the current admission record, our intake this year is 330 students from across neighbouring villages including students from Assam and Nagaland.

From their way of performances, we can contribute our proper guidance to excel in their hidden talents.

Covid Relief Package to Rural Poor

At the onslaught of corona virus spike in our country, many rural students and youngsters who went to mainland India to pursue their dreams and find fortunes returned to their native villages bringing about pandemic in the region. This was how the virus began to find grip in our state particularly in Tamenglong district. There was panic, fear and uncertainty in the minds of the rural people who apprehended that food crises may creep in to make the situation worse.



In this regard, Haitung Goodwill Foundation stepped in to reach out to the most vulnerable people of villages under Tamei and Tousem sub-divisions including migrant labourers, senior citizens, daily wage workers, widows and differently abled persons by way of extending relief measure, distributing rice to targeted families in 15 villages. As many as 1600 families were helped by giving them 25 kilos each of polished rice to mitigate their suffering.



The organization is happy and grateful to FCI Deputy General Manager ®, Govt. of Manipur for allowing us to lift the commodities at a subsidized rate. Had it not for their consent to our request and their generosity we could have not achieved this target. The programme of distribution began on 20th May and was completed on 30th May 2021.

Tata Trust Ongoing Programme

The ongoing Tata Trust footfall coaching that was initiated in 2019 continued for a couple of months and was discontinued for the rest of the year because of the pandemic and Govt.of Manipur orders for closure of all schools, sports and games complexes. These children have learned a lot of the techniques and rules of footballing through their coaches. Given a meagre sporting play field within the school campus, they have made good use of the opportunity to excel themselves far more than the first day they stepped foot on to school premises.
