Power Ionizer Basic Maintenance

Initial Start Up & Spring Opening Instructions

- 1. Balance the water:
 - a. Total Alkalinity = 80 120 ppm
 - **b.** pH = 7.2 7.8
 - c. Calcium Hardness = 230 350 ppm
 - d. Total Dissolved Solids = 1500 ppm
- 2. Turn on the Power Ionizer System and set the control to 8, (highest setting) for 48-72 hours.
- 3. Add pool salt.
- **4.** Add Condition. *** DO NOT SWIM FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS AFTER ADDING THIS PRODUCT!***
- 5. Test water daily until the copper level reaches .03 .06 ppm.

Two Week Maintenance (Weekly for Pools larger than 24')

- 1. Test water for pH, Alkalinity and Copper. The amount of copper indicates the level of natural minerals in the water.
- 2. Adjust the Power Ionizer System using the control.
- **3.** Add **1** bag of **Awaken** and **1** bag of **Energize**. <u>Various conditions may require adding an additional bag of each, such as high bather load and consistent temperatures around 100 degrees.</u>
- 4. Add 1 bottle of Cleanse.
- **5.** Test the copper level and adjust the control dial to maintain residual within .03 .06 ppm.
- **6.** Follow steps 4 6 on ABC's of Pool Maintenance.
