



Privacy Policy

Healthy Park County is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard information when you visit our website healthyparkcounty.org and interact with our services.

Information We Collect

Personal Information We may collect personal information you provide voluntarily, including: **name; email address; phone number; mailing address;** and any other information you submit through contact forms, questionnaires, or other communications.

Health Information (Protected Health Information PHI) When you request services, referrals, or support, you may provide health-related information such as **mental or behavioral health details** and information shared during appointment requests or referrals.

Automatically Collected Information We automatically collect certain technical information when you visit our website, including **IP address; browser type; pages visited; date and time of visits.** We also use cookies and similar technologies to enhance and personalize your experience.

How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- **Respond to inquiries and provide services.**
- **Schedule appointments and connect you with resources.**
- **Improve and maintain our website and services.**
- **Comply with legal, regulatory, and public safety obligations.**

We do not use your information for purposes incompatible with the reasons it was collected without obtaining your consent.

Cookies and Similar Technologies

We use cookies, web beacons, and similar technologies to operate and improve our website, analyze usage, and provide a better user experience. You can control cookie preferences through your browser settings; disabling cookies may affect site functionality.

Disclosure of Your Information

We **do not sell, rent, or trade** your personal or health information. We may share information in the following limited circumstances:

- **Authorized personnel and service providers** who assist in delivering our services and who are bound to protect your information.
- **Health professionals and partner organizations** when you have provided consent or when disclosure is permitted or required by law.
- **Government or law enforcement agencies** when required by law, such as in cases of child abuse, imminent danger, or other legal obligations.

Any third party with whom we share information is required to use appropriate safeguards to protect your information.

Protection of Your Information

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of your information. These measures include secure servers, encryption where appropriate, access controls, and staff training. While we strive to protect your data, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure.

Data Retention and Transfers

We retain personal and health information only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this policy, to comply with legal obligations, and to resolve disputes. Information may be stored and processed in the United States or in other jurisdictions where our service providers operate; when transfers occur, we take steps to ensure appropriate protections are in place.

Your Rights

You have certain rights regarding your personal information, subject to applicable law:

- **Access:** Request access to and receive a copy of your personal information.
- **Correction:** Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete information.

- **Deletion:** Request deletion of your personal data where applicable.
- **Withdrawal of Consent:** Withdraw consent for processing where processing is based on consent.

For health-related information, these rights may be governed by HIPAA and other applicable laws; requests related to PHI will be handled in accordance with those laws.
