- The meeting was held at Red Robin in Evansville and was opened by Dave Folk, with 18 attendees.

- The Treasurer's Report was given by Vince Anderson. The March balance was \$6,259.98. The June balance is \$6,045.98, this is a decrease of \$214.00. NAMGBR subscriptions (\$240) Vision Accounting for taxes (\$100) and a deposit of \$60 from a donation are the big items, plus some smaller items, leaving a balance of \$6,045.98.
- The Secretary's report was approved based on the May newsletter.
- Owensboro Liaison – Dave Folk reported that at this time the July Kentucky Dinner will be scheduled and we will update you closer to the date of any changes to that. The outside British Cars and Coffee has been moved to



Wonder Whip and will be held this Saturday, June 13 at 9:00 am with breakfast being serviced from 8:00-10:00 am. Also, everyone is welcome to meet at Wonder Whip every Thursday at 1:00 for lunch. They have picnic tables set up or you can bring a chair and enjoy the company.

- Mini Meet 2020 – Just a reminder that the meet has been cancelled due to the virus. The bank account balance is now zero and the account is closed.
- Car Show – At this time we assume that it will be possible to hold the car show in September. We have asked Dave Mullen to contact Newburgh and get their take on it. Dan Armstrong has volunteered to create the signage that will need to be posted around the area to remind people to maintain social distance and follow CDC rules.
- Bi-law change to Nomination Procedures - A motion was made in March to change the bi-laws from requiring two people for each board position on the ballot to allowing an unopposed nominee. An email vote was taken and the vote at last night's meeting unanimously approved the change. The wording will be "The Board of Directors will establish a Nomination Committee (three members) three months before election date for the purpose of proposing nominee(s) for each office to be presented to the membership. The board itself may elect to perform this task."
- Car Badges – Dave Folk is continuing to research places that badges can be ordered from. He will have a report next month on whether they will be possible and the price for each.
- Ivy Tech Auto Mechanic Scholarship – With Ivy Tech being closed we haven't been able to contact them about a scholarship so this is still being worked.
