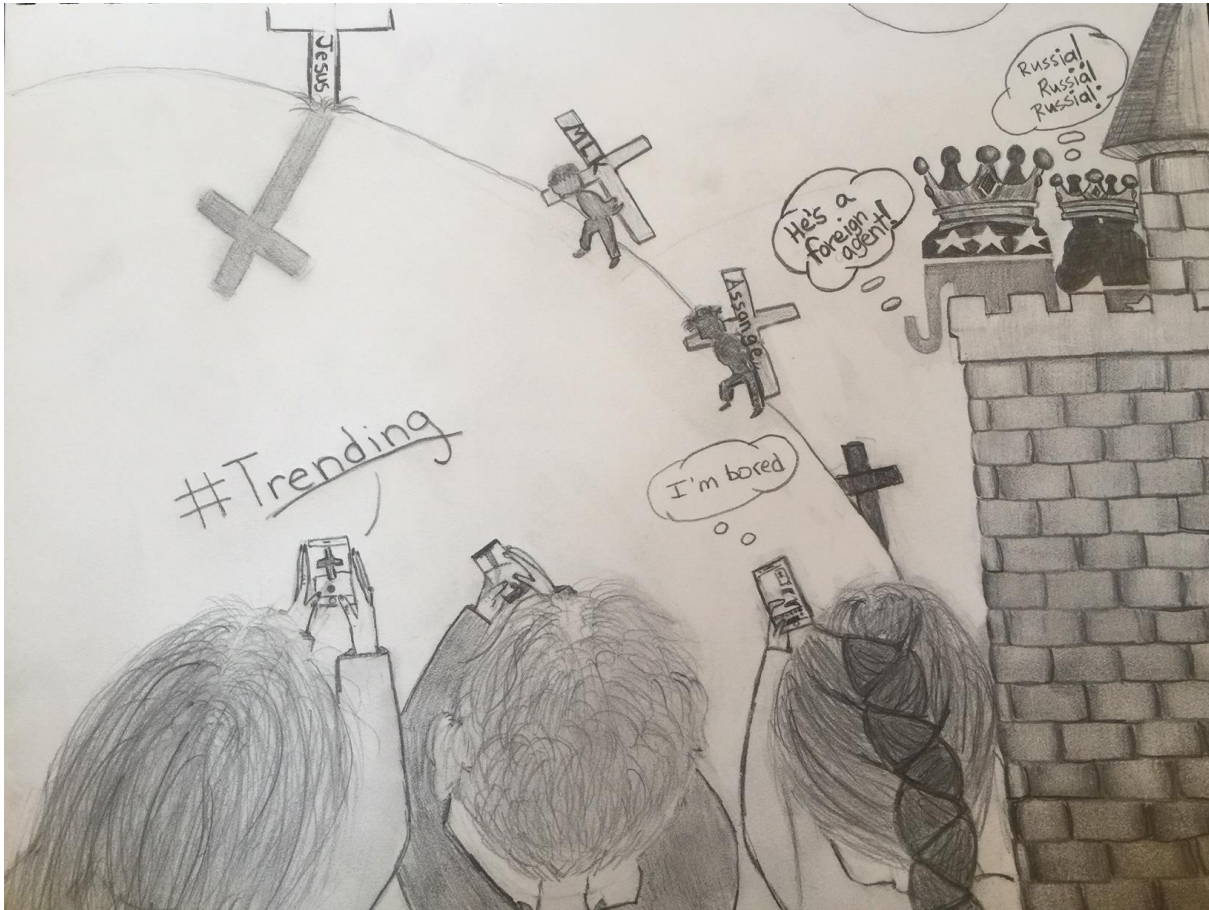

In a matter of a few short months, a small group of dedicated and regular people who had had enough have managed to completely upend the status quo and provide real inspiration and excitement for progressives across the country.

In May of 2020, the ***Reclaim Rhode Island*** movement was launched and a mere four months later, a whole slate of entrenched politicians was swept out of power in the Rhode Island State House and replaced by a diverse group of outsiders. How did they do it? Do yourself a favor and spend some time researching this movement, but in short, the key was that the vanguard leadership of the Reclaim RI movement created a simple and easy-to-follow step-by-step set of instructions for political newcomers to navigate the Rhode Island political process in order to run for office. They were able to quickly leverage each other's experiences and help the whole group come into power in one fell swoop. By the way, in the summer of 2019, the ***Reclaim Amesbury*** effort launched in neighboring Massachusetts. Hmmm, coincidence? It all starts at the local level. All you need is a tiny spark and flicker of real, genuine hope and things can scale up and spread like wildfire. Seemingly random and divergent movements across the country will increasingly build off each other and lift everyone up.

If you look globally, boundless examples exist of communities rising up in completely new ways that will increasingly reverberate back to the United States in a positive way. One fascinating case study is Cheran, Mexico. Cheran is an indigenous community that, unfortunately, has an all too familiar past. It was a community that felt the wrath of organized crime and corrupt politicians and law enforcement. The people were completely taken advantage of, with their resources regularly illegally seized. Things abruptly changed one fateful day in 2011. Sparked by growing outrage over illegal logging by outsiders who were decimating the community, a very small group of women did what they needed to do to block the logging. However, what happened next was the key to making sweeping changes. The women looked behind them and instead of remaining alone to carry on the fight, the entire

community immediately rallied behind them and joined the cause. As a result, not only did the illegal logging permanently end, everything changed, including the sweeping out of the entire corrupt political establishment. The people of the small community of about 20,000 people immediately began establishing an extreme form of self-democratic control, including the complete ban on political parties, which has greatly helped in unifying the population. Together we stand, divided we fall, right? In the almost ten years since the overnight revolution, the people and community of Cheran and their real-life David vs. Goliath story have become an inspiration to the entire world. The town and their new form of community government remains a success story. The key is that the people have stuck together, remained extremely engaged, including very careful planning of every aspect of their town, and have taken personal responsibility for all developments in their community. Full participation and input from all community members is expected.

What is the ultimate point of all this information and point of view in this newsletter series? It's time to bring everything together into an easy-to-digest step-by-step outline of activities needed to reclaim our lives and help put our society onto a path of true healing.

The below newsletter attachments contain a summarized plan of action and solutions from information contained in Issue #4 and Issue #5 of the *Unapologetic Truth*. In short, the Unapologetic Truth strongly endorses local control and development guided by a dedicated vanguard tackling each major pillar of action needed to revitalize our lives and create a better path for future generations. Each community or small region needs only about 20 or so dedicated people. Larger cities would need to be broken down into cohorts. Once real progress is made, the general population will eventually come along and support the effort almost without even knowing it.

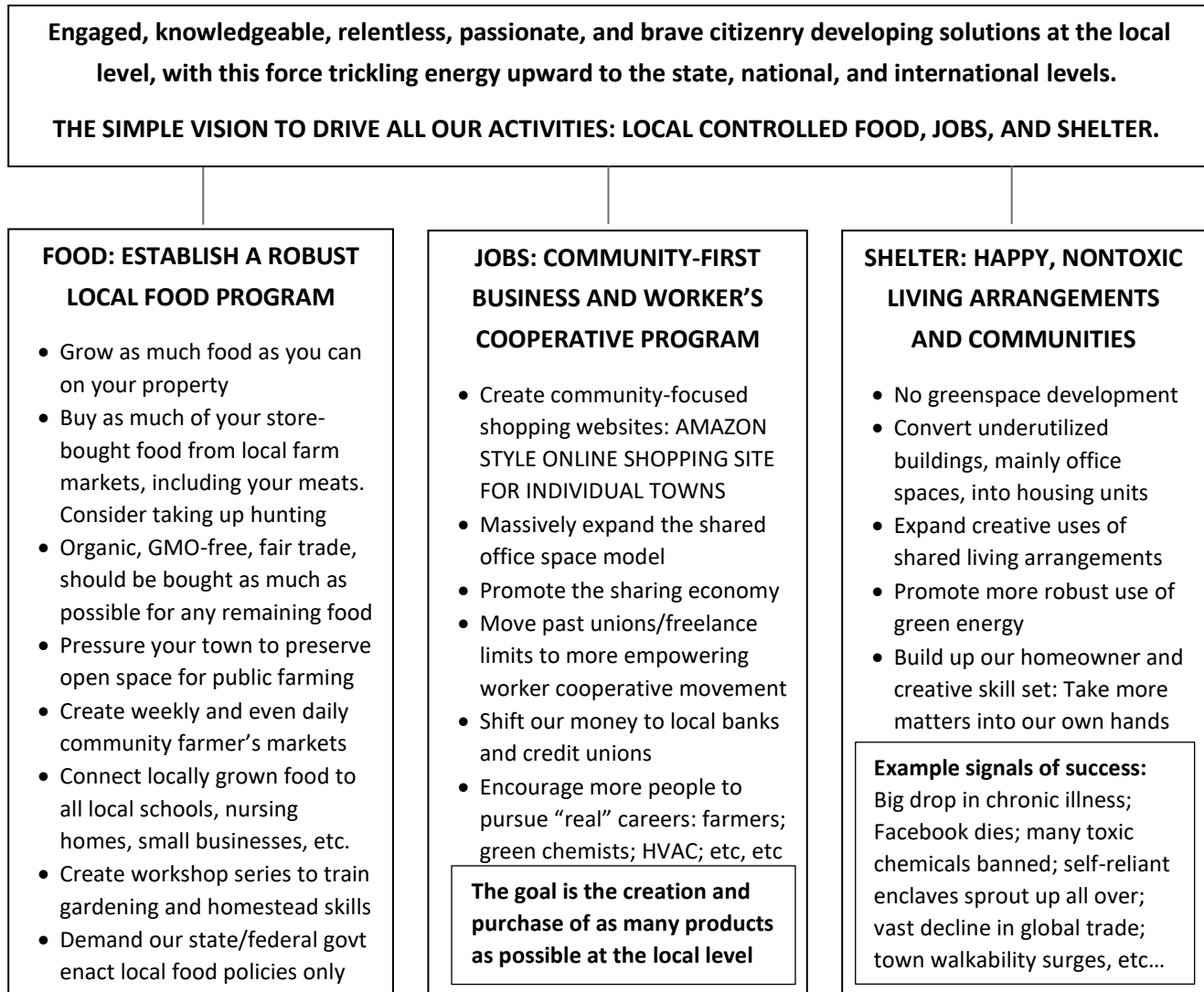

Attachment C: The American Political Spectrum:

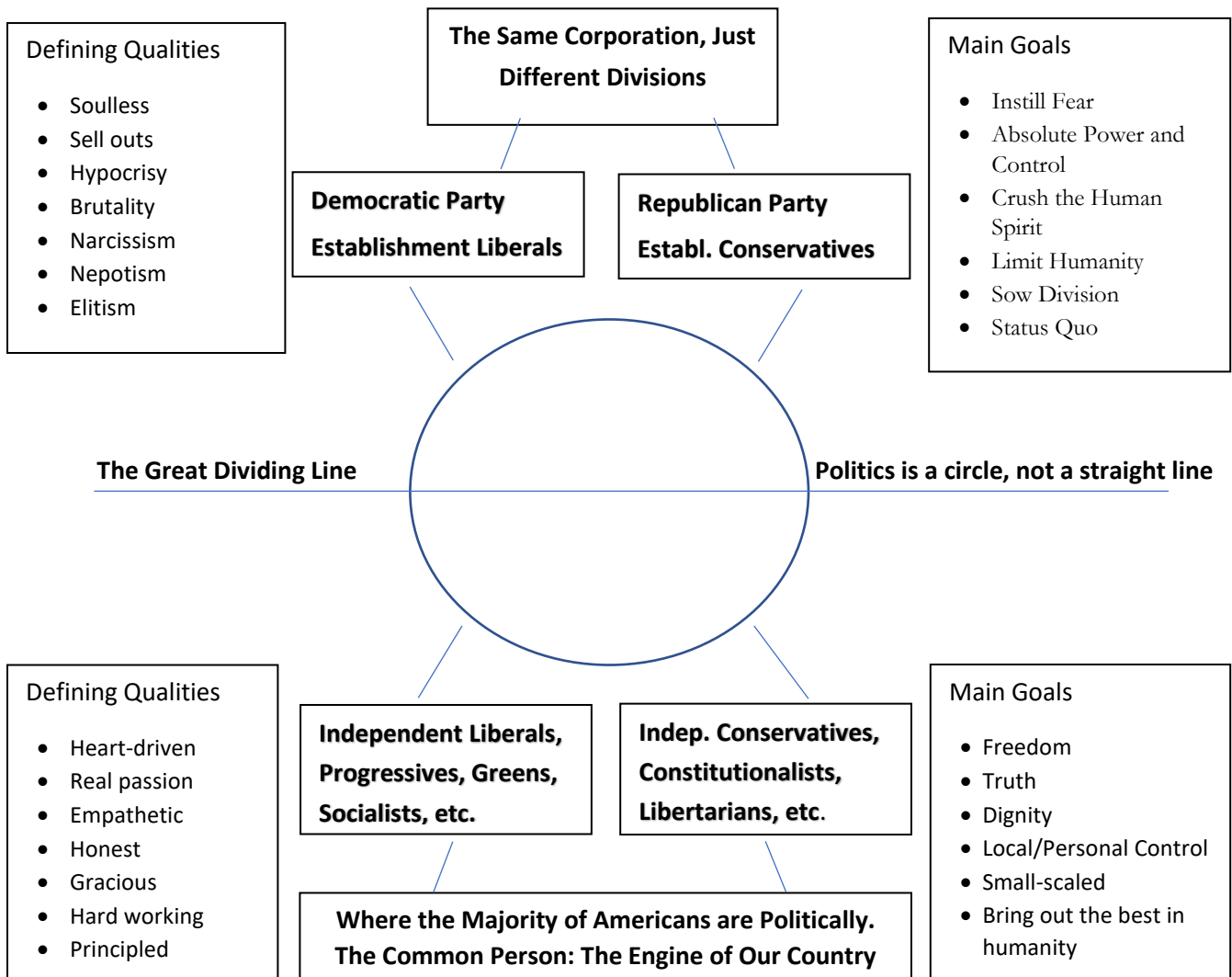
The Big Lie:

The Reality of the Political Spectrum:

No real change is possible via either route, as both parties work in collusion to maintain the status quo and power structure. Your preference depends on whether you'd rather get stabbed more directly in the chest Republican style, or in the back when you turn around from the carefully crafted smile of the Democratic party representative. Either way, it has been a slow bleed for a long time.

There is a reason Trump was elected. People were so fed up with politics as usual that they wanted to send a message, feeling that nothing else had worked to try to shake complacency. I have never voted Republican for president. I voted Democratic once and regretted it almost immediately. It was for Barack Obama's first term.

In a moment of weakness, I bought into the hype. I wanted to believe. This was the establishment's chance. Everything was lined up for real change after the debacle of the Bush presidency and the start of the Great Recession. What a wonderful moment for our country. Our long overdue first black president. Obama and the establishment had every chance. People were clamoring for change. This was the establishment's chance, and they blew it massively. I vowed never to support the establishment and Democratic party again.

One of Obama's clear first actions and signals of his true identity once he was elected, was to surround himself and put into leadership the exact same people and mindset that had put the US and world economy on the brink of complete collapse. And yet here we are once again in 2021 being force fed the same type of politician the country revolted against.

Be careful what you wish for establishment liberals. Now that Trump is out of the White House, replaced by your "safe" candidate, the spotlight will now be back on you. The country will be much less forgiving with Biden than it was with Obama.

We are not nearly as naïve anymore and because the establishment completely failed to address whatsoever the root problems highlighted by the Great Recession 12 years ago, the situation Biden is coming into now is infinitely more combustible than it was when Obama took over for Bush. By kicking the can down the road and pretending we can continue down the same old path, the structural issues are even worse. With Biden now forced on the country, establishment liberals will have nowhere else to run, blame, and hide.

Nevertheless, there is great hope on a broader political level. You can sense it in the air, as a great awakening is taking place regarding the empty rhetoric and games of both party establishments. Still, there is one major key remaining to unlocking the floodgates and taking us out of the current political dark ages into a new enlightened era. Without this understanding, we will continue to spin our wheels and foment additional unnecessary division and hate. Creating division among the masses is the original political game.

It has been drilled in us that politics is a straight line, with moderates, aka, mainstream Democrats and Republicans occupying the middle space. These moderates are supposedly the "adults in the room" who know best. Conveniently for the establishment, this model makes it easy to paint anyone who dares veer a bit further left or right, as "fringe" players who can't be taken seriously because they are too far from that great, rational center. This is THE huge deception that keeps the commoners in check, creates artificial divisions, and ultimately, keeps the tiny ruling class and oppressive mindset in charge.

It is time for a simple visualization exercise to blow this false narrative out of the water. Close your eyes and visualize that straight political line. Now, visualize that

line turning into a circle. What happens? Within the realm of democracy, progressive liberals on the so called far left and conservative libertarians on the so called far right come together. But how can this be? Don't those on the far left and far right have nothing in common? There could be many books written on this, but in short, if you honestly look at all the major issues, those on the far left and far right, by and large want the same ends. Yes, there can be big differences between progressives and libertarians in terms of why and how, but the bottom line is that the so called "far left" and "far right" have much more in common in terms of what end-goals they would like to see occur with society, policies, and democracy than with either of the two establishment political parties.

We now have a globe model of politics, as opposed to a straight line. Add one more element, which is the equator. The Democrat and Republican party controllers are on one side of the globe. Their number one goal is to maintain their power and the status quo by keeping the electorate divided. The policy goals of most people are on the other side of the equator, led by non-moderate so-called radicals, trouble-makers, and outsiders.

This plays out perfectly when bringing this full circle back to the real example of the recent school fight in Amesbury, Massachusetts. Still, you can sit down and see how this plays out in issue after issue at the local, state, national, and international levels. The so called far left progressives would argue most vehemently against the Woodsom Farm school plan for environmental, as well as holistic education reasons. The so-called far right would argue most vehemently against the school plan mainly for tax reasons. The establishment works overtime to bring up the tired old divisions of the left and right and everyone quickly gets engulfed in the usual debates. Sadly, the big picture gets lost in that both progressive liberals and conservative libertarians ultimately want the same thing, which is to reject the overpriced, oversized, and ecologically wasteful school plan. The center Democrat and Republican establishments work together to get the plan to pass, against the commonsense wisdom of the masses.

It should be clear to everyone by now that our country is heading into dangerous territory, something that many outspoken outsiders have been warning about for a long time. We cannot ignore these warnings any longer. We are already living in an active political civil war. Absent a major shake-up in thinking, our country will be further torn apart. The old tricks perpetuated by the elite are not working any more. A new, viable alternative path is a must. One that incorporates all the good people outside the narrow confines of the establishment mindset.

There is zero chance for the kind of changes we need within the modern two-party game, which suffocates any

and all reform efforts. We've been played for a long time. If enough motivated people were willing to see this game and call it out publicly, our prospects for real political reform would instantly improve, as the establishment would crumble when forced to face their lies and games head on. Reformers need to refuse to play the rigged games that have been set up and doggedly stick to the truth and develop alternative visions.



I will never join the Party. Once you taste this mental freedom you know you can never go back. If enough people overcame the artificially created fear and did what was right by walking away from the narcissistic world of the two-party political mind, our personal health, ecosystem and communities would rapidly begin to travel the path to healing. Politics is a circle, not the straight line that divides us. The circle model is the place to find freedom of mind and truth. It is an awesome feeling.

The Great Coming Together

There are many ways to fight for a better world and we must continuously search for the best course of action. What will ultimately not work though, is following the same blueprint as in the past. History does repeat itself, yes, but like animals that learn to adapt to their changing environments, we too must learn to change our tactics in important ways. In other words, we cannot conduct business as usual anymore. New ideas need to be tried, no matter how abnormal they sound.

What is it that people actually crave deep in their bones? I believe it is connections and a purpose in life. Conservative America has traditionally tapped into this deeper yearning brilliantly through their story connecting religion, social order, morals, and individualistic "possibilities" via capitalism. This conservative vision needs to be counterbalanced by an additional narrative that drives humanity to want to create a beautiful and abundant world, centered on the caretaking of our natural surroundings through a small-scale and locally driven cooperative free-market system. The promise of this is a return to a simpler, locally connected lifestyle, putting more control and dignity back in the hands of people. There are many things to like about this narrative for both progressives and libertarians. I have heard the idea of

using the name *Progressive Libertarian Party* for a new people's party, but that sounds a bit clunky. Perhaps **Reclaim Party** for short? **Reclaim** works well because it is a proactive word that could symbolize and represent so many things we need to reclaim in our lives, in our communities, and in the world. It is not about simply demanding and protesting, it is about a proactive vision to reclaim our lives ourselves.

One of the major hurdles is opening people's eyes to the possibility of bringing the independent left and independent right together. Here is my take, arguing for this natural union by first looking at areas of major agreement. Next, I tackle areas that may seem like insurmountable differences, but to me are just issues that need to be looked at from a different perspective.

Independents and third parties across the board need to join forces. This is the only realistic way to be able to provide the needed viable counterforce in modern politics. Viable outsider groups are united almost across the board on major substantive issues. There are some differences on the why and how (the means), but the ends are united (Bottom line goals).

The low hanging fruit, but what big juicy pieces of fruit they are!

Scaling back the military industrial complex: Huge area of agreement right off the top. The money spent and amount of suffering caused by the global arms industry is obscene. As is typical with progressives and libertarians, the end goals are often the same or very similar. The difference frequently lies in how they look at the issue and the arguments used to justify their positions. Nevertheless, the common end goal is there. For this issue, libertarians will focus on the need to scale back government spending and not getting involved in foreign affairs argument, while progressives will point out the humanitarian suffering caused by the overaggressive and hyper-masculine military culture, as well as the opportunity cost of the money spent on arms that could be spent on more positive end uses.

Freedom of speech, assembly, and anti-spying: Fighting the NSA and the general concept of snooping and the constant monitoring of the general population for the purpose of preserving the status quo and maintaining the power structure is another huge, obvious area of agreement.

Anti-global capitalism: While this one seems obvious for the left, certainly libertarians are no proponents of giant corporations either. First, they are recipients of large amounts of corporate welfare. Second, they operate in a monopolistic way, distorting the free movement of information—a big point of contention for the right.

While libertarians are in favor of free trade agreements that encourage genuine competition, they certainly are no fans of the kind that we have now, which grant global corporations unfair advantages over localities.

Criminal Justice Reform: Personal freedoms attractive to both sides here, although the left highlights the inhumane incarceration of non-violent offenders, such as drug users and small-scale sellers more often. Huge government cost savings attractive to the right as well. Certainly, both sides could find much common ground in reforming our criminal justice system to reduce or eliminate sentencing for non-violent offenders and to generally make our system fairer across the board for the poor and people of color. A true libertarian would not be in favor of a racist or punitive criminal justice system. There is great need for reform to bring in some common sense in places such as probate and family courts regarding divorce cases, etc. Everyone is choking on overwhelming levels of contradictory rules and regulations, driven by an army of lawyers and philosophies developed in ivory tower institutions of higher education that bear little resemblance to real-world human nature and conditions. In terms of criminal justice, much is driven by retribution and profit by our increasingly private criminal justice system, as opposed to healing and true reform of individuals.

Abortion, gay rights, and the separation of church and state: There are a number of social issues, centered on fighting religious crusades that both sides agree on. The argument centers on personal freedoms and certainly belongs as a central tenant of a unifying vision.

Corporate welfare and simplifying the tax code: Mentioned above, but worth repeating and creating a separate category, emphasizing the benefits of greatly simplifying our tax codes. Fighting against the granting of unfair tax advantages and other perks for corporations and the elite is an obvious area of agreement for both the independent left and right. The idea of greatly scaling back tax credits and deductions could be a bit of a scary notion for some progressives; however, wealthier individuals and corporations are much more adept at gaming the system and finding loopholes to their benefit.

Education policy: We need to fight our current top-down, test heavy education system by giving teachers and schools additional freedoms to develop more holistic curricula. Bringing back the concept of nurturing well-

rounded citizens, as opposed to churning out drones for the corporate world is at the core of the movement. I believe progressives and libertarians can find much common ground here, based on school district freedom and a much more comprehensive education for our children, which promotes true individuality, risk taking, and the questioning of social and scientific norms.

The nurturing of vibrant local economies: This is the heart and soul center of the overall vision, which is to bring our economy, democracy, and overall lives down to a personal level. The benefits of focusing our energy on creating bottom-up, self-reliant local economies are untold—far beyond just sustainable business and job creation. We need to overhaul the standard way that communities are physically built. In simplistic but easy to vision terms, we need to focus on the pedestrian, as opposed to the automobile. This would have positive impacts not only on our health and safety but promote tighter connections with our neighbors. It would also in subtle, but important ways, encourage the critically needed element of hands-on engagement with our local governments and community groups. This would have a positive snow-ball impact of increased citizen awareness of issues and policies that impact day-to-day lives.

If we truly want to: prevent the total destruction of our global ecosystem; tackle climate change; lessen the polluting of our bodies via the bombardment of toxic chemicals swimming around us; eliminate our totally immoral factory-farm food system; and reduce the sky-high stress levels our global corporate system has brought forth, which has introduced a host of physical and mental ailments; then we must strategically and relentlessly promote the undeniably positive benefits of focusing not only our economic system at the local level, but our democracy on a small scale as well.

So, how can we get the independent left and right to work together on this vibrant local development vision? Simply put, by focusing on how it would greatly enhance our quality of life through the dismantling of power held by the unelected global elites that are running every facet of our lives. Focused information would be much more readily available to the public, with a greater ability for individuals and communities to lead the lives they want.

Universal public healthcare: This may be the biggest problem area for me with strict libertarians, as I am a big supporter of universal public healthcare. However, I believe that not only does our private health insurance system need to be abolished, but our entire medical establishment needs to be overhauled as well. From giant corporate drug companies to a medical system that focuses on ever more treatment, as opposed to the root cause of illness, there is no shortage of ways to tackle not only insurance, but the broader issue of the business of health. Perhaps the independent left and right could focus on improving the overall health of the population, which would drastically reduce the cost of healthcare, and, thus, the overall expense to government. This certainly would be appealing to the independent right.

Welfare and the social safety net: This, I imagine, is at the top of the list for skeptics as well. However, is the end goal for socialists the actual government program, or is it an equitable distribution of assets and opportunity? By working to eliminate the globalized corporate system and putting in its place a democratically driven, small-scale capitalist system that would naturally enhance the power of workers and brighten the spotlight on the actions of business owners, the need for the government safety net, which is in large part taken advantage of by corporations, would be greatly reduced.

Affirmative action: In an ideal world, there would be no need for affirmative action, as there would be true opportunity for all to advance in life. Of course, this is not the case and is something we need to stride for. Certainly, libertarians are opposed to affirmative action programs, but this is a good example of how looking at an issue from a different angle allows groups from seemingly opposite sides to find common ground. Once again, for a progressive, is the ultimate goal to have the affirmative action program in place, or to have a system in place that negates the need for affirmative action in the first place, due to having a much more egalitarian society to begin with? The ideal choice is obvious and is in line with the overall vision of this proposed movement.

Free college tuition: Like healthcare, this is another area that deserves a robust debate that could be viewed from a number of angles. First off, how valuable is preserving a system that focuses not on nurturing strong, independent minds, but rather drones well suited for the corporate working world? In other words, the value of a standard college education is highly debatable and providing free, college tuition would only exacerbate the

problem of the largely empty education that our current system provides. That said, there is no doubt the state should provide for an affordable education. My point is that if we truly want to create a free and equitable society that does not destroy our ecosystem, we need to radically change the way we work, live, eat, and find happiness. This must begin with a solid education system at the core.

The Nanny State (gun laws, child safety laws, soda bans, etc.): The final major area of difference and arguably a bigger hurdle than the social safety net. Perhaps it is impossible for both sides to be able to agree or at least compromise on everything, and this may be the philosophical area that is too different to be able to do that. However, even here, I am optimistic that significant common ground could be found. Once again, it comes back to how we look at the issue.

When it comes to gun ownership, for example, it seems obvious that a leftist would want to significantly reduce their availability or outright ban them, while a libertarian would want zero restrictions. How could we possibly find agreement on this point? Well, I believe that a general shift back to living closer off the land is a central component of this simplifying of lifestyle vision and hunting for food is a legitimate part of helping us move away from the mass consumption of meat from factory farms. I find it difficult to stomach seeing a stereotypical liberal not thinking twice about eating meat from a grocery store, while lecturing a legitimate hunter for food over the morals of their actions.

Instead of bickering on the gun issue at this level, wouldn't we be better off fighting the general global arms trade and our massive military budget? How can the government expect citizens to give up their guns, while our military continues to rain death around the globe, all the while we have an increasingly militarized police force on the Homefront? Once we get a better handle on our hawkish government arms policies, then perhaps we could focus on diminishing the amount of guns in the hands of the citizenry.

When it comes to nanny issues such as soda bans, many of these issues would melt away if we addressed the root cause of our obesity, health, and reckless activity epidemic. Much of our unhealthy ways are perpetuated by heightened levels of stress caused by our callous economic system, as well as the fear-driven life we have allowed ourselves to have imposed on us.

Finally, regarding child safety, there is certainly a place for things such as car seats; however, there is no doubt we have taken things too far with our lawyer-driven, bubble-protective lifestyle we have thrust upon our youth, which is sucking the life out of childhood. I am seeing this firsthand as a father who is trying to let my children live

a free-range life within a sea of nervous nellie and overbearing adults around us.

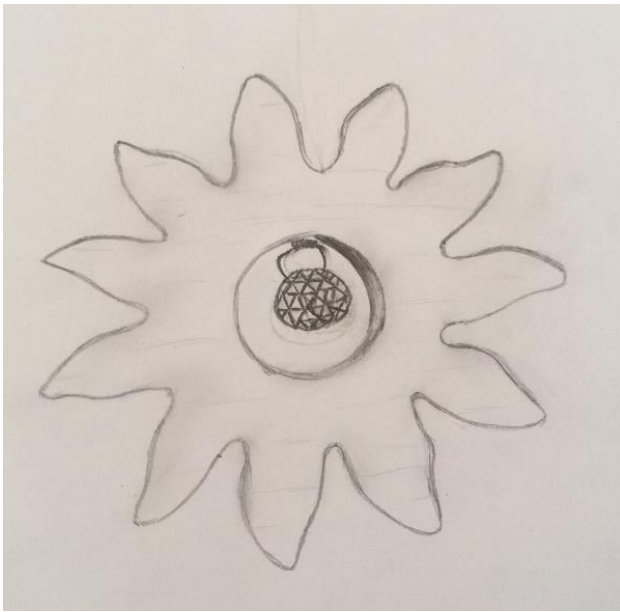
