The first ever Mrs. Ningwangle Pame (school Founding mother) volleyball tournament for the youth (girls) of the region was held 12th November 2021. The programme was designed in such a way to uplift and uphold the overall image of women and girls in the region who are often confined to household chores. It focuses on empowering them to achieve greater heights than merely looking after their children and related house works. Such outdoor initiatives will help and encourage them to come out of their cocoons of shyness, expose them to something new in their lives, widen their perspectives of their relationship with others by knowing someone new to them and also will boost up their moral, social and economic dimensions. A total of seven teams from surround villages participated in the programme held at the school campus. The Old Magulong village youth club was declared the runner up and the school girls' team won the championship trophy. Cash award was also given to the winners team and to the best player apart from appreciation citations.

School Re-Opening & Covid test drive



After a long winter vacation i.e from 5th December 2021 to 15th February 2022 the school was re-opened once again on 16th February 2022 by inviting village Pastor and his church members to preside over the worship programme. The function was marked by singing of songs and skits presentation from the student community. A total of 303 students were admitted this year to pursue their career in our school. Parents and guardians were

also present on the occasion to witness the opening of their wards school. As a precautionary measure against ongoing COVID-19 the staff and students including parents were screened and tested at the school gate before entering the campus. This was done by engaging Impa PHSc doctor and staff nurses.



Cultural Day 2022

The cultural day at school level for the children was held on the 30th April, 2022. The programme was held with the view to Protect, preserve and propagate the rich traditional and cultural practices of the Zeliangrong community amongst the tribal students. It also gave children an opportunity to learn and inculcate what had been the lives of their forefathers' and to continue the legacy by keeping them alive today's dying culture. Children dressed in traditional attires with necklace and other ornaments around their bodies depict the sense of pride and belonging to different tribes. Traditional dance like fish dance, butterfly dance, bee dance etc were performed by the children. Couple walk/cat walk was also performed proudly by the children.



School Sanitary day

Shri Armstrong Pame, former Deputy Commissioner of Tamenglong district visited the school on 5th March 2022 on the day the school was observing sanitary day. The day was marked by keeping the surrounding neat and clean apart from personal hygiene. On this day the former DC brought long sanitary pads for the school going girl-children who are 12 years and above. The pads were distributed by the teachers. He also asked the students and teaching community to be more conscious about the needs and requirements of the growing adolescents. Apart from encouraging them to study hard he also made a mention of keeping the body clean by washing hands frequently using soap during the day particularly after defecation, brushing teeth regularly, covering mouth and nose with masks or pieces of cloth to prevent transmission of any communicable diseases. The programme was spearheaded by children Sanitary and personal hygiene club.
