## RULES AND REGULATIONS ESTATES AT HUNTER'S CHASE COMMUNITY, INC.

Whereas the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for the Estates at Hunter's Chase Community, Inc. (the "Declaration") was recorded in Document number 2000046587 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, and whereas the Declaration authorizes the association to adopt community rules, and rules have been previously adopted and filed of record in Document #2003119822 and #2004018819 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, and

Whereas the association desires to supplement the previously-adopted rules, the following rules are adopted and become effective August 11, 2004.

All defined terms refer to the definitions contained in the Declaration unless otherwise stated.

<u>Detention Pond.</u> Access to the detention pond on the Property and area surrounding the detention pond is restricted only to Association representatives and government authorities for inspection and maintenance purposes. No fishing, swimming, playing, or other use, recreational or otherwise, is allowed by Owners, residents, tenants, guests or invitees in the detention pond or area surrounding the detention pond. Owners, residents, tenants, guests or invitees must obey all posted signs on common area property, including "no trespassing" or similar signs.

Common Area Use and Storage. No item may be placed or stored in the common area without prior written consent from the Architectural Committee. This includes but is not limited to furniture, barbecue grills, playground equipment, signs, sports equipment, plantings and landscaping. Items left in the common area in violation of this rule may, at the association's option, be removed and either stored, disposed of, or given to charity without notice. If the association chooses to store the items, the items may only be reclaimed upon payment of a storage fee of not less than \$25 per day, such fee to be determined by the board.

<u>Responsibility for Violations</u>. Owners are liable for all violations, including fines resulting from violations, committed by themselves, their residents, tenants, guests or invitees.


