GENERAL AGREEMENT

- 1. Customer will be responsible for delivery and installation charges should items be returned.
- 2. Delivery and/or installation within 40 miles, each additional mile \$3.00, one way, payable to installer.
- 3. It is the customer's responsibility to obtain and pay for zoning and building permits, if needed, and to check with local authorities for local codes and designate exact location and elevation to the installer.
- 4. Installation work done by Advanced Pools & Backyards, hereafter referred to as APB, carries a 30 day warranty. Delivery and Installation do not change the manufacturer's warranties. All manufacturer's warranties are handled on APB's premises or through the manufacturer.
- 5. APB does not do electrical wiring or hook-ups; electrical work is the customer's responsibility.
- 6. APB is not responsible for water loss or replacement for any reason.

INSTALLATION AGREEMENT

Normal installation includes:

- 1. Grading of site up to 8" out of level. Additional excavation will cost \$15 per inch from 8"-30" out of level. /excavation over 30" will be by bid. Normal installation does not include removal, spreading or backfilling of dirt and additional excavation cost is payable to the installer. There is an additional charge if large tree roots, rocks or other obstacles are encountered during excavation. These charges will be quoted by installer.
- 2. Placing of sand or pool cushion.
- 3. Erecting pool.
- 4. Hanging pool liner and filling pool approximately 3"-6" depth. (Customer must provide water)
- 5. Show customer proper use of equipment. (Filter, main equipment, chemicals)

RESPONSIBILITY OF BUYER

- 1. To provide free access of 10 ft. where trucks and excavation equipment are needed.
- 2. Priming and starting of filter.
- 3. Assembly and installation of all decking, ladders, fences and accessory equipment; This includes 110v electrical line. Unless otherwise specified or paid for.
- 4. Purchasing sand and ordering mason sand.
- 5. Furnishing water for the pool.
- 6. Obtaining and paying for zoning and building permits if required by applicable laws and/or regulation, and complying with local regulations for swimming pools, including but not limited to fencing, screening, landscaping and electrical.
- 7. Pay installer for installation work upon completion of installation including any additional mileage or excavation over 8" out of level.
- 8. Backfilling around the pool to prevent washout of sand bottom.
- 9. Maintain access to top seats and all components of the pool for service purposes.
- 10. Be ready for installation by scheduled date or special is void.
- 11. Customer is aware that there is no jumping or diving allowed in their pool.

I have read the general agreement and installation agreement above pertaining to my purchase and I understand and agree with all stipulations. I further agree that any controversy dispute or question arising out of, in connection with, or in relation to this agreement or its interpretation, performance or nonperformance, or any breach thereof shall be determined by arbitration conducted in Stigler, OK at the purchaser's expense in accordance with the ten existing rules of the American Arbitration Association and judgement upon any award may be entered by the highest State or Federal court having jurisdiction. Nothing contained herein shall in any way deprive the Company of its right to obtain injunction or other equitable relief as previously set forth herein.
