**July 13, 2020**

We continued meeting at Red Robin. We will continue to follow the CDC rules until they get this virus figured out. The way Red Robin has the room set up for us, we will have two booths for two people each along one wall, two booths for up to four people along the other wall, one booth for up to four people along the front of the room, a table for two and a table for six in the middle of the floor. We are able to meet with up to 28 people, if you are willing to sit with someone from outside your household.

Dave and Jackie were out of town for July, so Dick Yeager (Vice President) ran the meeting while Vince Anderson (Treasurer) provided these meeting notes.

Minutes

- The meeting was held at Red Robin in Evansville and was opened by Dick Yeager, with 8 attendees.
- No door prizes or half pot this month.
- The Treasurer's Report was given by Vince Anderson. The July balance is \$6065.08, this is an increase of \$20.00 (proceeds from the June half pot). Also, Vince had Sarah Karr audit the financial records of the club on June 24, Sarah found no issues and was complimentary of the records in general.
- The Secretary's report was approved based on the June newsletter.
- 2020 Car Show – per the email sent to membership prior to the meeting, the officers have proposed that we change the car show to a British Car Cruise-in this year. No ballots, awards, or registrations. This gives us the flexibility of cancelling easily if the pandemic gets worse, or if we have bad weather. Also addresses the fact that some members, including the car show chair Dave Mullen, cannot attend due to coronavirus vulnerabilities. In response to the email we had 13 members send Jackie input in favor of the cruise-in prior to this meeting. The other two options were complete cancellation or proceed with normal car show. During the July 13th meeting the discussion continued to support the cruise-in. Motion made by Vince for a cruise in from 9 to noon, seconded by James Havener, and vote was unanimous so this decision is now final. Dick will work with Jackie F and Carol Robinson to create a brief



description of the changes and to get the word out to our friends in other clubs. Further details to come from future meetings.

- Owensboro Liaison – Wonder Whip is becoming the place for our Kentucky members to meet. They now meet there first Monday at 7:30pm for monthly meeting, third Saturday at 8:30am for cars and coffee, and every Thursday at 1:00pm for social time (weather permitting).
- Car Badges – Dave Folk is continuing to research places where badges can be ordered. He will have a report next month on whether this will be possible and the price for each (same status as June).
- Ivy Tech Auto Mechanic Scholarship – With Ivy Tech being closed we haven't been able to contact them about a scholarship so this is still being worked (same status as June).
- Annual Donation – the club traditionally has donated \$500 to a local charity during the car show. We break even on the car show itself, but we generate income during the year to support this donation. The club needs to decide if/when we should make a similar donation for 2020 (tabled until August meeting).
