 to students. Registered camp students cost are covered by generous grants and sponsorships.

Q: What can I expect at drone day camp?

A: You'll have the opportunity to learn about many of the exciting way drones are being used and you'll even get to fly a few drones.

Q: Do I need to be registered to attend?

A: Yes, we have very limited spots and space available. You will receive an official camp schedule and location information when your registration is accepted.

Q: Do I need to bring a drone?

A: No. There will be several drone demonstrations where you will have the opportunity to fly.

Q: What are camp hours?

A: Camp will start promptly at 9am - 3pm each day. Please arrive by 8:30am.

Q: Should I attend both days?

A: Yes, you are highly encouraged to attend both days to get the most out of camp.

Q: Will food be provided?

A: Yes, lunch and beverages will be provided. If you have specific food needs, you may bring your own food.

Q: Can I bring a parent or support person?

A: Yes. You may bring 1 support person to help you make the most out of your experience.

Q: Will breaks be provided?

A: Yes. There are many opportunities for breaks, as well as a separate quiet space.

Q: Is transportation provided?

A: No. Each student is required to secure their own transportation to and from camp.
