

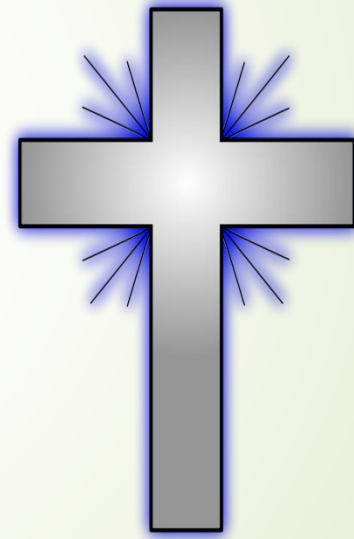

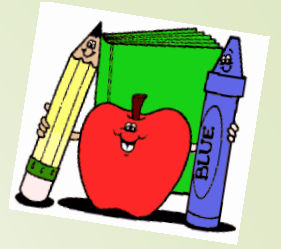


School Mission

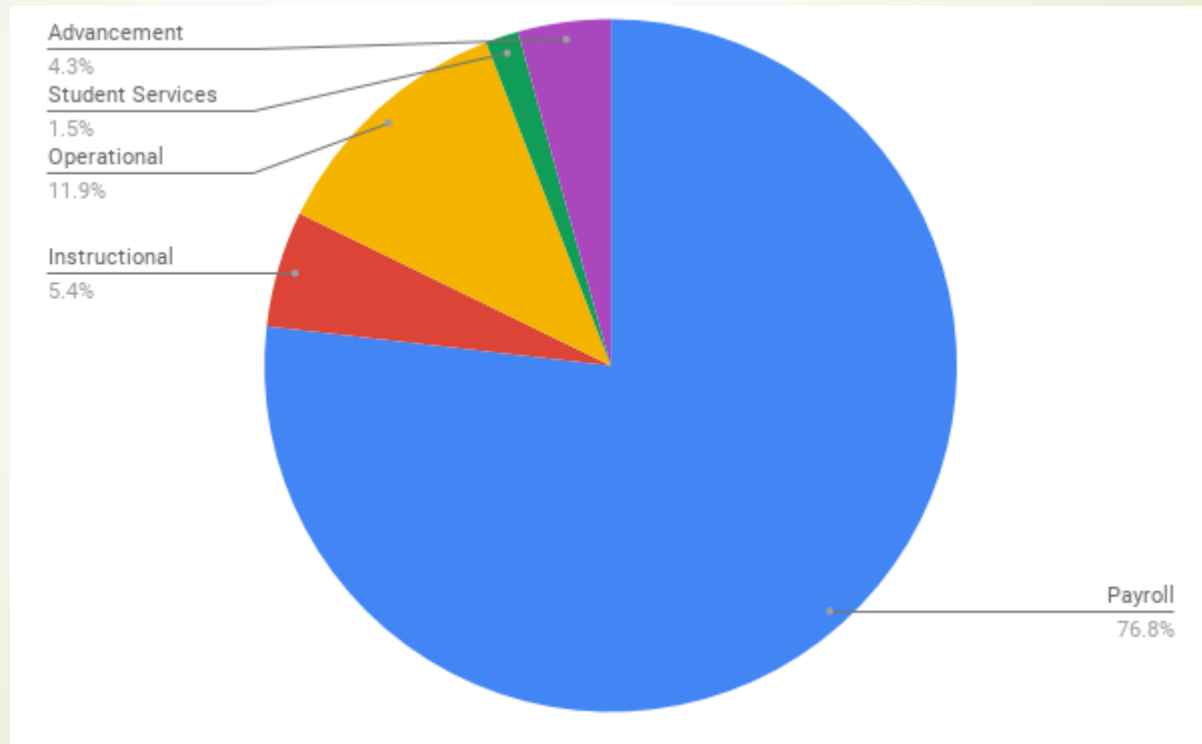
