

As the cost of living goes up, VA ensures that your benefit rates do too! Starting Jan. 1, 2023, all compensation benefit rates have increased by **8.7%** to match adjustments made to Social Security benefits. This increase impacts <u>disability benefits</u>, clothing allowance, dependency and indemnity compensation (DIC), as well as other VA assistance programs.
