Qualifications of Poll Workers

A poll worker must:

- Be a qualified elector of the state who is able to read and write the English language;
- Be a resident of the precinct served by the polling place at the time of appointment, unless otherwise determined by county election commission;
- Attend local poll worker training conducted by a State Board certified trainer.

A poll worker must not:

- Have been found or pled guilty or nolo contendere to the violation of an election law of this state;
- Be a paid employee of a political party;
- Be a paid employee of a candidate for office on the county's ballot;
- Be a candidate for an office to be filled at an election while serving as a poll worker; and
- Be married to or related to a candidate running for office while serving, if an objection is made to the county board of election commissioners within 10 days after the official list of election officials is posted in a public place in the county clerk's office.
- Be the County Political Party Chairman or be married to a CBEC member or the County Political Party Chairman, if an objection is made to the county board of election commissioners within 10 days after the official list of election officials is posted in a public place in the county clerk's office.
