ORDINANCE 08-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-5 TO CHANGE MINIMUM WATER RATE AND PERMIT CHARGE.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the Town of Burlington:

SECTION 1: That section 1 of Ordinance 98-5 be amended to read as follows:

(a) Minimum fee for delivery of two thousand (2000) gallons or less:

Residence or apartment: \$20.00 per month
Filling Stations, stores commercial buildings
Water users with a business and town residence
(up to a maximum of two taps) \$20.00 per month
Schools (for the first 100,000 gallons) \$385.00 per month
Churches \$20.00 per month

- (b) After 2,000 gallons of water have been delivered, the water rate will be \$2.50 per thousand. Schools shall be charged at the rate of \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons for usage over 100,000 gallons.
- (c) Bulk water rate is \$5.50 per thousand gallons.

SECTION 2: An emergency exists and is hereby declared; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from date of its passage and approval.
