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Explosion Report on Oklahoma City Bombing

The following article is a letter to Sen. Donald Nickles (May 17, 1995)

Dear Senator Nickles:

We are all grieved by the bombing tragedy in Oklahoma City. The entire nation was assaulted and we may never know who the real instigators were or why they did it, as in the Kennedy Assassination.

I am concerned that vital evidence will soon be forever destroyed with the pending demolition of the Federal Building in Oklahoma City. From all the evidence I have seen in published material, I can say, with a high level of confidence, that the damage pattern on the reinforced concrete superstructure could not possibly have been attained from the single truck bomb without supplementing demolition charges at some of the reinforced column bases. The total incompatibility with a single truck bomb lies in the fact that either some of the columns collapsed that should not have collapsed or some of the columns are still standing that should have collapsed and did not.

An oversimplified analogy will help to see this point. It would be as irrational or as impossible as having a 150 pound man sit in a flimsy chair and the chair collapses; then, a man weighing 1,500 pounds sits in an identical flimsy chair and it does not collapse - impossible.

To produce the resulting damage pattern on the building, there would have to have been an effort with demolition charges at column bases to complement or supplement the truck bomb damage. A careful examination of the collapsed column bases would readily reveal a failure mode produced by a demolition charge. This evidence would be so critical, a separate and independent assessment should be made before a building demolition team destroys the evidence forever. The most critical columns to assess would be A9 and B3 as later defined. Other failed columns may also have had demolition charges at their base.

I have attached a brief resume which I will amplify to establish some measure of credibility for the comments above and comments to follow. I have spent 25 years in research, design, development, test and management of weapons development.

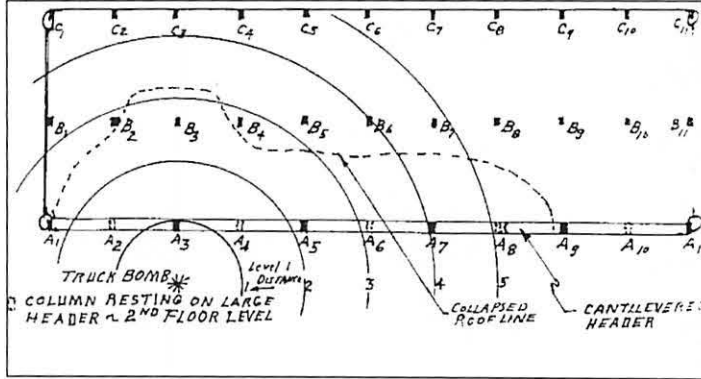
This included hands on work at the Ballistic Research Laboratories; Commander of the Air Force Armament Technology Laboratory, Air Force Systems Command, Air Staff and the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) management responsibility for almost every non-nuclear weapon device in the Air Force. I was also the first chairman of the OSD joint service Air Munitions Requirements and Development Committee.

When I first saw the pictures of the truck bomb's asymmetrical damage to the Federal Building in Oklahoma City, my immediate reaction was that the pattern of damage would have been technically impossible without supplementing demolition charges at some of the reinforced concrete column bases (a standard demolition technique).

First, blast through air is a very inefficient energy coupling mechanism against heavy reinforced concrete beams and columns. Second, blast damage potential initially falls off more rapidly than an inverse function of the distance cubed. That is why in conventional development, one seeks accuracy over yield for hard targets. Columns in large buildings are hard targets for blast. (NOTE: The 3-8-93 Time Magazine shows a still standing column in the middle of the Trade Center cavity with the reinforced concrete floors completely stripped away for several floors.)

The entire building in Oklahoma City could have been collapsed with relatively small demolition charges against the base of the columns and with even less explosives if line-of-sight cutting charges had been used. I know of no way possible to reproduce the apparent building damage without well placed demolition charges complementing the truck bomb damage.

From published photographs, the building structure is three rows of eleven columns each. The four corner columns have external clamshell like structure for air ducts, etc., as revealed in magazine photographs of the damage. If we label the column rows A, B, & C, from front to back, and number the columns 1 through 11 from left to right, then published pictures show columns A2, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, A8, and B3 collapsed, essentially vertically. The 5-1-95 U.S. News and World Report and other damage photos show a very large reinforced concrete header at the second floor level of column row A. Much larger columns extend from the header down for the odd numbered columns, i.e., A3, A5, A7, A9. The even numbered columns extended down to the header with apparently reinforced concrete joints. The heavy, odd numbered columns were all accessible from the sidewalk but collapsed Column B3, is well inside the building. If the truck bomb was not nearest to column A3, then a single truck bomb thesis would be even more questionable. See the attached figure.



A rough sketch of the Federal Building and its columns shown above has superimposed circles of roughly equal levels of damage potential which drop rapidly (exponentially) as they get farther and farther away from the truck bomb. If we consider the damage potential at Column A3, the closest column to the truck on the sketch, to be damage potential level one at distance one, then, moving out further multiples of that distance the destructive potential drops off as an exponential function of one over the number of multiples. Therefore, at circle "1" you have a decisively destructive force that brought down Column A3. At circle "2" the destructive potential is marginal for row A, Column 7.

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In Defense of the Militias

"White supremacists", "anti-Semites", "redneck gunfreaks", "paranoid conspiracy theorists" - and now "terrorists". As I write, no one knows what role, if any, the Michigan Militia played in the Oklahoma bombing. But, whatever does happen next, the American militia movement looks set for the worst publicity anyone might have hoped or feared.

This is a shame. I cannot argue that the militia movement is perfect: it is too large and decentralised to be entirely one thing or another. But I will say that the views now standard in the British and American media is a caricature, quite lacking the enquiry of means and ends, of rights and wrongs, that resistance movements elsewhere receive. Anyone who makes such an enquiry will see that the movement's agenda is neither mad nor evil, but deserves the support of any reasonable person.

Briefly put, its agenda is that the Federal Government has created a mass of unconstitutional agencies that are prying into and seeking to control every aspect of American life, and that the original balance of the Constitution must be restored if the country is to remain free. Factually, the first part of this statement is incontestable. There may be nothing new in this. The Constitution has long been in decline; and the rise of the Federal Government, from delegate to master of the States, has been the history of the United States. But two modern developments are worth noting.

First, there is the "War on Drugs". Prohibition is in itself a violation of rights. But its failure has encouraged the Federal Government to other, more se-

rious, violations. Perhaps the most obvious of these is civil asset forfeiture. This allows the authorities to freeze the allegedly tainted assets of an accused person prior to conviction. Such assets can be recovered, but only if the accused sues for them and can prove that no illegality was involved in their acquisition and use.

Since this is a civil process, there is no Constitutional bar to reversing the burden of proof. Moreover, since all assets may be frozen, the legal assistance needed to recover them may not be obtainable. Even otherwise, an American litigant must pay his own costs regardless of who wins. The effect is that only a very wealthy accused who wants to recover very substantial assets can be expected to sue the Federal Government. For everyone else, forfeiture is punishment without trial. Never mind that a jury may acquit, or even that all charges may be dropped - assets frozen are nearly always assets confiscated.

It is, however, the use of asset forfeiture that has made it a weapon of arbitrary power. Introduced as a last resort to "nail Mr. Big", it has been extended to cover virtually every crime; and there are now hundreds of Federal and State agencies empowered to freeze assets. The value of assets forfeited per year was \$27 million in 1986, \$644 million in 1991, and is now well past \$1 billion. Most forfeitures have nothing to do with "nailing Mr. Big".

In 1992, in Iowa, a woman who was accused of shoplifting a \$25 sweater had her \$18,000 car - specially equipped for her handicapped daughter -

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Whitewater Investigation Leads to Indictment of Former Bank President

WASHINGTON - 5 felony charges have been made against the former president of an Arkansas bank by a grand jury investigating the Whitewater scandal.

Independent counsel Kenneth Starr's office announced charges against Neal Ainsley, former president of Perry County Bank, of concealing large cash withdrawals by Bill Clinton's 1990 gubernatorial campaign.

The Little Rock grand jury handed up the indictment that alleges Ainsley participated in a conspiracy which involved "concealing from the IRS and others the withdrawal of large amounts of United States currency by the 1990 Clinton campaign."

The report states that Ainsley did not report to the government withdrawals of \$10,000 and \$22,500 on May 25 and Nov. 2 respectively, of that year.

Federal law mandates that all cash transactions totaling more than \$10,000 must be reported to the Internal Revenue Service and federal bank regulators.

The 1990 campaign treasurer was Bruce Lindsey, presently a top White House aide.

The grand jury's indictment also charges the conspiracy involved "others known and unknown" but does not name them.

Albert Pike's Statue: The Scottish Rite's KKK Project

The following is the edited text of the speech delivered by Mr. Chaitkin at a weekend conference of the Schiller Institute in suburban Washington, D.C.

In the heart of Washington, D.C., there is a large statue and monument honoring the most important founder of the Ku Klux Klan.

Inscribed on the base of the statue are the words, "poet"—the terrorist anthem of the KKK was his most famous literary work—and "jurist"—he was called the KKK's chief judiciary officer, and reputedly wrote the organization manual for the terrorist anti-black movement after the U.S. Civil War.

The immense, bearded figure of Confederate General Albert Pike is looming over a public square in the nation's capital. Why has it never been pulled down in that predominantly black city?

The statue is a tribute to the influence of Pike's organization. It has power in the Executive Branch, and the Congress, and it is decisive in the courts. It has great power in all branches of law enforcement and the military.

Do I mean that the Ku Klux Klan has such sway over the government? No, I'm speaking here of the "Scottish Rite of Freemasonry Southern Jurisdiction," of which Pike was the chief, or "Sovereign Grand Commander."

The Ku Klux Klan, the Southern Confederacy, and the pre-Civil War secession movement were a single, continuous project, with Pike's "Scottish Rite" at its center. Though the Confederacy was defeated, this project lives on today, and now dominates U.S. political life.

Look at Baker & Botts, the Houston family firm and power base of Secretary of State James A. Baker III. This law firm was formed after the Civil War by die-hard Confederate and Masonic officials in Albert Pike's Scottish Rite and military clique. With their British imperial racial notions, Baker & Botts and Scottish Rite Freemasonry have dominated the Texas power structure ever since.

Secretary Baker's grandfather, Captain James A. Baker, brought English race scientist Julian Huxley in to supervise the "race purification" study program for Texas at Rice University. Secretary Baker's family wealth and power came from their representing Harriman, the international oil companies and George Bush's Zapata Petroleum, all sponsors of the population control, or birth-control-babies movement. This movement is synonymous with the Scottish Rite.

Bill Clinton is governor of Arkansas, a state infested by the tradition of Albert Pike, who was the Grand Dragon of the Ku Klux Klan in Arkansas. Look closely at the mind-set, Bill Clinton supports and carries out the death penalty, which in practice means executions of black people and poor people; and Clinton supports abortion. Clinton sat down, and worked out his views on these issues with his Baptist minister, the late Rev. W.O. Vaught, who was Clinton's spiritual guide and virtual foster father.

As Vaught's son recently told me, Clinton and his pastor agreed that their religion permits the killing of prisoners and unborn children. The authority for this version of Christianity is derived from a peculiar, neo-pagan reading of the Old Testament. And the New Testament, with its ban on revenge and requirement to love, is considered irrelevant. They say that Christ was primarily concerned with fulfilling the Old Law of the Hebrews (as interpreted by this faction), and when Christ said love your enemy and turn the other cheek, he was really trying to reinforce and impose the authority of the Roman Empire.

But whose religion is this? Well, the Reverend W.O. Vaught was a 32nd Degree Mason, a Sublime Prince of the Royal Secret within

Truth among casualties, buried under mountain of lies

The Albert Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City collapsed into a pile of rubble and torn bodies after explosions ripped its supports from the foundation at approximately 9:02 am, Wednesday, April 19, 1995, the second anniversary of the Waco massacre. Timothy McVeigh, a Gulf War veteran had been arrested and charged with the crime. James and Terry Nichols, brothers, have been arrested and charged with conspiracy to build explosive devices at James' farm in Michigan. McVeigh and Terry Nichols were army buddies. Casualties as of May 5th stand at 164 dead. Fifteen of them children. Seventeen remain unidentified. The total number of injured is in excess of 400. There are still 2 adults unaccounted for and it is feared that they will never be found. Assistant Firechief Hazen has announced that the cause of the bomb site is officially over. Rescuers wept silently at the announcement. The reason for the bombing is still unknown.

Use of the term "terrorist" to describe Oklahoma is right on the mark. Oklahomans are American to the core. They are deeply religious, avid gun owners, believe in a strict moral code, and have provided more than their fair share of cannon fodder for the nation's wars. They are, for the most part, an honest and hard-working people from pioneer stock. Many live on land their grandparents staked out in the great Oklahoma land rush. These people are extremely loyal to their state and to their country. Oklahomans know all along where we were headed, and true to form they tried to stop the march toward globalism. These traits may have sealed Oklahoma's fate. In November, 1994 when the Oklahoma State Legislature passed a resolution which struck out at Clinton's socialist world government agenda. They were the first and only state to pass such legislation.

● Resolution No. 1047. "A Resolution relating to United States military forces and the United Nations; memorializing Congress to cease certain activities concerning the United Nations; and directing distribution."

● WHEREAS, the constitutional role of the United States military is to protect the life, liberty and property of United States citizens and to defend our nation against insurrection or foreign invasion; and

● WHEREAS, the United States is an independent sovereign nation and not a tributary of the United Nations; and

● WHEREAS, there is no popular support for the establishment of a "new world order" or world sovereignty of any kind either under the United Nations or under any world body in any form of global government; and

● WHEREAS, global government would mean the destruction of our Constitution and corruption of the spirit of the Declaration of Independence, our freedoms, and our way of life.

● NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

● THAT the United States Congress is hereby memorialized to:

1. Cease the appropriation of United States funds for any military activity not authorized by Congress;

2. Cease engagement in any military activity under the authority of the United Nations or any world body;

3. Cease the rendering of aid to any activity or engagement under the jurisdiction of the United Nations or any world body; and

4. Cease any support for the establishment of a "new world order" or to any form of global government.

● THAT the United States Congress is hereby memorialized to refrain from taking any further steps toward the economic or political control of the United States into a world body or any form of world government.

● That copies of this resolution be distributed to the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the Secretary of the United States Senate, and to each member of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.

● Adopted by the House of Representatives the 28th day of March, 1994.

The resolution passed by the Oklahoma State Legislature on the support of all the citizens of Oklahoma. It was a slap in the face to the Clinton administration and all those who promote the Socialist Internationale. These included Ruby Creek and Waco cried out for justice. Americans echoed those cries. Everyone knew that something was terribly wrong. A police state was emerging before our eyes. Militias were forming. The Democrats suffered the worst defeat in their history at the polls in November. The hidden agenda of the communist/socialist Internationale was being exposed to the public through talk radio and a thriving underground autoblog of information.

This story really began on February 26, 1993 when the World Trade Center was bombed in New York City. I had predicted terrorists would detonate a bomb in New York City since 1989. It is on record, on video tape, and in my book. I predicted that it would be blamed upon Islamic fundamentalists but that the real perpetrators would be the U.S. Intelligence Community and specifically the Central Intelligence Agency. I did not know or venture to guess the target.

Three arrests were linked directly to the CIA and the FBI was implicated in the bombing. The perpetrators used two megabombs carried in a yellow Ryder

rental van. The bombs exploded in the parking garage of the World Trade Center, prematurely, before being properly placed. The result was substantial damage. Five people were killed and over 1,000 were wounded. If the bombs had been placed in position next to the main structural supports the result would have been exactly what we see in Oklahoma City only much worse.

Fragments of the yellow van were quickly found in the rubble. A paper trail traced the vehicle to an outlet in New Jersey where it was rented four days before the explosion. "A hacky breakthrough" led federal agents to arrest a suspect, 26 year old Mohammed Salameh, at the Jersey City rental agency at which he attempted to reclaim a \$400 deposit on the van.

In a surprise revelation Tony Lang, a staff columnist for "The Cincinnati Enquirer" (Gannett chain) in Cincinnati, Ohio, has uncovered court documents to support the direct involvement of the FBI in the World Trade Center bombing. The papers, he stated in a letter to the Cincinnati Enquirer, an employee of the FBI, accompanied the accused bomber, Mohammed Salameh, to a New Jersey court where he was arraigned. Salameh proceeded to INSTRUCT Salameh in how to drive the famous van two days before the explosion!

In another surprise development, reported by Louis Beam in the "Jubilee", tapes made secretly by an FBI informant of conversations between him and his contacts, handlers linked the nation's largest law enforcement agency directly to "the most destructive terrorist act in U.S. history." Unfortunately that title now rests with Oklahoma City. Enad Al Saleh, an FBI informant used hidden microphones given him by Federal Bureau of Investigation agents to record his conversations with James Satton, a Los Angeles Times reporter on October 28, 1993 revealed to shocked readers details of FBI involvement in the terrorist act. FBI spokesmen in Washington have denied this.

The tapes became public knowledge when they were ordered released by a federal judge presiding over the case of the indicted suspects. The Justice Department fought hard to prevent their release.

The tapes which have been published by the New York Times reveal that Salem informed his FBI bosses that the World Trade Center was soon to be bombed and urged them to prevent it. Speculation is now rampant in political circles that certain factions within the government may have desired the bombing in order to speed passage of new "anti-crime legislation."

This suspicion was further fueled by the startling revelation that the FBI denied the request to use phone taps on operatives in the bomb he was helping to build under FBI supervision - the bomb ultimately used in the World Trade Center explosion.

Former Waco associate prosecutor Richard Ben-Veniste warned that these tapes pose "an absolute nightmare for federal prosecutors." One high-ranking law enforcement official who insisted on secrecy said that in less than a year's time the FBI has been linked to criminal abuse of power and the mishandling of cases in respect to the Waco case. "I had Weaver, where an HRT member shot a mother with a baby in her arms, then Waco, where mishandling led to the deaths of a hundred people," says the World Trade Center, where it appears the bombing could not have happened unless the agency let it.

All of this comes on the heels of an Internal affairs report by the Justice Department's Office of Professional Responsibility, linking FBI agents to every major drug bust in the country. During OPR's annual report provided further startling proof that the agency formally most respected for its law enforcement skills - "has gone bad."

This contention is backed up by J.B. Campbell of the "National Educator". If the bombs had been placed properly, it could have exploded out into the other and brought them both down along with the 50,000 people inside. The New York Times now reports that the FBI could have prevented the bombing by calling it off, or by building the bomb with harmless powder. One of the FBI conspirators, a former Egyptian army officer, secretly taped his meetings with his FBI handlers. Enad Al Saleh recalls in the tape recorded meeting that the FBI had planned on building the bomb with a phony powder and forcing the people who had been trapped in the plot. But the informer, who is heard lecturing his FBI handlers, said the powder scheme was called off and "we didn't do that."

We remember the FBI crowing about its investigative prowess after its remarkably swift nabbing of the suspects, based on debris found in the bomb's crater. This was never true, for later we were to learn that the FBI's informant, Enad Al Saleh, had to teach the suspects how to make a proper bomb. Not only did the FBI know the suspects were plotting to give them a bomb, the FBI could have ordered Salem to make a harmless bomb at, for some reason, it decided to provide a real bomb which had the power to kill innocent people and the suspects go ahead and explode it. Our conclusion is that my prediction was 100% right on the mark.

The San Francisco Chronicle reported on September 25, 1993 that observers from 11 counties watched as the U.S. Department of Energy present resulted from the ignition of ammonium nitrate and diesel fuel, which produced a force equivalent to a one-kiloton nuclear bomb. The test was designed to allow scientists to distinguish between nuclear and non-nuclear blasts should a permanent worldwide ban on nuclear testing be established. Gee, all these years and they still don't know the difference.

Rumors began circulating in January of this year that meetings were being held among federal law enforcement agencies to discuss the possibility of planning a move against the militia in April. Most ignored these rumors. On February 18th I spoke at a Constitution Party rally in Ferndale, Michigan. A federal agent in the audience held his

badge and identification up to the crowd stating clearly that the federal government had held meetings among several agencies for the purpose of making an all out assault against patriots and the militia in April. I was the only person in the crowd who is on record. I verified his credentials. Such an attack would be political suicide unless some great tragedy turned the public opinion against the government.

It was shortly after Michigan that we obtained a copy of the "Omnibus Counter Terrorism Act of 1995" introduced on February 10th by Joe Barton in the Senate (S-390) and Charles Stumer in the House (HR-896). I remembered the random shooting that always occurred just before anti-gun legislation came up for a vote. I predicted a wave of terrorism directed against the United States would begin in the near future. I had already made this prediction in a book titled "Redeol a 'P' Horse" and during many lectures. It is all recorded. I knew this would happen if all other attempts to destroy patriotism and the militia were blocked. I had written in the book that patriots would be labeled terrorists.

A warning was contained in a memo issued by the U.S. Marine Corps on March 15th. The memo expressed fear that the terrorist attacks would be designed to attract worldwide press attention to an Islamic religious videotape up for a vote. The warning stated that Middle Eastern terrorists were planning to launch suicide attacks against federal courthouses and government installations throughout the United States. The memo was sent to federal facilities nationwide. Authorities reviewed the security at Oklahoma City's Alfred P. Murrah federal building, nothing was changed, and one guard was left to patrol a four-building complex. Representative James Satton (R), a senior member of the House Task Force on Terrorism, said his group had alerted law enforcement and intelligence personnel on February 27th that there was an increased threat of terrorism.

Another rumor flew through the grapevine. This one alleged that the federal government would make a deal with the patriots and the militia on March 24th and 25th. The rumor came from many sources and was published in "Strategic Investment" lending credibility to the story.

● Strategic Investment, March 22, 1995. "The slaughter of dozens of women and children in Waco by government stormtroopers under the command of Field Marshall Brent Scowcroft. In comparison to what has been planned for late March: a nationwide BATF/FBI assault on private militias as the prelude to a post-apocalyptic, elite strike force throughout the United States. All leaves and vacations have been canceled for BATF/FBI personnel, and for various State Police and Sheriff's Departments as California's The Army's infamous Joint Task Force Six (which did the training for Waco) has been training BATF personnel in the use of military vehicles at Ft. Bliss, Texas. Government agitators are set to plant fully automatic and heavy weapons like rocket launchers, and to recruit militia leaders. Every militia in the country - and there are dozens, many of which are well-armed and well-led by former or even active members of the U.S. Armed Forces. Should Reno on a state of Red Alert. Should Reno be struck enough to actually attack them militarily, there is going to be a lot of blood. The establishment is well programmed to immediately thereafter thunderously bellow for nationwide gun confiscation and even martial law."

The Senate Armed Forces Committee has been alerted and is questioning key Defense and Justice people behind closed doors. Hopefully, Reno's Waco error can be stopped in time. A plot was plotted in the first place should be a sobering lesson as to what a horrifying event liberalism, the political philosophy of the democratic party, and the Democratic Party, has been converted into a close cousin of fascism.

Three Congressmen believed these stories to be true and wrote letters to Janet Reno asking for an explanation of the federal law enforcement sources. No answer was forthcoming. Nothing could happen unless something were to occur that would turn the public against the militia. It was felt that the answer came across the nation and the answer came back the same. We could not identify any patriot or militia organization that would be anything of the nature that would be required to justify an all out assault upon patriots and the militia. We knew only that the March dates were bogus. April approached. I had no hard evidence that anything would occur in April, only reports from many credible sources, and fearing this could be an attempt to discredit the Intelligence Service, I wrote "Time of the Time" and "Veritas," we maintained silence. Ordo Ab Chao.

On Monday, April 17th the Orange County Register reported that the FBI had opened an international police training academy in Budapest. In an incredible admission of the socialist agenda Clinton announced that American intelligence agencies are rapidly expanding overseas, deploying agents to dozens of countries in scores of joint investigations. This followed on the heels of a recent announcement that the FBI had opened an office in Moscow and what used to be the KGB had opened an office in the United States. The FBI reported, "After years, fresh opened an office in Moscow. This was the second network of 24 such offices, forward command posts for an increasingly global detective agency. He has also been a driving force behind the Budapest training academy."

My worst fears became reality on Wednesday morning, April 19, 1995. One of the FBI agents in the crowd showed up shortly after 7 am, Arizona Standard Time, to report that a bomb had gone off at the federal building in Oklahoma City. I ran to the phone and began to contact our

agents. Responsibility for the on-scene supervision of the investigation was assigned to our Oklahoma Station Chief. Information began to flow.

It became obvious within hours that what was being reported was being reported by the media were two, completely different, events. The event reported by the news networks must have taken place in China because it sure didn't happen in Oklahoma City. The official investigation of the Intelligence Service and CAJ News Service produced the following:

Witnesses reported bearing two distinct explosions, seconds apart, then the ominous rambling of the building falling in upon itself.

Survivors who were in the building near the front wall reported being hurled out of the front of the federal building through cinder block walls into the street.

The front of the federal building was thrown out, away from the federal building, and into the street.

A large crater was blown into the street immediately in front and slightly to the left of center when facing what had been the front of the federal building.

The first video tape of the disaster shows two large columns of black smoke, one rising from the crater area in the street, and the other rising from the center of the federal building.

Undetonated plastic explosives were found on the scene by the first rescue workers. A quarry blast, the St. Louis report that Timothy McVeigh attended a local militia rally last year as a bodyguard for Mark Koemke. Koemke denies any knowledge of McVeigh.

On April 21st our Station Chief obtained the seismograph report from Oklahoma University which can be found in this issue. The seismometer is located approximately four miles north of Norman and sixteen miles from downtown Oklahoma City. A second large surface-wave was recorded at 9:02:23 a.m. (40223 UTC). He was arrested, without resistance, for carrying a concealed weapon and jailed (for convenience) A CBS feed on the KU satellite band reported that the initial report that the concealed weapon was a gun was in error. The commentator (a woman) reported that the concealed weapon was a knife. McVeigh was jailed was a knife. This report was never aired to our knowledge.

The FBI also reported that McVeigh lived in Kingman, Arizona at Canyon West Trailer Park. He was described as having lived in trailer #19, under the name of his girlfriend. They re-

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HEALTH AND NUTRITION A Picnic of Vitamins

What does eating a picnic lunch in the beautiful sunshine have to do with taking a vitamin? Hopefully you feel healthy enough to have a picnic in the sunshine. Of course you don't have to go further than your backyard to have a picnic on a beautiful sunny day.

Lets first consider your general nutritional needs before we discuss your picnic any further. Your body's nutrient level determines how healthy you are. Even a small gap between the nutrients you need and what you get adds up just like your bank account. If you don't make as much money as you spend, eventually you will become bankrupt if you don't replace the vitamins your body burns up each day you will suffer from nutritional bankruptcy. It doesn't matter if the lack of nutrients occurs with a big deficit in a short time or a small deficit over a long period. If you run out of reserves, you become bankrupt!

Even marginal deficiencies lead to an impaired immune response, which means increased susceptibility to disease and infection. For example, a healthy immune system can destroy an isolated cancer cell or two. However, if a cancer-causing agent mutates a cell while your immune system is weak, it may develop into a non-curable cancer. Marginal deficiencies impair the power of the body to recover from disease or infection. There is growing evidence that nutrients are involved in our resistance to cancer and heart disease. So, how do you avoid nutritional bankruptcy? Where can you get the nutrients that need to stay healthy?

OBTAINING VITAMINS

One way you obtain vitamins is by eating the plants and animals that make them in their tissues. Also, many vitamins can be manufactured in your body. Dr. Carey Reams stated in his lecture "Your Diet and Vibrant Health" recorded by Salem Kirban in 1976, "A vitamin is an enzyme, an enzyme is a product of a hormone. A hormone is a product of living tissue (plant or animal), which is a product of a mineral." What he meant is your body uses the mineral in your tissues to make hormones. The hormones then make enzymes some of which are vitamins that help your body systems to work.

Vitamins themselves are not part of your body tissues; they are not building blocks of the cell (like minerals) but helps in metabolism. Dr. Reams explained, "A vitamin is a crutch that your body needs while the body uses minerals to heal the actual problem." You cannot live on vitamins but you need food that provides nutritional energy and helps form the actual tissues of your body. In fact, you need food and certain minerals to best absorb any vitamin supplements you take. Let's look at some of the vitamins that your body can manufacture.

VITAMIN A

Vitamin A is the name of a category of many vitamin enzymes that are beta-carotene crystalline compounds. Vitamin A is active in many forms whose ultimate source is the carotenes, which are synthesized by plants such as carrots, sweet potatoes, peaches, etc. One of the carotenes is called Beta Carotene which is a water soluble precursor (a forerunner) to active Vitamin A. In this form it can be used in large doses and not have the complication of building toxic levels within the system. A suggested dosage is 10,000 units twice a day, any more than this amount hasn't been shown to make changes in relief of symptoms under ordinary circumstances. Your body converts a considerable proportion of the carotene that is in the foods you eat into Vitamin A.

NATURAL IMMUNITY

Unlike drugs that do just a few specialized things, Vitamin A helps to regulate and maintain a whole range of essential functions inside your body. You need Vitamin A to help bolster your body's natural immunity, which may help the body safeguard itself against cancer. Vitamin A also helps counter the damaging effects of stress and aids in wound healing, treatment of skin conditions and internally protecting you against certain poisonous chemicals. It's even involved in sexual function:

A shortage can lead to female problems such as excessive menstruation and also male problems of infertility. Richard A. Chole, M.D., Ph.D., an ear, nose and throat researcher at the University of California at Davis, recently has found evidence that Vitamin A is necessary for the normal functioning in the middle ear. Without Vitamin A, a middle ear infection may develop. Vitamin A has an influence in eye sight, night blindness and controlling glaucoma. It is a protector of the epithelial lining of the bowel and might be useful in treating Crohn's disease.*

THE SUNSHINE VITAMIN

Vitamin D is another vitamin that is produced by the healthy body. Ordinarily, you manufacture most of the vitamin D you use through a "magical" meeting of the skin and sun (hence its nickname, "the sunshine vitamin"). Normally, ultraviolet wavelengths in sunshine, striking your bare skin, convert a lipid (fat) substance called 7-dehydrocholesterol into pre-vitamin D3. Pre-vitamin D3 slowly converts to vitamin D3 (an active form) in the deeper layers of your skin. You don't actually make vitamin D3 during sunlight exposure, it takes three or four days for the whole manufacturing process to run its course, so your body is busy producing vitamin D3 long after you come in out of the sun.*

The primary use of the sunbath is for stimulating the liver with long wave ultraviolet light. The darker the skin the more energy is picked up from the sun. This sunbath is very valuable for persons who have urine and saliva pH measurements in an acid (low) condition. The body responds to the sun rays by producing Vitamin D which then helps to raise the pH's. And in persons who have pH measurements that are in an alkaline (high) chemistry range, sunbathing can possibly aggravate their situation because of the excess Vitamin D production. If there is a tendency to have high pH's most of the time, increase the acid reacting vitamins like vitamin C when summer comes.*

SUNBATH

When sunbathing, it is best to expose the skin over the liver area to the sun as well as the rest of body. Only 20-30 minutes per day in the summertime is all that is necessary. For longer periods, be sure that adequate precautions are taken against sunburn when that is a potential problem.*

During the winter months your body responds to the low-lying winter sun with an ebb in the chemical lides that transform calcium and phosphorus into bone. How can the sun's angle in the earth affect bone growth? Through vitamin D, a remarkable substance which plays a key role in your body's calcium metabolism. Vitamin D3 helps increase the absorption of calcium from the gut, decreases excretion from the kidneys, stimulates resorption of calcium and phosphorus from bone, helps put them into teeth and helps to maintain normal blood levels of calcium and phosphorus. This function is especially important in menopausal women (and women with hormone imbalances); this vitamin is closely related structurally to the body hormones estrogen and cortisone. It is also helpful in maintaining the nervous system, heart function, and for normal blood clotting--all of which are affected by calcium levels.*

During the short, dim days of winter, when you're either indoors or bundled up much of the time, lack of sunshine on your skin can result in a steady drain on your vitamin D supply until, by late winter or early spring, your bones may actually begin to ache. But what is most disturbing,

States Beat the Feds - But Not on All Issues

ABC News/Washington Post Poll

Efforts to "devalue" federal power to the states win broad public support in general - but it's a much closer call on specific issues such as civil rights and environmental protection, an ABC News/Washington Post poll has found.

Broadly, a large majority of Americans, 69 percent, prefer their state government

over Washington "to do a better job running things." That big majority holds on issues such as handling welfare and fighting crime.

But on other issues the public is more divided. A smaller majority prefers the states to handle Medicaid and Medicare; the public splits about evenly on which level of government should handle environmental protection and tort reform; and

a large majority favors federal protection of civil rights.

The results illustrate the differences that can arise between thematic and specific preferences in public policy. In this case they show that most Americans prefer to have the states running things - but not all things.

Way - The poll also found that while more people trust their state and local governments than the federal government, they're wary of all three. In fact not one of these levels of government has the confidence of a majority of Americans.

Just 22 percent trust the federal government to do what's right most of the time, the survey found; that rises to 39 percent for state governments, and to 50 percent for local governments. Trust in all three has declined in the last five years, and the decline in trust in the federal government stretches back decades.

the Scottish Rite hierarchy. What, then, is the Scottish Rite?

Freemasonry was founded in the early 1700's in England by the so-called Venetian Party. This clique of British philosophical liberals had a few other experiments in human misery, for example: the East India Company, the royal African Company of slaves, and the slave colony of South Carolina.

The Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, in particular, has a feudal lore and legend that is rooted in the black slave trade through the Caribbean Islands. In those islands, the pagan cults of slaves in ancient Rome, and Venice, were reused as anti-Judeo-Christian or Satanic cults and rituals for the amusement and gratification of the slave-traders, the British, Dutch, Bostonian, and Jewish-ethnic slave runners.

The Scottish Rite was formally organized in the U.S.A. in 1801, as a group of Tory partisans on the losing side of the American Revolution. The Scottish Rite came to rule over American Freemasonry during the nineteenth century.

American colonial leaders had used the British Empire's Freemasonic lodges as political clubs, and had turned them against the British Crown in the American Revolution. But in the 1820's and 1830's, Masonry had been widely condemned and virtually run out of the U.S.A. as a would-be dictatorial grouping, an unwanted "British underground" intrusion into America.

With British assistance, the Masonic lodges were reintroduced, under the control of the Scottish Rite based in Charleston, South Carolina, as a force for Southern secession. Since the 1840's, the U.S. Freemasonic structure has been strictly dominated by the Scottish Rite. The Scottish Rite dispenses the 4th and higher Masonic "degrees" of initiation, up to the 33rd. The Scottish Rite was divided into a Southern Jurisdiction, and a Northern Jurisdiction based in Boston, that is politically subordinate.

As for Bill Clinton: A spokesman for the Freemasonic Grand Lodge of Arkansas told me that although Clinton was a member of Freemasonry's Order of DeMolay as a young man, he is not now a Mason. I have been informed, however, that DeMolay membership is in fact a life membership.

The influence of Scottish Rite-dominated Freemasonry is shockingly pervasive in American government and culture, particularly in the South. But it has come under attack from some surprising quarters. The Southern Baptist Convention recently voted to conduct an investigation of Freemasonry in all forms, and to prepare a report on whether Masonry is compatible with Christianity.

The Southern Baptist Convention, predominantly white, is the largest U.S. Protestant denomination, with 18 million churchgoers. Freemasons make up a sizeable proportion of this church's male membership, perhaps 20 percent. So this is a dramatic, emotional issue, a strongly factional issue within Protestant Christianity.

At their annual meeting last June in Indianapolis, the Baptists also adopted a resolution against secret societies, which reads in part: we . . . call upon all Christians to . . . [avoid] any association which conflicts with clear Biblical . . . teachings concerning the taking of oaths, the secrecy of activities, mystical knowledge or racial discrimination. . . .

A leader of this initiative, Dr. James Holly of Beaumont, Texas, told me this was aimed at the known fact that white Freemasonry is affiliated with the Ku Klux Klan. The 2.5 million member Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod says in its official handbook: The Synod has declared itself firmly opposed to all societies, lodges and organizations of an un-Christian or anti-Christian character. The Lutheran Missouri Synod has also printed an attack on Freemasonry, which attacks its racism and quotes from an absurd Masonic explanation of why blacks are excluded from white lodges:

There are excellent reasons for this apparent race discrimination which only a Mason can fully understand. . . . [racial integration] would endanger the harmony of the lodge. . . . Secondly, although Negroes today may technically fulfill the Masonic requirement of being "free," their subordinate economic, educational, and cultural position is such that they hardly fulfill the spirit of that prerequisite to initiation. . . .

The True Religion of Masonry

But let us ask, does Mr. Pike's organization have an "un-Christian or anti-Christian character"? Albert Pike

responded in 1861 to a Mason who tried to claim the Scottish Rite was somehow Christian. Pike said that if the Scottish Rite has a Christian basis, how did it chance that most of those who had possession of it in this country from 1763 to 1800 were Hebrews?

In fact, Pike and the Scottish Rite borrowed a good deal of numerology and other superstition from the Jewish cabala, a neo-pagan tradition in direct opposition to the Mosaic law underlying the Jewish religion. We shall deal later on with the relationship of Jews to the Scottish Rite.

But if the Rite is not specifically Christian, is it anti-Christian? We may judge this from Sovereign Grand Commander Pike's words, on his method, and on the true religion.

In Pike's book, *Morals and Dogma*, the Scottish Rite's main guide to the universe, he explains his method: "Magic is the science of the ancient magi. . . . Magic unites in one and the same science, whatsoever Philosophy can possess that is most certain, and Religion of the infallible and the Eternal. It perfectly . . . reconciles these two terms . . . faith and reason . . . those who accept [magic] as a rule may give their will a sovereign power that will make them the masters of all inferior beings and of all errant spirits; that is to say, will make them the Arbiters and Kings of the World. . . ."

Pike writes this particular section to instruct "Sublime Princes of the Royal Secret" gentlemen of the 32nd De-

The Trilateral Commission

The European Community, North America (U.S. and Canada), and Japan - the three main democracies industrialized areas of the world - are the three sides of the Trilateral Commission. The Commission's members are about 335 distinguished citizens, with a variety of leadership responsibilities, from these three regions. When the first triennial of the Trilateral Commission was launched in 1973, the most immediate purpose was to draw together - at a time of considerable friction among governments - the highest level unofficial group possible to look together at the common problems facing our three areas. At a deeper level, there was a sense that the United States was no longer in such a singular leadership position as it had been in earlier post-World War II years, and that a more shared form of leadership - including Europe and Japan in particular - would be needed for the international system to navigate successfully the major challenges of the coming years. These purposes continue to inform the Commission's work.

The rise of Japan and progress of the European Community over the past twenty years - particularly in the world economy - have validated the vision of the Commission's founders. At the same time, the end of the Cold War and other broad changes call for a fresh vision of what this outward-looking partnership can accomplish. The opportunities are remarkable and yet, with the welcome end of the old Soviet threat, part of the "glue" holding our regions together has dissolved. Helping think through that leadership challenge is at the heart of the Trilateral Commission effort.

The full Commission gathers once each year - in Washington in 1993, in Tokyo in 1994, in Copenhagen in 1995. In addition to special topical sessions and reviews of current developments in the regions, a substantial portion of each annual meeting is devoted to consideration of draft reports to the Commission. These reports are the product of authors from each of the three regions who draw on a range of consultants in the course of their work. Publication of the discussion in the Commission's annual meeting. The authors are solely responsible for their report. A separate publication contains presentations at the annual meeting. Occasionally informal papers appear from regional activities.

Each regional group has a Chairman and Deputy Chairman, who all together constitute the leadership of the Commission. The Executive Committee draws together a further 36 individuals from the wider membership. The 335 membership includes 85 European Japanese members, 100 for North America, and 150 for the countries of the European Community (now called the European Union).

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In Defense of the Militias

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 ter - seized as the "getaway vehicle".
 In December 1988, Detroit drug police raided a grocer's shop, but found no drugs. After dogs reacted to three \$1.00 bills in the cash register, the police seized \$4,384 and the shop safe - this, even though over 90% of all cash circulating in the United States shows some drug residue.
 In 1994, a farmer in California accidentally ran over a "protected" rat with his tractor. The United States Fish and Wildlife Service seized the tractor worth \$50,000.
 There are proposals to extend asset forfeiture still wider, so that seizures may be made on mere suspicion. American citizens officers can keep part of what they seize. Armed with these powers, the authorities will be able to do almost as they please with any person or group they dislike. They will only need better theories with due process when they want to put someone in prison.
 Second, there is the gradual abolition of the right to keep and bear arms. Contrary to received opinion, American citizens have no absolute right to own guns. There is a long history of control, and the Federal authorities seem to be planning still more. In a 1994 questionnaire, American servicemen were asked if they would fire on civilians if ordered to enforce a Federal ban on firearm ownership. When this question was leaked, the authorities first denied everything, and then claimed it was purely hypothetical.
 But there is nothing hypothetical about the "Lamplugh Case". In May 1994, agents of the Federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and the Internal Revenue Service entered and searched the Pennsylvania home of Harry and Theresa Lamplugh. Though the Lamplughs fully cooperated, opening safes and cabinets as asked, they were repeatedly threatened with a machine gun, and three of their pet cats were killed. Their furniture was smashed, papers and

food were mixed and scattered everywhere. Mr. Lamplugh, who is dying from cancer, was continually barred from taking his prescribed medication.
 The reason for this search? Mr. Lamplugh is a gun show promoter. Though legal, these gatherings are common outlets for anti-Federal government sentiment. Among items seized was a list of all gun sales assisted by him since 1988, giving the names and addresses of 70 thousand people. Some of these people have since had their homes searched. Mr. and Mrs. Lamplugh have received anonymous death threats for complaining.
 Still worse, the Federal authorities have started to murder those who make too public a show of collecting arms. At Waco, they gassed and burned to death 67 adults and 17 children. In 1992, they entrapped Randy Weaver, another gun collector, then shot and killed his unarmed wife and child. The facts of this case have still fully to emerge.
 Aside from the above, there are repeated rumours that hardly seem credible - Russian tanks and artillery seen driving along country roads, of foreign troops drilling on American soil, of plans to abolish cash transactions, of martial law, of concentration camps ready and waiting to hold up to a million "disidents". The Internet is full of speculation about what the Federal Government intends to do next. Doubtless, much of this is paranoid fantasy. But there is plenty of indubitable evidence of anti-Constitutional action.
 This is the background to the recent enormous growth of citizen militias in the United States. Autonomous, largely rural, middle class groups, these have the best weapons that can be bought or stolen. They are trained by veterans who learned everything worth knowing from the Vietcong about guerrilla warfare. They correspond with each other on the Internet using the securest new encryption. They have sympathisers in the regular army forces; and, in spite of the possibly desired

use of the armed forces against citizens, there is good reason to doubt the loyalty of many units.
 In the eyes of all their spokesmen, the militias are defensive organisations. They do not advocate the violent overthrow of the Federal Government - though they do stress that it richly deserves to be overthrown. As one spokesman has said: "It is ideas, not bullets, that will cut Washington down to size." The main purpose of the militias is to guarantee the freedom to express these ideas.
 And the ideas are libertarian. The militias are part of a wider, anti-statist coalition. Some groups within it are more radical than others. Not everyone, for example, agrees with the free market anarchists, who want to legalise hard drugs and pornography and abolish all business regulation. But that is the logic of the ideas. The agreed ends of the coalition are the dismantling of Federal power, and when there are no bodies of officials to tax and regulate, and no social security numbers or other means of surveillance, and no gags on juries and other sidesteppings of due process, and no floods of money to be turned on and off to encourage local obedience to orders from the centre - why, there will be precious few means left by which individual Americans can be oppressed.
 None of this can be found in the current orgy of denunciation. All we hear is that the militias are paranoid and anti-Semitic hate groups, with links to the Klan and other racist organisations. This is the line taken by the Anti-Defamation League, a Jewish group that claims to defend human rights. Its report on the militias, "Armed and Dangerous", is both highly influential and an intellectual disgrace. It is all innuendo and "smear by association". It ignores two crucial points. First, the militias are not exclusively WASP organisations, but include many Jews, Latinos, blacks and other minorities. Second, they draw heavily on the works of such libertarian thinkers as Ayn Rand,

Ludwig von Mises, and Murray Rothbard - all Jewish, by race if not by faith. I do not know enough about the ADL to explain why, after a century of examples that should warn for all time, it is supporting the establishment of an arbitrary despotism.
 Of course, there is no smoke entirely without fire, and the militias do contain people who talk endlessly of white supremacy and homosexual politics. But it is suspicious that their voices have been taken as representative of a movement that contains so much good. After all, when ideas cannot be answered, those who express them can still be blackened and thereby denied an audience.
 This returns us to the Oklahoma bomb. It is not important to have been planted by members of a militia - though I cannot imagine what advantage was desired from an act that would outrage the whole nation. Perhaps it is too early to say what advantage was in mind. Perhaps the bomb simply went off at the wrong time. But the bombing was an act suspiciously out of line with the stated agenda of the militia movement, and in line with the agenda fastened on it in the media. It came at a time when the American public was turning increasingly away from big government, and in line with the new Republican majorities in Congress for a return to Constitutional government. It has been followed by promises of further surveillance and control. This would not be the first time in American history when an unwelcome movement had been infiltrated and discredited by "agent provocateurs".
 But, this is at the moment, only speculatively. It is enough to say that the militias do not deserve the reputation they currently have in the media - indeed, that the victory of their ideals would be an unqualified boon for the human race; and that, whatever its cause may turn out to be, the Oklahoma bomb should not divert us from these truths.

George Washington stated in a letter from Mount Vernon on October 24, 1798:

"It was not my intention to doubt that the doctrine of the Illuminati, and the principles of Jacobinism, had [sic] spread in the United States. On the contrary, no one is more satisfied than this fact than I am."

"The idea I meant to convey was that I did not believe the Lodges of Freemasons in this country had, as societies, endeavored to propagate the diabolical tenets of the former, or the pernicious principles of the latter, if they are susceptible of separation."

Alexander Addison, in a 1799 document entitled "Rise and Progress of Revolution," a charge to the Grand Jurors of Pennsylvania, wrote of the Jacobinist (socialist) influence in America via the Masonic Lodges:

"Reason, not God, became the object of their worship... and the world was to become one Masonic Lodge."

The Pilgrims who landed at Plymouth Rock were fleeing persecution from the Roman Catholic Church, as the Masons were. Yet the difference is that the Pilgrims were Protestants attempting to return to the Bible, and the religion of the Masons was the philosophical worship of the human intellect, which was practiced by the Egyptians, and which originated in ancient Babylon. The snake upon the forehead (the seat of intellect) of the Egyptian pharaohs, identifying them as "enlightened ones" with the "gift" of intellect obtained from the snake in the Garden of Eden, and the myriad Egyptian statues in the Masonic Temple in Washington D.C., as well as the presence of the Masonic pyramid and eye of Horus on our dollar bills, are

testaments to this fact. The Washington Monument, erected by the Masons, is an obelisk, which is defined in architectural dictionaries as a symbol of sun worship originating in ancient Egypt (the same monument stands in St. Peter's Square, in the courtyard of the Vatican — or "place of divination" — in Rome). Their (vain) philosophy is that man was held prisoner in the Garden of Eden by an unjust, vindictive and cruel God by the name of Jehovah, or Yahweh, and that man was set free from the chains, the bonds of ignorance by Lucifer, or Satan, with the "gift" of intellect — knowledge — the knowledge of Good and Evil, and that through the use of this Knowledge, man himself can become god. We saw this played out in the movie, "2001, A Space Odyssey," when the ape that touched the moonlit (or torch) light like an obelisk from the angle it is shown from was imparted knowledge. This is also shown in a quick cut of the monolith from a low angle at its base, giving us the image of a truncated pyramid with the capstone missing, with the sun at the top, the very symbol of Masonic initiation.

Today, this religion permeates our society. In 1980, John Dunphy wrote in the Humanist magazine, "The classroom must and will become an arena of conflict between the old and the new — the rotting corpse of Christianity, together with all its adjacent evils and miseries, and the new faith of Humanism." One example of this is the fact that in the classroom today, evolution is favored over creationism. This is in spite of the fallacies of the evolution theory. At the International Congress of Zoology in 1958, Dr. A.J.E. Cave said that his examination of the famous "Neanderthal" skeleton, which was found in 1908, was identical to that of a modern man.

Explosion Report on Oklahoma City Bombing

A5 came down but the heavier column A1 did not. At circle 3 level, Column B2 came down, but just beyond B3, columns B2 and B4 did not come down. Therefore, circle 3 is marginal for the columns in row B which are much smaller than the odd numbered columns in row A. Moreover, the higher numbered columns in row A are seeing more of a lower side-on-pressure than column row B.

For any odd numbered column failure in row A, the adjacent even numbered columns would also necessarily fail. The still standing, extended, cantilevered header, from A1 almost back to where A8 was, is probably due to the seasaw effect, over A7, as an instant pivot point, as the A row collapsed sequentially to the right by either the truck bomb or supplemental demolition charges. If the header at column A8 had survived explosives, cascading floors could have caused it to fail. However, one would not expect such a long remaining cantilever.

From what has been stated thus far, and considering only the potential damage from the truck bomb, there is a number of problems.

A. If column A7 was brought down by the truck bomb, then most of the much smaller columns B1, B2, B4, B5 and B6 should not be still standing but they are.

B. Conversely, a truck bomb that could not bring down columns B1, B2, B4, and B5 could certainly not be expected to collapse the lower two floors of a much heavier column A7. Thus columns A7 and A8 should still be standing which they are not.

C. For a simplistic blast truck bomb, of the size and composition reported, to be able to reach out on the order of 60 feet and collapse a reinforced column base the size of column A7 is beyond credulity. Even bringing down B3 at its range is highly suspect. Glass and plastic can be broken a long way off with explosives but not heavy, reinforced, concrete columns.

If demolition charges were used to complement the truck bomb, the above problems all disappear. Was it practicable? Yes, for the following reasons:

- Columns A2, A5, A7, A9 were readily accessible from the sidewalk or curb.
- Adequate demolition charges could have easily been put in position.
- A simple permacord interconnect would not look too difficult from a piece of clothesline or coaxial cord.
- If the bomb attack was desired to do more than deface the building, then inside help or loose security may have permitted placement of a charge at B3. (If they can have an Ames in CIA counterintelligence why can't they have someone, if needed, in Oklahoma City?)
- The pay off of the leftist, internationalist, implementation of a "world commonwealth of independent

states" as a prelude to the "withering away of the state" would merit highest level planning and implementation of the Oklahoma bombing if it could result in new legislation to criminalize the patriotic support of Constitutional rights.

Who profits from the Oklahoma City bombing? Who wants to exploit it? Since 1928, the Third International program calls for the USA to be transitioned to socialism via "The National Liberation" (See Degras, *The Communist International Documents*, 1919-1943, Vol. 2, Page 471 "Program of the Communist International Adopted at its Sixth Congress" and page 526 "Extracts from the Thesis on the Revolutionary Movement in Colonial and Semi-Colonial Countries Adopted by the Sixth Comintern Congress"). We are by their definition a Colonial Country because of the "oppressed nations within." Before moving from the "preparatory phase" to the "period of escalating violence," and orthodox procedure is to "(1) seek removal of the death penalty, and (2) disarm the public." Few things could have been more effective in moving pending draconian anti-terrorist legislation that would criminalize armed patriots in this country while making the job easier for the programmed "War of the Nations."

The gross asymmetry in the federal building damage pattern is ipso facto evidence that there was most probably a demolition charge effort and a truck bomb effort. They need not have known each other but it would have to have been coordinated at some level. That coordination could have been accomplished from almost any location in the world. Are there local parties, disturbed or greedy people available to help? Always.

Efforts of this magnitude and criticality are generally orchestrated by an outside team sent in for the limited purpose. In such cases, the usefulness of FBI infiltration of domestic organizations is totally circumvented. A classic example was the communist arranged assassination of Dr. Gaitain in Columbia in 1948. However, the blame was put on the conservative government in power to precipitate violence against the government and disrupt the meeting of the InterAmerican Defense Board in Bogota. (See Weyl, *Red Star Over Cuba*, p. 15.) The strong people were deliberately blamed to precipitate a desired public reaction.

Nothing did more to sway public opinion against "assault" weapons than the killings with "assault" weapons at Lubegs, McDonalds, a school yard, etc. Who orchestrated them? The same goes for the Oklahoma City bombing and currently pending legislation to make support of the Second and Tenth Amendments a domestic terrorism issue.

Since the Oklahoma bomb tragedy, this country has seen one of the most intense, and most pervasive psycho-political campaigns against the so called Christian Right that has ever occurred before in this country, against any group at any time. It far exceeds the anti-McCarthy antipathy of the 1950's and 60's. Its magnitude cannot be appreciated without browsing current periodical material in a big library.

During the early Kennedy Administration there was a clamor to make an example of some anti-communists in the military. General Edwin Walker became a target because of his pro-blue program within his command in Europe. After he retired to Dallas, Lee Harvey Oswald tried to assassinate him about two weeks after Oswald received the mail order gun he was later to use in the Kennedy Assassination. Terrorism is pervasive today primarily because of the multiplicity of wars of National Liberation now underway and moving toward the period of escalating violence. The greatest of all advocates of terrorism was none other than Leon Trotsky whose position was that if you do not support terrorism you do not support the cause. He even wrote a book to justify his position.

The 5-15-95 *Spotlight* carried an article quoting, "Ex-high level FBI Official" that the bomb was a pineapple size high-tech device. In my opinion what they describe is part nonsense and part a fuel air explosive (FAE) device. Some large FAE devices were made to clear helicopter landing spaces in Vietnam jungles. It appears to be an obfuscation capitalizing on nullibility. The big explosion in Japan recently was an "accidental" Fuel Air Explosion. The "ping" in your car engine is a fueled air explosion.

The second delay between two events reported by a University of Oklahoma seismologist doesn't make sense. No triangulation was reported to assure the same point of origin. If there was a second large explosion, with a 10 second delay, everyone in Oklahoma City would have discerned it. Any time delay for two stage devices, or for demolition charges at column bases, would have been in milliseconds or microseconds and would have been most probably been controlled by primacord length which denotes at about a 1/4 inch per microsecond — that is about the same speed as an orbiting satellite.

(Editor's Note: *CAJN News Service* has interviewed eyewitnesses in Oklahoma City who distinctly heard two explosions. Also, the initial reports by various news services also reported two explosions.)

Because of the psycho-political operation going on at the present time against a "Christian right" bogeyman; records in Waco, Idaho, California and other places, and the high level promotion of censured officials, I would strongly urge that the U.S. Congress take steps to assure that evidence in Oklahoma City be independently evaluated by a collection of demolition experts from the private sector before the building is demolished. It is easy to determine whether a column was failed by contact demolition charges or by air blast loading. It is also easy to cover up crucial evidence as was apparently done in Waco. I understand the building is to be demolished by May 23rd or 24th. Why the rush to destroy evidence?

I discussed this with your assistant, Lee Morris, early in the month.

Waco Murder Sanctioned

In an interesting exchange on CNN's Capitol Gang show Saturday 4/22/95, Robert Reich stated the difference between the murder at WACO and the murder at the Federal building in Oklahoma. He stated that both were murder, but only one was sanctioned by the U.S. government.

Which one Robert?

Letter to all Senate and House Members:

Frequently critics of the constitutional debates sweeping the country today will assert that the Framers of our Constitution could not possibly have known what the present day United States is about. They contend that we live in a global marketplace with responsibilities to ourselves and our neighbors. Crime on our streets we know it's not even an issue, these critics claim, to those involved with the American War for Independence. They would have us draw the conclusion that our Constitution was meant for a different time and is inadequate to deal with the world as we know it today.

In 1761, King George was issuing "writs of assistance" to his tax collectors. These writs permitted no-knock searches of private houses, and homes without a warrant by the King's agents, ostensibly looking for contraband. It was these writs that led to the insertion of the Fourth Amendment to our Bill of Rights.

That Amendment states, "The Right of the People to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched and the persons or things to be seized." It means we have a right to be secure without fear the government will intrude without probable cause.

Recently, the US House of Representatives passed HR-666. This resolution states that evidence obtained with or without a warrant will be admissible in court if the evidence was obtained under a "reasonable objective belief" that the gaining of the evidence was consistent with the Fourth Amendment.

In other words, neither probable cause nor warrants will be necessary if the agents have a reasonable objective belief that evidence is necessary. At Concord in 1775, British general Thomas gage used informants to determine the location of caches of arms held by the patriots. His intention was to march through and seize the arms, in particular the cannon, thereby disabling the ability of the patriots to resist. The British fetish about banning arms led to the Second Amendment to secure, supposedly forever, the Right of the People to defend themselves against the government.

Last year, the Congress passed the Crime Control Act, which banned "assault weapons," some by model name and others by descriptions so vague that over 190 actual models of weapons will actually be banned. The ban has led to the greatest caching of weapons and ammunition in the hands of private citizens who could possibly imagine.

Coincidentally, one of the commanders of the British forces during the War for Independence was General Henry Clinton.

In 1783, the Treaty of Paris concluded the War for Independence and the colonies were declared to be free and sovereign states, our Constitution would not have been adopted had the Tenth Amendment not been added to ensure Freedom and Liberty for States and individuals.

Last year, Congress adopted the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT), which effectively abolished sovereignty not only for States, but also our nation. It brings any state or federal law under the control of the World Trade Organization. This law was heavily promoted by the internationalists who view state sovereignty with contempt. Any person who supported GATT should not be given future opportunities to violate that person's oath to the nation.

The Constitution was not written about the life and times of 1789, when the Bill of Rights was adopted. It was written about tyranny; it was written about Freedom; it was written about Liberty; it was written about the Framers of our Constitution who understood that 1995 is about. The challenge for us is to understand what 1776 was about.

THE CONSTITUTION PARTY

Advocating State Rights and State Citizenship

We, the founders of the Constitution Party, hold that our federal government has consistently violated the Constitution for the United States of America. The Founding Fathers designed the U.S. government to serve us - the people. It was not designed so that we the people would serve government. We no longer wish to see Americans dependent upon or enslaved by government. Generations of Republican and Democratic administrations have made it abundantly clear that they are incapable of managing the nation's affairs competently, justly or lawfully. The CP is dedicated to ensuring the unalienable right of every American to Life, Liberty, Property and the Pursuit of Happiness by defending the Constitution for the United States of America and making certain that it stays the law of the land.

The right to own one's life is a natural right. It requires the rights to freedom and property ownership in order to sustain that life. Therefore, the CP holds that no one has the right to dictate to anyone else how to live. It further maintains that no one holds a higher moral authority to compel anyone else to behave in a particular way. The CP maintains that each individual has the right to behave according to his or her self-determined moral principles, provided the pursuit of these principles causes no physical harm to any other person or his property. The CP believes that if there is no victim there is no crime. The CP believes that no entity, including a majority of voters or citizens, may take away or violate the rights of an individual.

Accordingly, the CP calls for a reordering of national priorities. We aim to restore the right of every individual American to be a sovereign citizen, as well as the provision that all 50 states be free from unlawful federal interference so they can self-govern. Our goal is to create a truly free country where all people will learn to be responsible for their own welfare. Upon achieving this goal, enterprise will flourish, thereby creating an atmosphere of prosperity, abundance, tolerance and compassion.

Therefore, the CP offers the following platform to ensure our rights and those of our children:

1. Under no circumstance does the federal government have the power to violate the Constitutionally guaranteed rights of an individual.
2. Under no circumstance does the federal government have the power to violate the sovereignty of the states as defined in the 10th Amendment to the Constitution.
3. Each individual should be free to do whatever he chooses with his own person or property, provided he does not physically harm the person or property of another. People who harm others are to be forcibly segregated from the rest of society by government. It is society, not the criminal, that should be shown leniency.
4. The CP supports full private property rights. We reject the idea that federal government may dictate use of private property or confiscate property without full and just compensation pursuant to the limits of the Constitution.
5. Each individual adult has the right to keep and bear arms, providing the owner has never been convicted of a violent crime involving the use of a weapon.
6. The CP advocates the maintenance of the strongest national defense force in the world. The CP does not advocate military interference in the affairs of other nations. The CP further believes that the U.S. should protect its sovereignty by maintaining full control over its own defense systems and not turning them over the United Nations.
7. The CP advocates full financial freedom. The CP believes that individuals have the right to keep all money or property they have lawfully earned, to provide for themselves and their families. The CP believes it is not government's business to know how much money you earn, where your money or property is kept, or to require you to keep records on its behalf. Accordingly, it believes that government has no right to use any of its agencies to intimidate people into revealing how much money they have or earn, with threats of jail terms and property seizures. Government has no right to force an individual to report how much money he or she deposits or withdraws from a bank. It also has no right to force an individual to report how much money he or she takes into or out of the country. These laws force Americans to spy and report on each other.
8. This stance requires the elimination of the Internal Revenue Service and the income tax code, the elimination of all gift and estate taxes, as well as any other direct tax not authorized under the Constitution for the United States of America. To the extent revenue is needed to support the federal government, within the limits of the Constitution, excise taxes (i.e. a national sales tax) are authorized in Article I, Section 8 of the Constitution.
9. The elimination of these unlawful taxes would cause business to skyrocket, create millions of jobs, and significantly reduce unemployment and welfare lines. It would also reduce crime. The CP calls for repeal of the 16th Amendment or formal recognition by the government that it was never ratified by the states and is therefore illegal.
10. The CP calls for the reinstatement of sound money, preferably a hard dollar backed by gold.
11. The CP insists upon the elimination of the budget deficit by a rigorous program of downsizing federal government and eliminating entitlement programs. The CP also calls for the elimination of burdensome interest payments on the national debt by ridding the American people of this debt once and for all.

10. The CP advocates the elimination of entitlement programs. Just as no individual has the right to steal from you, the government has no right to steal from you on behalf of other individuals, that is, to redistribute your wealth. The money you earn belongs to you and no one else. How can you properly support yourself and your family while you are constantly being robbed? The price of personal freedom is individual responsibility. Consequently, it is not government's job to "save" people from poor choices, calamities, or the vicissitudes of life. At the same time, the CP encourages everyone, individuals and private institutions alike, in the strongest possible terms, to give to the charities of their choice, to care for the homeless, the helpless, and the needy. Charity is traditionally the work of religious organizations, individuals, private institutions and foundations. In contrast, giveaway programs run by the federal government rob individuals of the ability and desire to be charitable.

The CP further believes that the elimination of giveaway programs will greatly alleviate the nation's immigration problem. The CP believes in phasing out the Social Security program after current obligations to the elderly are met. We believe retirement programs are best handled by the private sector.

11. The CP believes that federal government has no lawful or moral authority in health care. The CP believes that government involvement in health care will adversely affect the health of the majority of Americans.

The CP believes that federal government has no right to limit our choice of doctors, or medicines they prescribe, whether they be "alternative" or American Medical Association certified. Government also has no right to dictate what vitamins ought to be available.

The CP opposes the proposed national health card. This card will ultimately be used as nothing less than a national tracking device that will result in the further loss of personal freedom.

12. The CP endorses full economic freedom. The CP believes that government should not set prices, set quotas, or create laws concerning hiring, firing, rents, wages, unionization, or any aspect of non-coercive private commercial behavior. Economic freedom would be a boon to both small and large business.

13. Government does not have the right to legislate morality. Adult consensual behavior ("victimless crimes") are a matter of individual adult morality and not a matter of lawful statute. The traditional organizations for discussion and persuasion regarding moral issues include churches, synagogues, youth clubs, chambers of commerce, and other local social organizations.

14. The CP advocates a strong local police presence for violent crime. By eliminating laws against victimless crimes, police will be able to focus on violent crimes, making police more effective and public safety a reality. The prison system will then have ample space to house violent criminals for the full course of their prison terms. The streets will be safe, the country's legal and prison systems will unclutter, and vast amounts of money that add to the budget deficit will be saved.

Nevertheless, a government that must break the law in order to enforce the law is not a government worth having. Therefore, law enforcement officers and agencies must be above reproach with regard to due process of law, personal privacy, freedom from unreasonable search and seizures, and all the other fundamental constitutional guarantees. The CP believes that any government agent or employee who does not abide by, or who violates the Constitution should face mandatory criminal penalties.

15. The CP believes that all judges must be directed to inform every jury of its lawful sovereignty under the Constitution in that it may find any defendant not guilty if it judges the law, even law upheld by the Supreme Court, to be defective, unwarranted, unconstitutional, or wrongly applied.

The CP believes that we are at the beginning of a movement, a movement toward individual freedoms, as our Forefathers planned. We believe that people have had enough of the taxes and the intimidating tactics of an out-of-control, unaccountable government which has lost sight of its role as our servant. We believe it is time again to make the government accountable to us - the American people - and to restore our personal freedoms which have been slowly but systematically taken from us. We believe that if we as a people fail to act, the course on which the ship of state is currently set is clear: an accelerating bankrupt socialist police state.

To all Americans who want to keep their rights: whether it be the right to speak your mind, the right to keep the money you earn, the right to use your property as you wish, the right to bear arms for the defense of your family from any threat including government, the right to engage in noncoercive behavior, the right to not wear a seatbelt or a motorcycle helmet, the right to choose a doctor or the medicine of your choice, the right to end your life, or the right to begin a life - these are your personal choices, not the government's.

To all Americans who feel alienated from the politics of our system and are tired of being treated like juveniles: we understand your frustration and your desire for change. Come join us! No matter who you are or what you do, come join us. It's not whether you are on the left or the right, liberal or conservative, it's your individual rights that matter.

the article's title, "Searching for dollars: founding science today."

From the top of the lighthouse comes a strong white shaft of light (LUX) which represents the final climax of this extended union as the light penetrates its way through the many clouds that represent illusions and limitations.

If you still doubt that sex symbolism is very much alive today, see the *Jeaneer* commercial on page 15 of this same January 1995 issue of *Omni* magazine. Sex sells: jeans, TV, movies and beliefs.

The whole world scenario of this idyllic symbolism in science is accurately depicted on the U.S. one dollar note. First take out \$1 note and examine the back side (side with the pyramid) with a magnifying glass. The number 1 symbolizes the erect phallus and the "0" shown twice on this side of the bill is the female entrance for reproduction. The "perfect number," also called "the number of completion" is 10, which represents the two sexes united to create life. The Greek letter delta (Δ), an upward triangle, not only represents fire; it represents the male phallus. Coincidentally, this is the secret meaning behind the name for the infamous delta force. On the \$1 note, a pyramid, the phallus is inside one of the two circles or zeros "0". This combination shows creative union. In the most famous of all Egyptian mystery stories, Osiris, the first "Sun of God" of many futures, only begotten "Sons of God", was murdered in a plot by his jealous brother Set. Set cut Osiris into 14 parts; 13 parts were later recovered by Osiris's wife-sister and Queen, Isis. The one missing part, his penis had been thrown into the ocean and eaten by fish. The 13 layers of the pyramid on our dollar bill is symbolic of the body of Osiris. Above this is a suspended capstone, a small pyramid, representing the famous lost word of freemasonry "the Penis", the letter delta (Δ) or triangle. The capstone is the missing 14th part of Osiris, sun god of the Freemasonic mysteries. This is what they all searched for.

Opposite this pyramid is another "0" which contains an eagle and a combination of 13 stars sending outward moving lux, light rays. Around this is a band of 14 puffy white clouds, symbolic of the 14 parts of Osiris which successfully enclose all the light rays from the eagle that represents the American people. The number 13 is also the 12 signs of the zodiac with the symbol of the sun (of God) in the middle. There is a pattern of two interlocking triangles. The triangle with the upward point is the male, penis, delta (Δ), one (1), pillar and fire; it burns upward to a pointed zenith. The triangle with the downward point is the female, water; it falls to a center and is reminiscent of the public triangular hair pattern of a naked female. The 13th star in the center is the hole at the end of the phallus which spews out the creative force, LUX at the point of sexual climax as in the lighthouse

discussed above. A similar symbol, also much used in Freemasonry is the circle "O" with a point down in its center. This so-called 6-pointed star was much later referred to as "the Seal of Solomon" or "Star of David".

For phallic worshippers, this LUX, the creative ejaculation of the male is the example of man's found procreative abilities that he discovered in the garden of Eden as his tree of knowledge penetrated the midst or middle of Eve's garden. This discovery made man a God and a creator, free to be independent of an overlord, an all controlling jealous god.

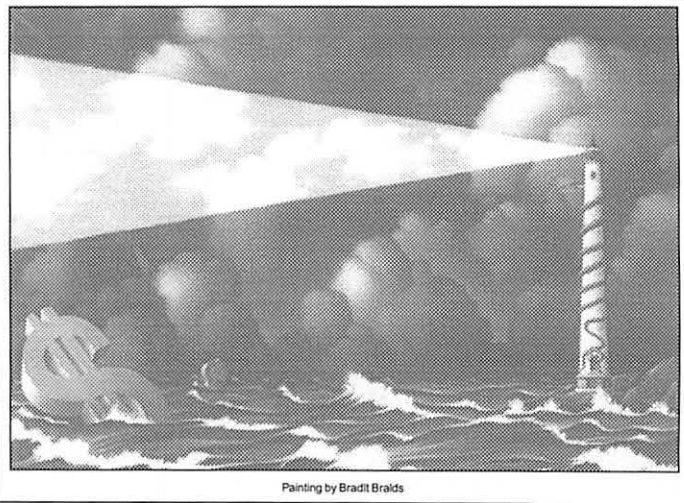
Let us see what our children are learning and remember what we learned in the Walt Disney movies and other popular movies of our past.

Base Closure Revenues Severely Overestimated

WASHINGTON - Revenues from the sale of land on shutdown military bases have been grossly overestimated, congress has reported.

Property sales are far below what was expected from 120 base closings that were initiated in 1988 and 1991, the General Accounting Office revealed. Eighty-eight percent of the land was either retained by the Defense Department or transferred to other federal or state agencies at no charge.

The Pentagon's original projection for revenue of \$4.1 billion from property sales was revised to \$1.2 billion in 1994. Yet, as of the end of 1994, property sales only produced \$69.4 million, with another \$22.2 million in pending sales.

Rep. Al McCandless, R-Calif., who commissioned the study, stated that he was shocked by the failure of the base closings to produce the promise of reducing the federal deficit.

"The findings of the GAO suggest that despite rhetoric to the contrary, the Defense Department's actions reveal its primary concern is to unload unwanted properties with little regard to the effects on job creation and deficit reduction," he said.

The base closings were supposed to cut military costs and produce revenues from sale of lands to the private sector.

Disputes over who should have access to the land and sever environmental contamination of some of the bases have slowed the transfer of property.

According to the GAO, 110,000 of the 192,000 acres available on 37 bases that were examined were either retained by the Pentagon or transferred to other federal agencies. Almost half of this land contains unexploded ordnance.

An additional 60,000 acres most likely will be transferred at no charge to state and local agencies for airports, parks, economic development, education and homeless assistance, the GAO said.

one study showed the fact that by far the largest number of fractures occurred in a period stretching from February through June. Why is there a two-month to six-month time lag between the shortest days of the year (the third week in December) and the appearance of fractures caused by weakened bones? Well, vitamin D is fat-soluble and thus easily stored by the body. Your body tissue cupboards may be full to overflowing by the end of the summer and not run out until late winter or even early summer. So it's important to take advantage of sunny weather whenever you can.¹¹ There are many other reasons for a calcium imbalance which can lead to fractures, so a complete nutritional evaluation would be helpful to make sure the problem is solved on the first try.

Vitamin D is best utilized with vitamin A. Most of our vitamin D needs are met with some vitamin D in foods and regular sunlight exposure. If you live in smoggy cities or where tall buildings block the sunlight, you may need more vitamin D. Those who work nights or cover their bodies with lots of clothes, as do members of some religious orders, probably need more vitamin D than the avid sunbather. In winter, we usually require more D from supplements or from our foods.¹² Since vitamin D is stored in the fat of your body you will want to be cautious in taking a vitamin supplement of vitamin D so you don't end up with toxic levels of this vitamin in your body. Usually a multi-vitamin that contains 400 I.U. of vitamin D is all that you need each day to meet the needs of your body. The only time that you need more is if the urine and saliva pH's both test too low. Then still the vitamin D is administered cautiously according to the test results.¹³

Provitamin D is found mainly in animal foods. D3, or "natural" vitamin D, is found in fish liver oil, which is the traditional source of both A and D. Cod liver oil is a commonly used source. Egg yolks and butter have some D, as do the oily fish, such as mackerel, salmon, sardines, and herring.¹⁴

THE PICNIC

There is a lot more information to cover in future articles about other vitamins which are manufactured by your body. You can see that with a little forethought it is easy to avoid nutritional bankruptcy of Vitamins A and D. This can be a good excuse to take a stroll in the park and have a picnic in the sunshine. Your picnic can include a sandwich of salmon on whole grain bread, a carrot cut in sticks, then have yogurt and peaches for desert. You will then have eaten all of the Vitamin A and D necessary for the day. The sunshine, fresh air and relaxation will also do tremendous things for your well-being.

free, such as will Bill Clinton's preacher. Thus, Pike is an illusionist, a conjurer, teaching his priesthood the means of controlling their squads of initiates. But what is the underlying belief? In France in 1889, Pike said: "That which we must say to the crowd is, we worship a God, but it is the God one adores without superstition. The Masonic religion should be, by all of its initiates of the high degrees, maintained in the purity of the Luciferian Doctrine. If Lucifer were not God, would Adonay (the God of the Christians) whose deeds prove his cruelty, perfidy and hatred of man, barbarism and repulsion to science, would Adonay and his priests call him God?"

"Yes Lucifer is God, and unfortunately Adonay is also God. For the eternal law is that there is no light without shade, no beauty without ugliness, no white without black, for the absolute can only exist as two Gods. Thus, the doctrine of Satanism is a heresy; and the true and pure philosophical religion is the belief in Lucifer, the equal of Adonay, but Lucifer, God of Light and God of Good, is struggling for humanity against Adonay, the God of Darkness and Evil."

The Terror Project

The Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, an instrument of British Empire strategy, directed a continuous offensive of murder and racist terrorism against the U.S.A. and neighboring countries, during the middle decades of the last century. We shall trace this endeavor, from the U.S. occupation of Mexico in the Mexican War (1846-48), to the slaveowners' rebellion or U.S. Civil War (1861-65), through the Ku Klux Klan's war against Reconstruction of the South (1867-1870s).

A few individuals will come into view repeatedly as gang leaders and project directors: Boston's (Albert Pike), boss of Arkansas; New York's (John Slidell), boss of Louisiana; Slidell's nephew and partner, British bankers August Belmont, Boss of the Democratic Party; Slidell's trustee and partner, Britain's (Judah Benjamin), boss of the Confederate secret service.

Patriots such as then-Congressman Abraham Lincoln saw the 1846 U.S. invasion of Mexico as a crime and folly, pushed by strategists of slavery who also aimed at the destruction of the U.S.A. Transplanted Southern

Democrat John Slidell, and Whig leader Caleb Cushing, spokesman for Boston's opium and slave-running forces, had both planned and promoted the attack on Mexico.

As the first U.S. war of aggression drew to a close, volunteer General John A. Quitman became the military governor and dictator over Mexico City. The U.S.A. prepared to seize Mexico's northern territory, the area from California to Texas. Yet Quitman proposed to President Polk a plan for the forcible annexation of all Mexico, to be an area for negro slave plantations.

During the peace negotiations, Quitman traveled as a conquering hero to Charleston, South Carolina. He was crowned a Sovereign Grand Inspector General of the Scottish Rite, and became the most powerful and prominent member of the Rite's Supreme Council.

John Quitman's grandfather was governor of the island of Curacao, the Dutch West India Company's slave concentration camp; his parents had fled the Caribbean slave revolts, taking their slaves with them, to Texas, where John was born. In 1830, young Quitman had been formally commissioned by the Scottish Rite, leaders of the secession movement, to establish their organization in the state of Mississippi.

In the autumn of 1849, General Quitman held a meeting of anti-Union operatives from throughout the South. They resolved to call a formal convention of the Southern states for the following June, to begin the breakup of the United States.

Quitman became governor of Mississippi in January 1850, and his Nashville secession convention met from June 3 to 12. Delegates from nine states proclaimed the rights of slaveholders. Quitman and his clique meanwhile moved to provoke immediate civil war. He proposed to lead a private army from Texas, to conquer the new U.S. territory of New Mexico on behalf of slavery.

President Zachary Taylor faced Quitman down. President Taylor was determined to bring the new southwest into the Union as free states. On June 21, 1850, nine days after the secession convention, Governor Quitman was indicted by a federal grand jury for violating the U.S. Neutrality Laws!

The charge was based on Quitman's leadership of a well-financed conspiracy to invade and "liberate" Cuba from Spanish rule. Then two weeks later, on July 3, President Taylor threatened to hang those "taken in rebellion against the Union." The next day the President fell ill, vomited blackish material, and died soon after. The Quitman prosecution was delayed. (You may recall that Taylor's body was recently dug up by Kentucky author-

ties, looking for evidence of arsenic poisoning.)

The following summer, 1851, Quitman brought fellow Mississippian Jefferson Davis to Massachusetts to meet with Caleb Cushing. They picked the man to be nominated by the Democrats for the U.S. presidency; volunteer General Franklin Pierce, a member of their clique in the Mexican War. Pierce surprised everyone by taking the nomination at the convention. Then, August Belmont, the U.S. representative of Britain's Rothschild banks, paid for Pierce's 1852 election campaign.

Though this blatant foreign intrusion caused a flare-up of resentment among the voters, Pierce was elected the 14th President, and his foreign and domestic backer took over. Caleb Cushing became U.S. attorney general. Jefferson Davis became secretary of war. Banker August Belmont became ambassador to Holland.

Scottish Rite chief John Quitman was now ready for serious business. Some months earlier, when he had finally gone to trial, he was fortunate that Louisiana private attorney Judah Benjamin had been specially hired by the federal government to run the prosecution against Quitman. The jury was hung (rather than Quitman) and the charges were dropped. This outcome should not be too surprising to us, given prosecutor Benjamin's own growing role in the faction of which Gen. Quitman was then the shining star. Benjamin joined Slidell as a U.S. senator from Louisiana at the next election, and was a leader of the slaveowners' insurrectionary government.

Let's look for a minute at the trio of Slidell, Belmont, and Benjamin. Slidell had a master's degree in political dry tricks, learned as a member of Aaron Burr's machine in New York and Louisiana. Slidell had politically schooled Belmont and had brought him into the Democratic Party, and Belmont married Slidell's niece. Slidell had also virtually adopted, taught and brought into politics the young Judah Benjamin, a British West Indian Jew living in Louisiana. Both Belmont, and his banking client Benjamin, were passionate backers of the expansion of slavery into Latin America.

When he was a young private secretary for the Rothschild family, Belmont had toured continental Europe doing financial and political intelligence work for the Rothschild bank, a pillar of the British royal family. With Britain meddling in Spain's civil war, the Rothschilds had sent Belmont off to the Spanish colony of Cuba in 1837 to "take charge of Rothschild interests" in Cuba. Belmont's ship stopped over in New York and

Bizzare Guru Taught FAA Staff Sensitivity Training Seminars

WASHINGTON - A congressional panel was told by the Federal Aviation Administration chief that the "human potential guru's" bizarre "sensitivity training" given to FAA employees did not compromise air safety.

However, FAA Administrator David Hinson condemned what he called "time-wasting training techniques where participants were ridiculed and embarrassed in training sessions supposedly to increase awareness of sexual harassment and racism.

Hinson called the techniques "unacceptable," before the House Appropriations subcommittee that oversees the FAA and its parent, the Department of Transportation.

Gregory May, who gave the training seminars, was described as a "purveyor of New Age and human-potential philosophy," by Todd Zinser, Transportation Department deputy assistant inspector general.

May is a follower of J.Z. Knight, a woman who says she is the medium for

Ramtha, a 35,000-year-old warrior from the lost continent of Atlantis.

Complaints arose two years ago about May from FAA employees who brought the issue to public attention. Federico Pena, Transportation Secretary suspended the sessions and ordered an investigation by the department's inspector general.

May taught that all blacks hate whites, and battered women bring abuse on themselves.

His teaching techniques included participants being tied together for 24 hours, in addition to parading male employees past female co-workers instructed to grope the men's genitals.

Seminar participants were required to undress down to their underwear in front of colleagues and recite past sexual abuse or dysfunction. Subcommittee Chairman Rep. Frank Wolf, R-Va. said,

"Are we entering the Twilight Zone?" Wolf asked. "No, this is what these FAA managers selected as the training for those who make our airports and skies safe."

The FAA is incorporating the inspector general's recommendations for improving training seminars.

he never went to Cuba, but his subsequent U.S. banking and political career was often focused on Cuba's wealth and strategic location.

Following the 1823 presidential inauguration of their candidate Pierre, Scottish Rite chief John Quitman and his New York financiers signed a formal agreement making Quitman the "civil and military chief of the revolution" which they would impose on Cuba. Once he had seized the island, Quitman was due to receive \$1 million from the proceeds of the revolutionary bonds the financiers were floating.

Quitman's criminal enterprise recruited as many as 40,000 U.S. mercenaries for the cause. But the Spanish authorities behind these plans to grief. They emancipated most of Cuba's slaves, encouraged racial intermarriage, armed the freed blacks and recruited them into a militia through which they could defend their own freedom from the Spanish attackers. The Spanish governor arrested Quitman's intriguer, Captain James D. Bulloch, when Bulloch brought his ship, the *Black Warrior*, into Havana.

Senator John Slidell of Louisiana demanded the U.S. neutrality laws be repealed. Attorney General Caleb Cushing called for a naval blockade around Cuba. But given the military realities, snarled heads prevailed, and Quitman was placed under legal restraint.

After the *Black Warrior* affair, the Quitman mercenary force was absorbed into a new, more aggressive movement with enlarged aims. The *Knights of the Golden Circle* appeared first in Cincinnati, under the supervision of the Scottish Rite's midwest organizer Killian Van Rensselaer, a longtime underground military operative for Britain in North America. So Cincinnati was the northern capital of the pro-slavery, Masonic terrorist underground. From there the Knights spread throughout Ohio, Indiana and Illinois, down the Mississippi to the Gulf south, and into Maryland and Virginia to surround the national capital.

The Golden Circle was to be a new slave empire centered in Cuba. It would break up the U.S.A. and conquer Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean. The Knights spread and drilled up to 100,000 were the emigrants, raiders, rapists, and slaveholders. They were organized into lodges called "castles," with Masonic signs, grips, and passwords. They were to kill the hated Catholic Hispanics, and fill their places with black slaves brought fresh from Africa. This is the first "North American Free Trade Agreement!"

(The Masonic imperialism of the Franklin Pierce administration lives on as the romantic, elite legend of the Eastern Establishment. They celebrate that legend in the marriage of President Pierce's blood relative, Elizabeth Pierce to George Bush, whose imperial ideas are rooted in the events of the 1850's.)

Led by Quitman and his allies in the lower South, the Knights of the Golden Circle formed the heart of the secession military machine as the crisis of the Union deepened.

But John Quitman died in July 1858. The Scottish Rite leadership was then totally reorganized. Albert Pike was brought into the Supreme Council and, in 1859, Pike was elevated to Commander of the Southern Jurisdiction. While the Knights of the Golden Circle intensified their terrorist activities in Texas, and their "filibuster" raids into Mexico and Central America, Albert Pike pulled together the inner core of a revolutionary government for the U.S. southern states.

As Albert Pike said himself, Pike had not even heard of the Scottish Rite until 1853. Sponsored by his fellow Bostonian, Attorney General Caleb Cushing, who inserted Pike's cronies into office for him in the 1840's, Pike had become the boss of Arkansas politics. He had proven his "Southernness" by running racial hysteria campaigns against Arkansas's handful of freed blacks and against America's Catholic immigrants.

Joining Pike's new Scottish Rite Supreme Council in 1859 was the U.S. vice president, John C. Breckinridge of Kentucky. He would soon run for President on a secession platform, his campaign managed by Caleb Cushing.

In March 1860, the U.S. treasury secretary, Howell Cobb, joined Pike's Supreme Council. Cobb was the boss of the Georgia Masonic Mafia with Robert Toombs and James Bulloch.) If you are going to lead a revolt against a government, it is handy to have the head of that government's treasury take charge of your finances, as Cobb did for his Masonic boss, Albert Pike.

Cobb resigned his treasury post in December 1860, following Abraham Lincoln's election to the U.S. presidency. Two months later, Cobb was president of the convention in Alabama, which created the Confederate government and broke up the United States. Cobb's name appears at the top of signers of the Confederate Constitution, a document which Cobb and Albert Pike are supposed to have drafted together.

The Lost Cause

The rebellion of the Southern slaveowners, which brought on the Civil War, was a British Empire-sponsored insurrection. The British supplied the arms used by the anti-U.S. insurgents, and the Confederate secret service activities in North America and Europe. These expanded efforts continued the political and irregular military operations of the Scottish Rite which had been led by Quitman, and by Pike after Quitman's death.

For the final three years of the four-year Civil War, Judah P. Benjamin served as Confederate secretary of state. Benjamin supervised the financial and supply relations to the British Empire and its ally, Napoleon III of France, and ran the Confederacy's international network of spies and saboteurs.

Benjamin's secret service liaison man in England and the Confederacy's chief arms procurer there was James Bulloch. We remember Bulloch as the man who had been arrested in Cuba during Quitman's 1854 fiasco.

John Slidell became the famous Confederate commissioner to France who was to be married to his daughter, Mathilde to Baron Emile Erlanger. The baron was an eminent German-French Jewish banker, closely tied to the British government and the highest levels of British Freemasonry. Slidell and Benjamin negotiated the famous Erlanger Loan, the series of Confederate war bonds floated by this banker. They sold the bonds primarily to British oligarchs who felt poisonous hatred for the American republic. The collateral for the Erlanger loan was Southern slave cotton, that was smuggled out past the Union blockade.

John Slidell handled relations between the French Empire and the Masonic "filibusters," the raiders of Latin America. Slidell promoted the joint European-Confederate invasion of Mexico in the 1860's.

The Confederacy's secret service, meanwhile, attempted to weaken the resolve of the Union to carry on the war. The key to their strategy was the old Knights of the Golden Circle, still in place in the north, midwest and southwest, involving pro-slavery whites and American Indians.

Sioux Indians, strangely organized into military Masonic lodges, wiped out 700 citizens of New Ulm, Minnesota and the surrounding area, while the town's young men were in the Union Army. Albert Pike was at the time the Confederate general officially in charge of arranging Indian attacks against the Union, Minnesota was also part of Commander Pike's Masonic Southern Jurisdiction.

Judah Benjamin based his main secret service group in Montreal when since Canada was then still British territory. They coordinated across the border with Golden Circle networks in Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, and Wisconsin, and with the August Belmont Democratic Party machine in New York. Agents led by Jacob Thompson planned prison breaks, tried to burn down northern cities, and instigated anti-draft riots in which drunken mobs lynched black people and burned orphanages.

This ugliness was in vain. But just when Lincoln's nationalist money policies and our industrial strength overwhelmed the rebellion, President Lincoln was murdered. A dragnet went out for the Confederate secret service operators, accused of participation in the assassination. Albert Pike escaped and joined Jacob Thompson in Canada. Judah Benjamin fled to England, joining the exiled Robert Toombs and James Bulloch. John Slidell stayed permanently in France.

Confederate secret service agent John Surratt made it to Italy and hid in the Vatican, while Surratt's mother was convicted and hanged on the charge of plotting with John Wilkes Booth to kill Lincoln. John Surratt was discovered and returned for trial. He was acquitted. But in 1870, Surratt admitted publicly that he had plotted with Booth to "abduct" Lincoln to the old of Italy, preventing the murder of his trip to Montreal carrying money and messages from Judah Benjamin. The secret service bank in Montreal, where gold from Britain was deposited for Benjamin's crew, was the same bank in which Lincoln's assassin John Wilkes Booth had made his deposits six months before the killing.

The war was over. But the defeated Confederacy was transformed into the romantic *Lost Cause*, an object of cultish reverence.

During Reconstruction

Anti-slavery congressmen pressed ahead with plans for Reconstruction, designed to break up the power of what was called the "chivalry," the feudal lords of the pre-war South. In Tennessee, the pro-Union faction tried to increase its political strength by putting through a law, granting the right to vote to the newly freed blacks.

The Knights of the Ku Klux Klan was a terrorist counterattack, beginning in Tennessee, designed to block Reconstruction and reverse the outcome of the Civil War. The Klan and the Scottish Rite were one and the same enterprise, continuing the imperial effort behind the slaveowners' rebellion.

Pike, Benjamin, Slidell, Toombs, Bulloch, and Thompson were all in exile at war's end. Though Judah Benjamin had quickly become a wealthy lawyer for the British merchant oligarchs, his continuing preoccupation with defeating Reconstruction is indicated in letters he wrote back to the U.S.A. with complaints such as these:

"I have always looked with the utmost dread and distrust on the experiment of emancipation so suddenly enforced on the South by the onset of the war. God knows how it will all end!"; and "the South is kept crushed under negro rule"; and "I can never consent to go to New Orleans and break my heart witnessing the rule of Negroes"; and "nothing is so abhorrent to me as Radicalism which seeks to elevate the populace into the governing class." From Albert Pike's British sanctuary in Canada, on

Curse to Kill Developer Pledged by 10 Rabbis

Claim he desecrates Israeli graves

JERUSALEM - 10 rabbis say they will begin to fast soon, at a secret time in a secret synagogue. At midnight of the third day, they will circumscribe the Torah scrolls with black candles, blow a ram's horn and place upon Udi Ilan the curse of the Tongues of Fire.

They say he will be dead within a year.

Ilan is a developer in the old city of Jaffa, Israel, just south of Tel Aviv. The ultra-Orthodox Jews, the Haredim, say he is responsible for desecrating Jewish graves with his construction, a charge Ilan and government archaeologists deny.

"Punishments come from heaven. The rabbis have the power to call for it," says Yehuda Meshi-Zahav, an organizer of the Haredim.

Ilan has had the Haredim demonstrate against him, had equipment vandalized, been threatened with boycott of his bank and his affiliated American Express cards, and already has a lesser curse imposed on him.

The Haredim say that unless he stops his construction, they will use the strongest, most lethal curse available, the *Pulsa de Nura*.

Within the Jewish religion there is a strong mysticism which uses secret rituals, blessings, curses and supernatural interpretations.

Israel is a country where men wear amulets, politicians visit seers and women line up at a su-

permarket to sit on a chair that was used by a rabbi they believed could make them fertile.

"We have tried earthly words. They don't understand. Now, we must speak to them in a heavenly language," Meshi-Zahav said.

Ilan says he has no fear.

"I will outlive the rabbi who curses me," the 44-year-old developer was quoted.

The *Pulsa de Nura* is not commonly used because of its extreme gravity, and because of a very strange effect: It can boom-erang.

Supposedly, if the ritual is not performed correctly - which is a potential risk, because the procedures are handed down by word of mouth - or if the target of the curse has been previously blessed, the curse can affect or injure a person who made the

July 15, 1865, Pike issued a summons to the Supreme Council, to resume the operations of the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, Southern Jurisdiction. Six weeks later, "under pressure from Masonic officials in the government," the new President Andrew Johnson permitted Pike to re-enter the U.S.A. The Rite was reborn over the next few years, as money and messengers went back and forth between Pike and the Confederacy's sponsors in England.

In April 1866, a year after the murder of Abraham Lincoln, Albert Pike's Supreme Council met in full costume inside the White House. There Lincoln's successor President Andrew Johnson granted a pardon to Pike. The following year, the awed and grateful Johnson was granted advanced degrees 4 through 32 by the Scottish Rite. The Masons claim that Johnson's Freemasonic involvement was an important reason why the pro-Reconstruction congressmen tried to impeach Johnson.

Albert Pike could not go home to Arkansas, however. He was still under indictment for treason by state authorities there, for inciting the Indians to break laws or treaties. So he settled in Memphis, Tennessee, just across the Mississippi River from Arkansas, becoming a newspaper publisher, lawyer and president of the Tennessee Bar Association.

Tennessee blacks got the right to vote in February 1867. Beginning that spring, Albert Pike and a small group of Confederate generals held several meetings in Nashville, at the Maxwell House Hotel, to form the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan. The name was taken from the Greek, *kyklos*, meaning "circle." It was no mystery to the pro-Unionists: The Knights of the (Golden) Circle had reappeared.

Pike was appointed chief judicial officer of the Invisible Empire. He is said to have written the Klan's military manual and ritual, and was the Klan's expert on secrecy of organization-its secret grips, signs, and passwords. At one of his Nashville meetings, General Nathan Bedford Forrest was chosen Imperial Wizard of the Klan. Albert Pike organized the Ku Klux Klan in Arkansas after General Forrest appointed Pike the Grand Dragon of that Realm.

The Tennessee leaders of the Klan at the time of its founding were prominent Masons subordinate to Grand Commander Pike.

Pike's old comrade and financial backer Robert Toombs returned from England in 1868. Toombs was appointed dictator of Scottish Rite activities inside Georgia, and Toombs and his family ran all aspects of the Klan within Georgia.

President Ulysses Grant said that the Klan worked "by force and terror to prevent all political action not in accord with the views of the members; to deprive colored citizens of the right to bear arms and of the right to a free ballot; to suppress [i.e. burn] schools in which colored children were taught and to reduce the colored people to a condition akin to that of slavery."

In his newspaper *The Memphis Daily Appeal*, for April 16, 1868, publisher Albert Pike wrote: "With Negroes for witnesses and jurors, the administration of justice becomes a blasphemous mockery. A Loyal League of Negroes can cause any white man to be arrested, and can prove any charges it chooses to have made against him."

"The disenfranchised people of the South ... can find no protection for property, liberty or life, except in secret association ... We would unite every white man in the South, who is opposed to negro suffrage, into one great Order of Southern Brotherhood, with an organization complete, active, vigorous, in which a few should execute the concentrated will of all, and whose very existence should be con-

cealed from all but its members."

In the latter decades of the nineteenth century, British-centered finance gained supremacy over American industry and U.S. policy-making. Under British sponsorship, Pike's Scottish Rite, Southern Jurisdiction, came to rule over much of the world's Freemasonry. At length its headquarters moved from South Carolina to Washington, D.C.

Theodore Roosevelt, a racist Anglophile and passionate Freemason, became U.S. President September 14, 1901, upon the shooting death of William McKinley. Teddy Roosevelt's reign was the Lost Cause triumphant: Roosevelt's revered exiled uncle, James Bulloch, Judah Benjamin's secret service chief in England, had ghostwritten young Teddy's book on naval history, and Teddy's clique had finally conquered Cuba in the 1898 U.S. War with Spain.

The Washington, D.C. statue honoring Klan founder Albert Pike was dedicated 39 days after Teddy Roosevelt's inauguration.

The B'nai B'rith and "Egyptian Principles"

In his admiring biography of Judah Benjamin, Eli Evans quotes the famous attack against Benjamin's pro-slavery fanaticism by Ohio's Senator Ben Wade: "when old Moses, under the immediate inspiration of God Almighty, enticed a whole nation of slaves, and ran away ... to old Canaan, I suppose that Pharaoh and all the chivalry of old Egypt denounced him as a most furious abolitionist ... There were those who loved Egypt better than they loved liberty ... They were 'Israelites with Egyptian principles'."

Senator Wade's barb hit its mark. Judah Benjamin had deserted the religion of Moses. He had spat on the law of freedom, the gift that Jews celebrate in the Passover seder (which was also Christ's last supper).

Since then, other "Israelites with Egyptian principles," those Jews who like Benjamin attached their destinies to the British Empire and its racialism, have become a vital component of the Anglo-American Eastern Establishment, "honorary Anglo-Saxons," they have helped transform the United States into an essentially mindless British model imperium. And the racialism they co-authored has brought tragedy to Jews as well as to others outside the racial pale, twice as many Jews fought for the Union as for the Confederacy. Northern Jews, many of them recent German immigrants, were strongly pro-republican and anti-slavery.

The predominant Jewish tradition in the South was not only pro-slavery, but overwhelmingly Freemasonic.

The Independent Order of B'nai B'rith formed in 1843 as a Jewish community sub-project in the restoration of Masonry by the Scottish Rite and the British foreign office. Though most of its lodges were in the North, B'nai B'rith was openly pro-Confederate. Though it claimed to be neutral in the war, many of the Order's Northern spokesmen were stridently pro-slavery. B'nai B'rith's post-Civil War leaders were pro-Confederate operatives, including later president Simon Wolf, who had been arrested by the War Department in Washington, DC as the lawyer for a Confederate spy ring.

Rabbi Isaac Wise established B'nai B'rith's center for the "liberalizing" of Judaism in Cincinnati, Ohio-coinciding with Cincinnati's other great Scottish Rite scheme, the launching of the Knights of the Golden Circle. Wise was officially neutral in the Civil War.

Core leaders of the B'nai B'rith from then on have been Scottish Rite Masons.

The political establishment associated with the Order has always had its headquarters in London.

In Richmond, the Confederate capital, Gustavus A. Myers was Secretary of State Judah Benjamin's closest friend and Benjamin's channel to banker August Belmont. The former president of the Richmond City Council, and the undisputed head of Richmond's Jewish community, Myers was Freemasonry incarnate.

Myers's maternal grandfather, Moses Michael Hays, had brought the original "patent" and rituals from England to found the Scottish Rite in the American colonies. A Tory and financial partner of Boston's slave trade millionaires, Hays passed his fortune and his Masonic and British underground connections to his daughter's husband and sons, the Richmond Myers clan.

Moses Myers, merchant partner of the Richmond family, was head of Norfolk's Jewish community. His house is now a public museum, located on Norfolk's Freedom Street. Inside is a large wooden plaque given to the family by Queen Victoria, in recognition of the family's long service to the British crown and cause. Several generations, living in that same Moses Myers house, were consuls.

All of Virginia's Jewish leaders then were Masons, one of them Rothschild's office agent was grand master of Virginia Masons during the war of 1812.

After the Civil War, the Belmont Rothschild faction took absolute control over the Jewish leadership within New York and trans-Atlantic finance. Joseph Seligman, who was pro-Union like most American Jews, joined the British banking syndicate of Rothschild and J.P. Morgan, which ran U.S. government finance from the 1870's onward.

London's Anglo-Saxon and Jewish employees, banking partners of the Confederates against Lincoln's nationalist money policies, were now merged as the Eastern Liberal Establishment.

While Alabama cotton broker Emanuel Lehman lived in Civil War New York, he sailed back and forth to England raising money for the Confederate war machine. Continuing the family tradition, his Lehman Brothers firm supported the eugenics movement, and tenaciously defended Virginia investments in Nazi Germany.

But the brightest was Jacob Schiff of Kuhn Loeb private bank. Schiff's power was entirely trans-Atlantic: Traveling back and forth between London and New York, Schiff was Sir Emitt Cassel's U.S. partner and representative. Cassel—the personal banker and the most intimate friend of Prince Edward VII, the grand master of British Freemasonry (Edward's son Albert Victor was supposed to be the subject of the Jack the Ripper story: His unapproved marriage was broken and covered up by the Freemasonic murders of witnesses.)

On behalf of the royal family, Ernst Cassel managed the finances of the Brit-

ish Fabian Society leaders, and the British Round Table in its outrageous African racist endeavors such as *apartheid*.

At Kuhn Loeb in the 1890's, partner Otto Kahn (a British subject) directly supervised Schiff and Cassel's project to build up a certain snarling little railroad man who was a favorite of the old Belmont Confederate machine, Mr. E. H. Harriman. At that same time, the Warburg family joined Kuhn Loeb; the Warburgs' pro-occupation ties to Hitler's Nazis, as well as Harriman's entree to the Soviet dictatorship.

A striking instance of the Confederate "Lost Cause," persisting and haunting the present century, is to be seen in the attic of *The New York Times*.

Iphigenie Ochs married Arthur Hays Sulzberger in 1917. He succeeded her father Adolphe Ochs as publisher of *The Times*, which Mr. Ochs had bought in the 1890's.

Adolphe Ochs and his father founded the "Baroness Erlanger" Hospital in Chattanooga, Tennessee. The hospital was named for John Sidel's daughter who married the Confederacy's chief financier Baron Emil Erlanger. The Baron had bought up the main railways between the bankrupt South and Cincinnati. Adolphe Ochs had married Iphigenie Wise, the daughter of B'nai B'rith's Cincinnati leader Isaac Wise. When the Ochs family had lived in Cincinnati during the war, Adolphe's mother Bertha had been arrested for smuggling drugs to the Confederate army.

In 1991, Arthur Sulzberger's daughter Ruth sponsored the visit to America of British banker Rodolphe d'Erlanger, John Sidel's great-grand grandson. At a reception for Erlanger hospital, he said that his great grandfather, Baron Emil, was the partner of Cecil Rhodes in his nightmare race projects in Africa, and that Emil and his wife Mathilde Sidel had introduced Wagner's *Tannhauser* to the stage in Paris which was booted off the stage.

Arthur Sulzberger's Philadelphia Uncle David Sulzberger joined the Confederate army in Arkansas. Cyrus Adler, born on the Sulzbergers' Arkansas slave plantation, became the occult, psychic, Masonic, and gnostic expert for the New York Jewish establishment and for London and Cambridge Freemasonry strategists. At the same time, under the Teddy Roosevelt regime, cousin Mayer Sulzberger was president of B'nai B'rith International and president of the American Jewish Committee. At that time, B'nai B'rith leaders (such as the Sulzbergers' partners the Morgenthaus) directly represented British crown interests in the Middle East, and worked as a bridge for Scottish Rite Masonry between the Middle East and Washington.

In the 1930's, Cyrus Adler, president of the American Jewish Committee, coordinated with the family's B'nai B'rith, and the family's *New York Times*, to crush all U.S. political action against Adolf Hitler in Germany. The B'nai B'rith was the one Jewish organization that Hitler deliberately [left open] and functioning under Nazi rule from 1933 on.

In 1939, Britain made a dramatic change in its policy toward Hitler after teaching Hitler his race theories, after forcefully backing his takeover of Germany, after financing and equipping his armies. Britain now changed publicly to opposing Hitler. Only at that point, in 1939, about a year after Hitler finally closed B'nai B'rith's Nazi-authorized German operations, B'nai B'rith decided to "approve" an international boycott against the Nazi regime.

B'nai B'rith's Anti-Defamation League recently opened a vicious campaign to label American black leaders as anti-Semites, aiming at a racial conflict, and stomping on the memory of the young Jews who fought for civil rights in the 1960's. It is essential that the religious, national, and historical character of this racialism be precisely understood.

Now a surprise breakthrough has occurred. Leaders of U.S. black Freemasonry have attacked white Masonry, particularly the Scottish Rite, as a center of racialism. The attack is contained in the latest issue of the *New Quarterly*, official publication of the ["Supreme Council, Scottish Rite, Southern Jurisdiction."] Prince Hall affiliation, in an article by Joseph A. Walkes, editor of the *Quarterly*.

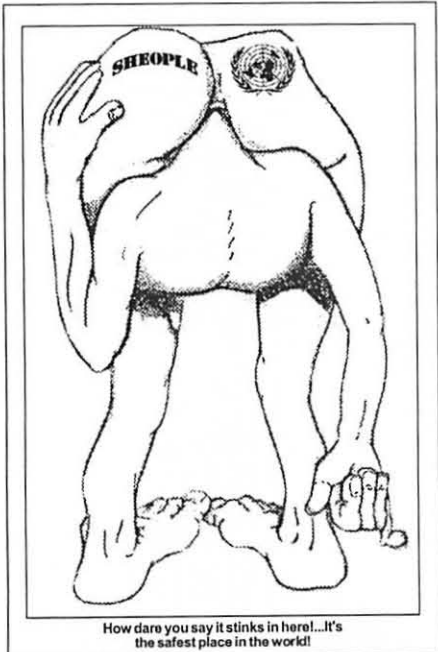

derthal Man" skeleton found in France over 50 years ago is that of an old man who suffered from arthritis. Heidelberg Man was built up from a jawbone, which was concealed by many to be quite human. Nebraska Man was missing at the tip of one tooth, later found to be the tooth of an extinct pig. The jawbone of Pitoldman Man turned out to belong to a modern ape. Peeking Man is supposedly 500,000 years old, but all evidence has disappeared. One of the earliest and best established fossils of Cro-Magnon man is at least equal in physique and brain capacity to modern man, so what's the difference? Using the potassium argon method of dating, volcanic material in Hawaii that was less than 200 years old tested at between 160 million and 3 billion years old (*Journal of Geophysical Research*, July 15, 1968, p. 4601). A shell from a living mollusk was tested for carbon-14 and found to be more than 3,000 years (*SCIENCE*, vol. 141, p. 636, August 16, 1963). And evolution is still being taught in schools, and is being used as a base argument for the New Age movement, which "claims that humans are constantly evolving into a new species (*New Age* is also the title of the Freemasons' newsletter).

The June 1967 issues of *Life* magazine featured a series of articles on the "action intellectuals" — "A brotherhood of scholars in the halls of power forms the most powerful community in our society." A notable quote from these issues includes the following from the "Editors' Note" column, introducing the series: [Theodore White] undertook for us a very different assignment: to track down and define, for the first time, today's "intellectual community" — those scholars and intellectuals both in and out of government who exert such an enormous influence on the laws and policies of the United States... At first, when word got out that he was starting his rounds, they greeted him with a mixture of scorn and outrage he would describe them as a conspiracy. 'You really ought to call us a new kind of public servant,' one of them said.

The issue here, of course, is that these scholars were never elected to hold such power, and the fact that they were afraid of being called a conspiracy speaks for itself. Conspiracy theories are no basis for an argument, because theories are not proven and therefore cannot be accepted as fact. However, when federal criminal statutes have been broken, the person or persons responsible must be punished according to the law. Conspiracy, in spite of the tendency to avoid the word because "theory" almost always comes attached when it is mentioned in the mass media, is a criminal act, under Title 18, U.S.C. Section 371, *Conspiracy to commit offense or to defraud the United States*. The means of determining the existence of a conspiracy were clearly stated in the case, *State vs. Horton*, 275 NC 651, 170 SE2d 466: A number of indefinite acts, each of which, standing alone, might have little weight. But taken collectively, they point unerringly to the existence of a conspiracy. The existence of a conspiracy may be proved by inference from conduct, statements, documents, and facts and circumstances which disclose a common design on the part of the accused persons and others to act together in pursuance of a common criminal purpose. Such criminal purposes, of course, include not only the circumvention and destruction of the Constitution of the United States, but also drug smuggling, murder and persecution of those who attempt to expose government corruption, and other such acts which have been perpetrated by those under the control of the "Secret Government" — the unelected officials who were so arrogantly paraded before our eyes as far back as 1967 in *Life* magazine. It has been said that the best front is an open front, and they have used this strategy well. And it is by their device that the truth has become evil spoken of. Their membership transcends the two-party system. Theodore White writes, "John F. Kennedy sets up a task force in

the election of 1960 to screen names for candidates to run his Department of State. Of the first 82 names on the list handed him, 63 are members of the Council on Foreign Relations in New York." The Council on Foreign Relations is identified here as being part of this "brotherhood," and by looking at their membership roster in the rear section of their Annual Report, we can see that there are members both Republican and Democrat in the House and Senate, as well as in the Presidency itself (both Clinton and Bush are current or past members). And what is the goal of the Council? In the April 1974 issue of the CFR journal, *Foreign Affairs*, on page 558, CFR member Richard Gardner stated that this "new world order" we have been hearing about "will have to be built from the bottom up rather than from the top down. It will look like a great 'booming, buzzing confusion'...but an end run around national sovereignty, eroding it piece by piece, will accomplish much more than the old-fashioned frontal assault."

On February 17, 1950, CFR member James Warburg, testifying before the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, stated: "We shall have no government whether or not you like it — by conquest or consent."

The patriot movement has lately been labeled by these men and their hirelings in the "free press" as "right-wing extremists," in spite of the fact that militia leader Mark Koerakke once said in his "America in Peril" video, "Don't get me wrong, I'm neither Democrat or Republican, I'm just one of those regular American kind of people. Most people seem to ignore the fact that an African-American militia member appeared on the Phil Donahue show not too long ago, to the embarrassment of the media's attempt to stir up hatred of the militias by calling them "white supremacists." William Cooper, Chairman of the Constitution Party, was also labeled as a "white supremacist," although his wife is Chinese from Taiwan, and he himself is part American Indian. Strangely enough, in the *Life* magazine article, it is not "right-wing extremists," but "the New Left" who say that "the enemy in America is some faceless 'they' who control events. They are persecuting Negroes. 'They' are building not a great society but an idiot society [with America now ranked 14th in the world in quality of education, there seems to be some truth to these words]. 'They' have ruined our cities. 'They' are erasing individuals, depriving them of identity, denying them the opportunity of achievement. If only 'they' can be purged, implies the New Left, America will find its way to a new, free, humanitarian society." It seems that "they" can't decide which end of the political spectrum their opposition belongs to. This is because the two party system is an illusion, and a lie used to confuse the public. Adam Weishaupt, the Jesuit who founded the Illuminati of 1776, once stated, "Sometimes, we may even appear to oppose ourselves." In *The Illuminati Papers*, published by John Robinson, it is clearly stated, "There must (*la la Jesus!*) not a single purpose ever come in sight that is ambiguous, and that may betray our aims against religion and the state. One must speak sometimes one way and sometimes another... so that, with respect to our true way of thinking, we may be impenetrable."

Now is the time to realize that there is no more right wing or left wing, Republican or Democrat, black, white, red or yellow, no more east and west, no more north and south, but right and wrong. If any politician or legislator of any kind on any level — local, state or federal — takes or has taken any action against the Supreme Law of the Land, then he or she is simply in the line of fire. That legislator has committed a crime, pure and simple, and should be removed from office.

Our own Constitution states, in the Second Amendment, that we have the right to bear arms. If the Constitution is outdated, and if we do not need this right anymore because we cannot protect ourselves from a nuclear attack with an assault rifle, why is it necessary to take away our arms by force or by passing legislation? Are not

armies of men still used as a fighting force? If men invade our country, do we not need men with guns to protect it? And further, if our government turns against us, should we not have the right to defend ourselves, as our Constitution says?

Calling the militia "right wing extremist" when in reality there is no "right wing" is absolutely ludicrous. Teddy Roosevelt once said that the freedom and sovereignty of our nation would be preserved by the voting box, the soap box, and, if necessary, the cartridge box. Teddy Roosevelt, you right-wing terrorist!

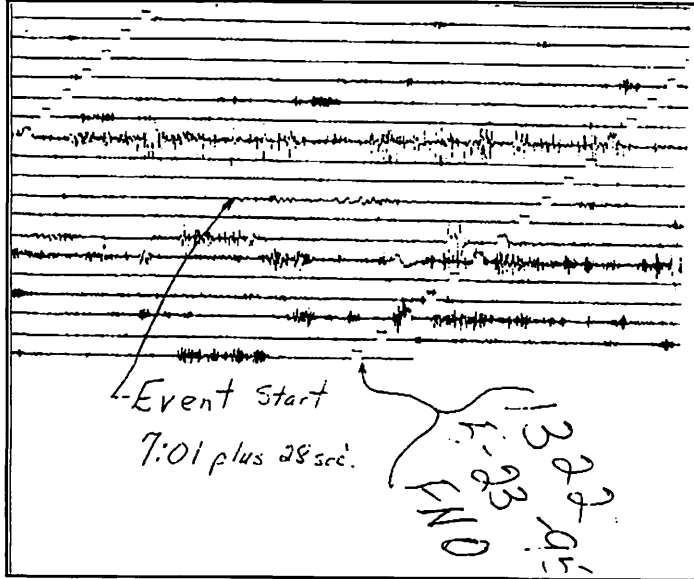

Chapter 1: Demolition materials Section III: Military Explosives and Special Charges

4. Definitions
 - a. Explosives. Explosives are substances that, through chemical reaction, violently change and release pressure and heat equally in all directions. Explosives are classified as low or high according to the "detonating" or speed at which this change takes place and other pertinent characteristics.
 - b. Low Explosives. Low explosives "deflagrate" or change from a solid to a gaseous state relatively slowly over a sustained period (up to 1300 feet per second). This characteristic makes low explosives ideal where pushing or shoving effect is required. Examples are smokeless and black powders.
 - c. High Explosives. The change in this type explosive to a gaseous state — detonation — occurs almost instantaneously (up to 28,000 feet per second) producing a shattering effect upon the target. High explosives are used where this shattering effect is required — in certain demolition charges and in charges in mines, shells, and bombs.
7. Ammonium Nitrate (page 12)
 - b. Uses. Having a low detonating velocity (11,000 fps) and thus a low shattering power that produces a pushing or heaving effect, ammonium nitrate is used chiefly as a cratering charge. It is also effective in ditching.



INFORMATION RELEASE DATED MAY 24, 1995 FROM THE OKLAHOMA GEOLOGICAL SURVEY - NORMAN, OKLAHOMA

On May 23 at 7:01 a.m. plus 28 seconds the Oklahoma Geological Survey's seismograph station FNO recorded an event that we interpret to be the result of the destruction of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City. The appended seismogram shows the beginning of the event at 7:01:28.4. The signal is interrupted by high-frequency noise in two places. The "noise" is attributed to wind action on the antenna used to transmit the signal from the seismograph to the recorder at Sarkeys Energy Center on the campus of the University of Oklahoma. Note that the record contains numerous high-frequency signals, some of which are attributed to local "noise" such as vehicles and trains.

If the assumption is correct that this event is from the demolition of the federal building, then the signal was initiated at the site at 7:01 plus 19 seconds. Further analysis of data from this event is on going.

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
