The ten laptops computers that we sent home with them last August continue to be a blessing for the older kids to complete their lessons online. To bring internet to the home will be approximately \$2,000.

A day at the home starts with prayers/devotions, breakfast, and household chores. The older children then attend their on-line classes while the younger children have time for play or outside games. The widows and older children help prepare the meals, while the younger children help with watering the fruit trees.

The children will be heading back to school full-time next week, and everyone is looking forward to getting back to a regular schedule.

Please keep the children, women, and staff in your prayers as one of the village women, who helps with the cooking, recently tested positive for COVID. She is quarantined and under a doctor's care.

Recently, Pastor David, from one of Madhukar's sister churches, celebrated a day with four baptisms. We praise God for how God is using Brother David in his community, bringing the hope of Jesus Christ to the lost.

Pastor David is the pastor of a small church in a new Governmental district that is building new homes and businesses.

Meet Mahesh!

Mahesh is ten-years-old. He came to the home when he was seven-years-old.



Before Mahesh came to the home, he came from the beggars community, begging at bus stations, railway stations, and hotels in the Sangareddy area. He lost his father when he was two. He has one brother Varanasi Praveen, who is also at the home and in the 5th-grade class.

His mother, Shantha, was addicted to alcohol and drugs. She gave little care to her sons. When Mahesh came to the home, he had not participated much in school. Mahesh started in Kindergarten class and is now in 4th-grade class. Mahesh quickly adapted to school and did very well in his studies.

Mahesh has a soft heart for spiritual matters like prayer and Bible storytelling. He is a natural leader with the younger boys at the home, helping them keep track of their daily chores and their studies. When Mahesh grows-up, he wants to be a soldier and join the military.

As Mahesh's mother saw her son's improvement, she also applied for residency at the home. Shantha is no longer addicted to drugs and alcohol. She is learning about God's love and how to love and care for her children. Shantha helps with the cooking and care of the girls in the home.
