COVID and SICK Guidance

Test-Mask-Go Strategy

With allergy season and New England Winters We will be using this strategy for *MILD* respiratory symptoms your child may have, but will be able to continue to attend school with symptoms If you do the following:

- Fever Free- Less than 100.0 F without medication
- Must wear a mask consistently and correctly
- Must test negative for COVID every day they have symptoms prior to coming to school, as well as one final test when symptoms have resolved.

Mild symptoms include: infrequent cough, congestion,

Runny nose, sore throat, etc

Test kits are available from the Nurse

Fever Greater than 100.0 F

* Stay home until fever free for 24 hours without medication and must have a negative COVID test

If your child is sick please do not send to school for the health and safety of all students and staff.

Positive COVID cases still need to **isolate for 5 days. Please let the school nurse know so she can provide guidance. If you are unsure if your child should attend school, please contact the school nurse

Please let the nurse know if you are testing your child to prevent a call to pick up your child.

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
