2023 has been a very eventful year for the Angelians. A lot of interesting, exciting & important events were organised during the year. This year the School is blessed with 350 students & 27 Staff. The School has students from over 22 villages. We shared our similarities & celebrated our differences as we journeyed through the year.

HAA had the first batch of students of the HSLC Examinations 2023 with a 90% pass percentage, 4 securing 1st Division & the rest securing 2nd Division. Reaching this milestone marks a substantial growth of our school. The highest score for Zeme Language in the whole state of Manipur was secured by our own student, which is another great success.

Ms. Paideule Panme of Class 8 was the winner in the 1st Tamenglong Schools Debating Championship in the entire District. Her success has brought laurels to our school and we are very proud of her. She was awarded by the Deputy Commissioner, Tamenglong and the District Administration office, walking away with a cash prize and a trophy to adorn the school.
