Before starting taxes, review this list of deductible expenses. Highlight those you had and then begin gathering any receipts or statements that show how much you spent on each category. You can also attach this list to your tax-prep folder and check off items as you add documents.

\bigcirc	Vehicle and mileage Expenses for vehicles that you owned and used for work.	\bigcirc	Meals (50% limit) Includes meals for individual business travel or networking events.
\bigcirc	Home office Expenses for the area of your home you use exclusively for work.	\bigcirc	Legal and professional fees Includes legal or professional fees, bills, or business licenses.
\bigcirc	Communications Includes internet, phone bills, and other tech services.	\bigcirc	Business travel Includes airfare, hotels, and other business travel expenses.
\bigcirc	Assets Larger purchases, usually over \$200, that you'll use for more	\bigcirc	Office expenses Includes furniture, cleaning, shipping costs, and more.
\bigcirc	than a year. Supplies Includes everyday work supplies that you purchase often.	\bigcirc	Meals (100% limit) Includes meals for employees, the public, or meals that are part of a service (like daycare).
\bigcirc	Advertising Money you spent promoting your business.

0	Credit card, loan, and other interest Interest paid on work credit cards and other lines of credit.	\bigcirc	Building or land rental Includes building, land, or space rental for your business. This is rent paid for property used for work only, not for an office in your home.
\bigcirc	Taxes and licenses Includes sales or business tax, and industry licenses.	\bigcirc	Health insurance premiums Can include premiums for you, your spouse, and dependents.
\bigcirc	Business insurance Includes business, retail, and liability coverage.	\bigcirc	Long-term care insurance Can include premiums for you, your spouse, and dependents.
0	Repairs and maintenance Expenses that keep your property and equipment in good condition.	\bigcirc	Mortgage interest Interest paid for property used for work only, not for an office in your home.
\bigcirc	Utilities Includes utility services for your separate office space. Commissions	\bigcirc	Inventory Includes merchandise, raw materials, and finished or unfinished products not yet sold.
	Commissions you paid others who are not employees. Car and equipment rental	\bigcirc	Contract labor Includes subcontractor payments and other contract-labor expenses
