Earlstock's Supplementary Regs to be read in conjunction with the 2026 Machine eligibility regulations.

For the 2026 season all of the above 14 listed rounds will count towards the overall Earlstock's Championship.

In the event of there being a points tie at the end of the year the decision will go to the highest number of wins in the 14 scoring rounds and if still equal on the number of 2nd places etc. Please be aware that for 2026 for anyone to score points or receive any awards in relation to the Earlstock's Championship meetings you must be a fully paid up member of both Earlstock's & also the organising club of the race meeting, i.e. BHRC, PDMCC & Tonfanau Racing AC Ltd.

Trophies/awards

The Earlstock's Club does not receive any monetary funding whatsoever from any of the organising Clubs so we are very much in their hands on the allocation of any trophies/awards for our meetings on race days.

In previous seasons we have had a great deal of help from sponsors to whom we are extremely grateful & who have very kindly helped us out with funding enabling us to provide trophies/awards for the vast majority of our meetings. I am very pleased to say that with many thanks to our sponsors (the details of whom I will publicise later) that for 2026 we will again be in a position which will allow us to present awards for the Saturday of the BHRC weekend meetings.

Please be aware that British Historic don't award trophies for the majority of their classes on race days, so any on the day awards will be sourced by the Earlystocks Club. In this case awards will generally be issued subject to the number of finishing riders in each class, 1-3 riders would have awards of a 1st place only, 4-5 riders a 1st & 2nd & 6 riders or more would be a 1st, 2nd & 3rd. This will however be extended where possible.

At this current time we believe that there will be end of year awards for the Earlystocks riders from BHRC just as they have in previous seasons which we hope to be presented at the BHR awards night. I am hoping that these awards would cater for all Earlystocks classes again but obviously this decision is down to BHRC. For a rider to be eligible for a BHR award the rider would have had to compete in at least 3 of the 6 scheduled BHR meetings, although this is subject to the BHRC committees discretion.

Earlystocks end of year Awards/Trophies

To be eligible for the end of year overall Earlystocks championship awards a rider **should** have competed in at least 50% of the Earlystocks championship rounds for 2026, however the committee may use their discretion if appropriate.

Race Entries

All entries for our race meetings are to be sent directly to the race organising Club.

I believe all of the organising clubs we run are running with in 2026 are offering entries via an online system, & when these are available, I will attempt to send you a link for the online entry where possible.

Alternatively, please see the Race organiser's websites for further details.

I strongly recommend where possible that you send your entries into the organising clubs as soon as you are able before the closing date to ensure your place on the grid as classes will be combined if there is insufficient entries to fill a grid.

If you've had a race number allocated to you & agreed by Earlystocks, where possible please make sure this is indicated somewhere on your entry to assist the race entries secretary.

For those of you who wish to pay by cheque or pay a deposit or by alternate means for the meeting where available I would recommend you contact the organising clubs race secretary to seek advice. If you are struggling to enter a meeting due to payment issues etc, please don't hesitate to contact me & I'll liaise with the race entry secretary on your behalf.

Alternatively, please see the Race organiser's websites for details.

It looks increasing likely that paperwork for the meetings such as tickets etc may well be sent out via email so please ensure that the organising club & myself have your upto date details.

RACE NUMBERS

Race numbers are allocated by the Earlystocks club in conjunction with BHRC & will generally consist of three numbers preceded by the number 2 or 3. Once allocated a race number for the season, most of you should hopefully then be able to use this same number at the vast majority of the Earlystocks championship meetings.

Unfortunately, due to there being very limited numbers available I'm afraid riders are not always able to choose a preferred number. Some people however have adopted race numbers over the years which they have registered with other race clubs but I'm afraid we can't guarantee to be able to issue these numbers to you for specific meetings.

Due to us racing with 3 different clubs this season there unfortunately may be occasional circumstances when a rider must change their number from their usual allocated number. I will work with all the race entry secretaries & do my best so you can hopefully retain your number but please be aware some circumstances are out of my control & you may have to change your number for a meeting.

OTHER INFO

In the case of a 2-day meeting where it is scheduled for 2 races per day & if for example only 1 race has been completed on the first day & the remaining 2nd race is carried over to the next day, these 2 races will be classed as 1 race day for points. In the event of only 1 race being completed per day due to abandonment etc the points for the completed race will be doubled, this will also be the case where just 1 longer race is scheduled for a race day instead of the usual 2 races.

Where a meeting has 3 races scheduled for a day e.g. in the case of Tonfanau for example the 1st 2 races will be for Championship points & the 3rd race will be a trophy race. This helps us to keep the points in alignment.

Change of Bikes/classes.

A good number of bikes are eligible for different Earlystocks classes therefore it's most important that I am aware of which Earlystocks Championship Class you are wishing to enter your bike in when entering a meeting & at the very latest before the start of the meeting on the day of the race(s). This is to ensure that riders are correctly identified in the correct class via the timing system & awarded with the correct awards/championship points as appropriate.

If we are not aware of which Earlystocks class, you are entering you will be entered subject to eligibility for the Class 3 Class as there are no minimum modifications required for this class.

If a person has 2 different classes of bike & wishes or needs to change them during a meeting, firstly you must inform the race office/clerk of the course this is to prevent anyone being black flagged & then please advise me or one of the committee members before your race. Failure to do this could result in disqualification.

To prevent any suggestion of anyone gaining an advantage by this, they must not gain any grid advantage in any shape or form, via timed practice, grid position based on previous result or otherwise. If this is found to be the case, then that person will be moved subject to eligibility to the class 3 Class in respect of points for that meeting.

Please note you can't score points in two different classes in the same race should your bike be eligible for two different Earlystocks classes.

TRANSPONDERS

All the clubs we'll be running with in 2026 will be using transponder timing therefore you will need to have an AMB TRANX 260/MY LAPS TR2 (the red coloured ones) transponder or equivalent model. The organising clubs do usually have some to hire but these generally have to be pre booked with your race entry.

The Earlystocks club usually has 6 transponders available to hire for £15 a meeting each. If you wish to hire one of these from us please contact me first to check on availability & so I can issue you with the transponder number for your race entry. The transponders will be hired out on a first come first served basis or if we get oversubscribed it will be by ballot. Transponders will not be handed out to anyone until payment for the hire has been made. This can also be by BACS before the meeting.

Please take extremely good care of these transponders as they are now approx £615 each to replace. Due to the high cost of replacing these transponders if you hire one from us & damage one rendering it unusable during an event, we would ask that you either replace the transponder with one equivalent to it or provide us with the funds to purchase a replacement.

I have been asked on a number of occasions where to purchase a transponder from & at the time of writing one of the deals I found was via www.racetransponders.co.uk this is for the New MyLaps TR2 (AMB) Transponder which can either be purchased for £615 non subscription or leased on an annual subscription basis from £155 for 1yr.

ELIGIBILITY.

Please be aware that at some meetings there may well be ineligible machine(s) running in the same race as ourselves, on some occasions the machine(s) will have been allowed to run at the committee's discretion (on a non Championship basis), but on some occasions the organising club(s) allow non eligible machines to run on the same grid as ours to make the best use of grid space & entry fees which unfortunately is very often out of our control.

Please be assured the Club will do it's best to keep the races dedicated to Earlystocks machines, but please don't have a rant at us if we don't manage to achieve this at some meetings as unfortunately, we are not the organisers of the meeting.

Wet Weather Tyres.

In seasons gone by there have been a couple of incidents where a rider has chosen to race or practice on wet weather tyres in the Earlystocks races/practice sessions, **which is in contravention** of the Earlystocks regulations. This is something that riders have frowned upon & have raised

their deep concerns about quite understandably to the Club. The Club will not accept the use of wet weather tyres as per Earlystocks regs which is also the same as for British Historic Racing Club meetings & anyone using them for either Earlystocks timed practice sessions or Earlystocks races will be reported to the clerk of the course & disqualified from their results in their respective sessions/races.

We have a Zero tolerance on this matter & this is the same should anyone be found using tyre warmers immediately prior to the Earlystocks Race.

Only treaded race tyres or suitably speed rated road legal, i.e. road legal on the machine fitted to, are permitted”.

What we mean by this is any road legal tyre with an appropriate speed & load rating for that particular bike it is fitted to will be permitted. (For example, the H rating limit is 130 mph, V rating is 149mph and W to 168 mph).

We have been asked on numerous occasions about Supermoto tyres that are available but please be very careful as I think you will find that most if not all these tyres available won't be appropriately speed rated for your bike.

BHRC Meetings

Due to time constraints, it is believed that there will be no timed practice in 2026 at the BHR events. Therefore, for the 1st race of each of the BHR weekend meetings the grids will usually be sorted by Class & Championship positions order. One thing I must point out though is that entries must be received by BHR by the closing dates as the grid positions will be drawn up on the closing date. Entries received after the closing date if accepted will be allocated on the grid in order as they are received.

If you need to speak to the entry secretary for the BHRC meeting's which is Ralph Coldwell Mob: 07944 266895, can I please ask that you don't phone him after 9pm.

Eligibility issues.

I would just like to say to everyone which includes our seasoned members please don't be offended if any of the committee members come & take a close look at your machine. It is something we will do on occasions.

We just want to make sure that we have everyone entered down for the correct class for the purposes of any awards or points etc.

If there are any problems regarding eligibility etc at a meeting please let us or any one of the following committee members #150 John Adamson, #204 Ivan Childs #216 Alec Gilfillan or #225 John Brush, know preferably on the day in order that we can sort out any possible problems, speaking to us after the meeting or the following day is very often too late & may not allow us to resolve any issues.
