THE SIMPLE VISION TO DRIVE ALL OUR ACTIVITIES: LOCAL CONTROLLED FOOD, JOBS, AND SHELTER.

FOOD: ESTABLISH A ROBUST LOCAL FOOD PROGRAM

- Grow as much food as you can on your property
- Buy as much of your storebought food from local farm markets, including your meats. Consider taking up hunting
- Organic, GMO-free, fair trade, should be bought as much as possible for any remaining food
- Pressure your town to preserve open space for public farming
- Create weekly and even daily community farmer's markets
- Connect locally grown food to all local schools, nursing homes, small businesses, etc.
- Create workshop series to train gardening and homestead skills
- Demand our state/federal govt enact local food policies only

JOBS: COMMUNITY-FIRST BUSINESS AND WORKER'S COOPERATIVE PROGRAM

- Create community-focused shopping websites: AMAZON STYLE ONLINE SHOPPING SITE FOR INDIVIDUAL TOWNS
- Massively expand the shared office space model
- Promote the sharing economy
- Move past unions/freelance limits to more empowering worker cooperative movement
- Shift our money to local banks and credit unions
- Encourage more people to pursue "real" careers: farmers; green chemists; HVAC; etc, etc

SHELTER: HAPPY, NONTOXIC LIVING ARRANGEMENTS AND COMMUNITIES

It really would only take around 20 dedicated people in each small region of the country to put us on a much healthier shared path and greatly heal our nation. Here is a sample set-up for community-level vanguard leadership teams in towns/regions all over the country

- 2-3 people with some computer skills to start an Amazon-style online shopping site for the community
- 2-3 people with a green thumb to start a weekly and then eventually a daily community farmer's market
- 2-3 people with a passion for writing to start an alternative underground community newsletter
- 2-3 people with knowledge in politics to create stepby-step guidebook for independents to run for office
- 2-3 people with homesteading skills to start workshop series on various self-reliant topics
- 2-3 people with labor skills to develop helpful career guidance and local worker cooperatives
- 2-3 people with housing and zoning expertise to set-up a robust/diverse local housing program
- 2-3 people with eco passion to push green energy, work local efforts, nontoxic chemicals, etc...
