### 6. Your Rights In Relation To This Processing

As an individual, you have certain rights regarding our processing of your personal data, including a right to complain to the Information Commissioner as the relevant supervisory authority.

**Right of Access**: You have the right to obtain confirmation from Trans Support Hub CIC as to whether personal data concerning you are being processed and, where that is the case, access to that data.

**Right to Rectification:** You have the right to oblige Trans Support Hub CIC to rectify inaccurate personal data concerning you. Considering the purposes of the processing, you have the right to have incomplete personal data completed by providing a supplementary statement.

**Right to Erasure (Right to be Forgotten)**: You have the right (under certain circumstances, but not all) to oblige Trans Support Hub CIC to erase personal data concerning you.

**Right to Restriction of Processing:** You have the right (under certain circumstances, but not all) to oblige Trans Support Hub CIC to restrict the processing of your personal data. For example, you may request this if you are contesting the accuracy of personal data held about you.

**Right to Data Portability:** You have the right (under certain circumstances, but not all) to oblige Trans Support Hub CIC to provide you with the personal data about you that you have provided to Trans Support Hub CIC in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format.

**Right to Object to Direct Marketing:** Where your personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data for marketing, which includes profiling to the extent that it is related to such direct marketing.

**Rights in Relation to Automated Decision-Making and Profiling:** Trans Support Hub CIC does not perform any automated decision-making based on personal data that produces legal effects or similarly affects you.

You should note that some of these rights, for example, the right to require us to transfer your data to another service provider or the right to object to automated decision-making, may not apply as they have specific requirements and exemptions which apply to them, and they may not apply to personal information recorded and stored by us. For example, we do not use automated decision-making in relation to your personal data. However, some have no conditions attached, so your right to withdraw consent or object to processing for direct marketing are absolute.
