

RG31 5UB DIRECTIONS –

NB. Sulham Hill has been designated as ‘Unsuitable for HGV’s’

M4 Junction 12. A4 towards Newbury. 2nd roundabout – right towards Pangbourne, A340. In Tidmarsh turn right at The Greyhound Inn. Up Sulham Hill.
Hall Place E.C. is at the end of the road, at the T-junction, on the right.

Alternative Route

M4 Junction 12. A4 towards Reading. After approx 2.5 miles Prospect Park on left. Turn left at traffic lights into Liebenrood Road. At roundabout turn left. Follow road for approx. 2.5 miles & turn right at T-junction (mini roundabout) into School Road. Left at mini-roundabout into Chapel Hill. At bottom of hill turn right then immediately left. Hall Place is at top of 3rd hill at fourth turning on the right.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) Entry to Hall Place Equestrian Centre assumes acceptance of the Show's rules and conditions.
- 2) No liability will be accepted by the organisers or proprietors for any loss, damage or accident to horses, spectators, competitors or property, however caused.
- 3) The Committee reserve the right to alter or cancel classes if necessary. Also to refuse entry if classes are full. No responsibility will be taken for classes clashing, if they do we apologize.
- 4) Correct riding attire & hard hats must be worn when competing. Hats conforming to PAS 015 or above MUST be worn when mounted. It is recommended that body protectors are also worn when jumping.
- 5) Ridden showing classes may be ridden side saddle. If a 'judge may ride' class, an astride saddle must be provided.
- 6) No smoking – Hall Place is a **No Smoking** establishment.
- 7) Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 8) Competitors numbers must be clearly visible.
- 9) Any rider/horse sustaining a fall in any class will be automatically retired from the class.
- 10) The Judge's decision will be final. Any objections must be made within ½ hour of the class results with a deposit of £20. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 11) All ridden horses & ponies must be 4 years & over.
- 12) Winners of Challenge Trophies will be required to sign a trophy form and return the trophy 3 weeks prior to 2023 show.
- 13) Every effort will be made to allow competitors to enter as many classes as they wish but it is the competitors responsibility to ensure they are able to get to each class. It will be the judges discretion to allow a late competitor to enter the ring. No refund can be given in the event of an earlier class over running.
- 14) ALL COVID GUIDELINES TO BE ADHERED TO.
