Membership Cards. All members are required to display their membership card and sign in while using the range facilities.

Non-members. Non-members may only use the club facilities under the following conditions:

1) they are with a current NHRC club member and

2) they have completed a Liability form. Liability forms are located in the club house and on the outdoor range. Place completed (signed and dated) forms back in the bin. A form must be completed yearly.

Targets. Only paper targets and various steel targets provided by NHRC are approved for use. All other non-approved targets are not permitted and in violation of club rules.

CLUB EVENTS

Trap Shoots. Trap shoots are held on Tuesday evenings starting at 5:00 PM from April to October. The shoots are open to NHRC members and the public.

ARA Shoots. American Rimfire Association (ARA) run the 2nd Saturday from April through November at NHRC. ARA Tournaments are held on Saturdays throughout the season. Please see the NHRC website for dates and further details. ARA is open to the public.

LAST CALL - 2026 NHRC DUES

AMERICAN RIMFIRE ASSOCIATION (ARA) ACTIVITIES

The ARA is going strong! The upcoming year, 2026, is the 5th year we will be hosting ARA Matches at NHRC. Our attendance has continually improved over the last 4 years as well as the individual competitors scores.

NHRC's first ARA Match occurred on July 2, 2022. At that time, there were 7 Factory Class and 1 Unlimited Class shooters. Dan McGough was the winner in the Factory Class with a total score for 4 target cards of 9250-1X. Alex Vezendy was the top Unlimited Class shooter with a total score of 2990-1X for 4 target cards.

Compare that to the past 2025 season, where we averaged 28.25 shooters per monthly event. The final Match was held on November 11, 2025 with Ed Sklaney taking top score in Factory Class with a 9460-6X total and Barry DeVliegher winning the Unlimited Class with an 8650-34X total score. Overall, there were a total of 15 Factory Class and 10 Unlimited Class shooters at the November Match. The Club Champions for the 2025 season were Joe Senick, Factory Class, with a 2375.2778 aggregate score / 3247.2778 aggregate + points and Alex Vezendy, Unlimited Class, with an aggregate score of 2037.9167 / 2397.9167 aggregate + points.

With the interest in the ARA, the club continues to look at ways to grow and expand the program for 2026. During the season, we will be adding another 5 benches – making the total 20. NHRC will again host monthly matches and tournaments. The PA State Tournament for Unlimited Class will be held at the range on July 11th. On a special note, NHRC will be hosting the Area 3 Tournament for Factory Class. Area 3 consists of competitors from Michigan to the Atlantic Ocean and Maine to Tennessee. Quite an exciting honor!



NEW INDOOR RIMFIRE SHOOTING COMPETITION




At the request of some members who miss shooting in the winter, NHRC is organizing a new indoor **.22 caliber pistol competition**. The competition will be start at **10 AM on Wednesdays** in the Indoor Range. A special target will be used with rings graded from 4 through 10, plus X. There will be 10 rounds fired into 5 target cards. Targets will be set at 7 yards. Cards will be completed in relays of 6 shooters (based on target retriever availability). Each relay is limited to 2 minutes of firing time.

Scoring for the competition is by total score, number of X's and group size. Each relay will have only the best card, or cards if tied, advance in the event. The scoring team will consist of 3 people that determine card advancement.

Competition Rules are: 1) Only .22 caliber handguns are permitted. 2) Open sights and red dots are allowed. No magnifiers or scopes. 3) Each shooter will use the same gun throughout the day's event. 4) Weapons will be cased and uncased at the firing line only. Hard or soft cases are allowed.
