Dr Nick Morton is a Consultant Clinical Neuropsychologist working in both the NHS and private sectors.

Dr Morton holds degree of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Psychology, Master of Science degree in Clinical Psychology and Doctor of Clinical Psychology. Since 1992 he has specialised in Neuropsychological assessment and Neuropsychologically based rehabilitation in clients with acquired brain injury. Since 1997 he has been employed as a Consultant Clinical Neuropsychologist. He has been involved in setting up brain injury rehabilitation services in the independent sector, he has worked as a Lecturer in Neuropsychology at the Institute of Psychiatry (London) and has worked in Clinical Neuropsychology services within the NHS and the private sector.

Dr Morton is currently employed as Head of Service – Lead Consultant Clinical Neuropsychologist within the NHS for Neuropsychological Rehabilitation Services. This involves Consultancy and Clinical service lead in both inpatient and community sectors of the service. Dr Morton is also the research lead for multidisciplinary neuropsychological based research within the Trust.
