# School Re-opening - cum - Worship Programme

The academy with the total strength of 212 students (122 boys & 88 girls) at the time of admission began its second scholastic year on 12th February with a worship programme in its campus. The programme was conducted by Deilungtui, former pastor of the local church. The school was privileged to have two ADC members of Tamenglong Autonomous District Council namely Mrs Ramingle, Chairperson Education and Shri. Poukhui, Executive Member.
