Rental Alcohol Service Requirements & Agreement

For rentals serving or selling alcohol, the renter requires the following:

If you would like to serve or consume alcohol during your rental, you (or someone in attendance) must have the following prepared prior to your rental:

1. Special Event Permit
2. Serving it Right Certification
3. First-Aid Certification
4. Safety Plan (How you will prevent underage drinking, ensure no one is driving under the influence, who will respond in an emergency, conflict resolution etc.)

1. Special Event Permit:

- At least one month prior to your rental, apply for your Special Event Permit (SEP)

- Once SEP has been approved, send a copy to OCA

2. Serving it Right (SIR) Certification:

- Anyone who will be serving/selling alcohol must have their SIR
- Anyone who will be serving/selling alcohol must have a copy of their SIR certification on display during the rental
