Contest Date Sunday, March 10, 2019

Purpose

Participation in this competition gives students a deeper knowledge and appreciation of the United States Constitution and furthers their research, essay writing and public speaking skills. Entering this contest gives students a valuable insight into the rights and privileges of American citizenship and of the associated duties and responsibilities.

Eligibility

Contestants must be 7th or 8th grade students in the general Wheaton area attending any public, parochial or private school or home schooled. They must be under the age of 15 on the date of the county contest.

Contest Rules

Each contestant must give a four to six minute speech on some phase of the Constitution of the United States. The students will be judged on content (up 70 points) and speaking skills (up to 30 points). Contestants will speak from a podium and should not read their speech but may refer to notes during the speech. Points will be deducted for speaking shorter or longer than the prescribed time. Family members and other interested parties may observe the speeches (no cheering or applauding permitted) but participants may not listen to the speech of a competitor. There will be no photography of any kind prior to or during the competition.

Post Level Competition

Each participating school may enter up to two students in the 2019 Post 556 competition. (Alternates are welcome to apply.) Additionally, two home-schooled students (selected in the order of receipt of registration form) may participate. Each school and home school student is to complete the accompanying registration form and mail to Post 556 to be received by February 15th. The competition will be held at the Visitor Center Theater at Cantigny Park, Wheaton, at 1:00 PM (student check in is 12:30 PM) on Sunday, March 10th.

County Level Competition

Each post in the DuPage County may advance two students for judging in the County 7th and 8th Grade Speech Contest. The county competition will take place on Saturday, March 16, 2019 at the Visitor Center Theater at Cantigny Park, Roosevelt and Winfield Roads, Wheaton, Il. Participants will be notified of the check in time during the Post Level Competition.

Awards

Post 556 awards are \$100 for 1st place, \$75 for 2nd place, \$50 for 3rd place and \$25 for 4th place. Additional awards will be presented at the county level for students advancing from individual post competition.
