General Information/Criteria:

- The Military Spouses' Society of Virginia (MSSofVA) awards scholarships to high school senior dependents of first responders and military members who satisfy the eligibility criteria specified below. Scholarships are awarded in accordance with the MSSofVA Scholarship Committee Guidelines.
- Selection criteria may include all or some of the following:
 - 1. Academic Achievement
 - 2. Work Experience
 - 3. Community/Volunteer Activities
 - 4. Leadership Roles
 - 5. Personal/Educational Goals
 - 6. Essay
- Awards are granted without regard to race, gender, ethnicity, religion, or disability.
- The applicant is responsible for gathering and submitting <u>all necessary information and official</u> <u>documents</u>.
- Applications must be postmarked no later than 10 June 2022. No other delivery method will be accepted (i.e. hand-delivered, e-mailed, or faxed). Incomplete packets will be deemed ineligible. Please retain a copy of all documents; application packets will not be returned.
- Applicants will be notified in writing if a scholarship has been awarded.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a high school senior dependent of a first responder or military member (sponsor) that plans to attend an accredited college or university during the 2022-2023 academic school year.
- The sponsor must be assigned to the Hampton Roads area, working in law enforcement (police officer, border protection, etc), as a firefighter, paramedic/EMT, active-duty military member or military retiree. Or the dependent of one of these sponsors who was killed in action.
- Applicants for academic awards should have at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA.
- Home-schooled high school applicants may apply and must supply credentials that commensurate with the requirements listed in the criteria directly above this point.
- Applicants accepting full college/university scholarships may not accept a scholarship from MSSofVA.
- The Scholarship Committee members, including essay judges, and their dependents are <u>not</u> eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Limitations:

Scholarship funds are to be used within the 2022-2023 academic year.

- All funds received shall be applied to tuition and/or associated university costs administered by an
 accredited college or university. These costs may include room and board, books, and various fees
 pertaining to active participation in an academic setting.
- MSSofVA scholarship funds may not be applied towards penalties or disenrollment fees. Should

MSSofVA funds be used in such a case, we reserve the right to request repayment in the amount of scholarship awarded (as well as any fees incurred to process initial payment and request for repayment).

- Payment of scholarship awards will be made directly to the selected school. The recipient <u>must</u> provide the Scholarship Committee with the following items:
 - Name of college/university applicant will be attending
 - o Address to the financial aid office of said college/university
 - Contact person in financial aid office (will need name, phone number, and email address)
 - Student number (student identifier)
 - This information must be received by 1 July 2022. This can be emailed to MSSofVAScholarships@gmail.com

Failure to provide this information will result in the scholarship being considered unclaimed and the funds will not be distributed.

- The scholarship award, when combined with other scholarships, must not exceed the cost of attendance (to include tuition, room and board, books, and fees) for the academic year. Any remaining funds must be returned to the MSSofVA Scholarship Committee as soon as possible.
- Applicants accepting an appointment to a military service academy or a full scholarship become ineligible for this award. Upon notification of such awards, the MSSofVA scholarship will be forfeited.
