SYNOPSIS

Henry Pearl's rare skin disease has left him hiding from the sun in the shadows of small town BATTLECREEK. His overprotective mother, the local diner and his night time job at the gas station provide him a nocturnal and mundane existence. When a beautiful, yet tormented girl becomes stranded in town, Henry is awakened by love, forcing them both to face their turbulent pasts in light of the future.



Q&A WITH DIRECTOR ALISON EASTWOOD

Were you involved with the film from inception?

Anthea Anka had written the script before we had reconnected. I read it and loved the characters and their journey. It spoke to me from a storyteller's point of view. I have always wanted to do a Southern drama with complex characters.

How did you come on board to the project and why?

Anthea and I grew up together in Carmel. We lost touch for a while and then reconnected. She had seen my first movie Rails and Ties, and told me she was writing screen plays. I told her to send me what she had. I read Battlecreek and loved it.

What did you see in Bill Skarsgård that led to his being cast in the role of "Henry?"

Bill wasn't available when we first approached him. We had already cast all of the other roles and were scrambling to find the right "Henry". I was thrilled when his schedule suddenly changed. He had an innocence and sweetness I thought would be perfect for the role. We spoke on the phone and I knew he was our Henry. He was passionate about the project too. He really understood Henry's struggles.

What does Henry dream about and want from life?

I always saw Henry as a person who was just sleep walking through life because he didn't think he had any other options, same routine every night. His mother didn't encourage him cause she wanted him to stay with her, the town was a dead end. As a loner and an artist, he lived on the peripheral. The outsider looking in. Then Alison shows up and opens up his possibilities. They were drawn together by their mutual wounds, not knowing how much they had in common in different ways. Kindred spirits. I think Henry was looking for a connection.

What made Claire van der Boom the perfect "Alison?"

Claire had just played young Diane Keaton in a film and nailed it. When I saw Claire's audition, she had such soul about her. I didn't care that she was a bit older than the part called for. I knew she was our Alison right away.

Is there a part of Alison Eastwood in this film? Which part?

I think every director puts a huge part of themselves into their films. I'm convinced you shave a year or two off your life span directing a film. I wouldn't have it any other way. Blood, sweat and lots of tears. It's such a labor of love and you feel everything. Good, bad and ugly. It's an incredible job to lead everyone through the process. Fortunately, I had the best film school ever watching my father embrace each person and knowing everyone's job matters.

Tell me about your locations?

We chose Mississippi after looking at a few other Southern states. We felt it still had the raw, untouched feeling we were looking for in a small town. They also welcomed us with open arms.

How long did it take to film the movie?

We had a fairly short shoot at 21 days. When you are doing a true indie film you make it work.

Q&A WITH DIRECTOR ALISON EASTWOOD

What changed from the script when you got behind the lens and started directing?

Things always change when you start shooting. You realize you have limitations (locations, etc.) that the writer didn't intend or foresee so you do the best you can for the story. Lots of improvising.

What was one of the biggest hurdles you overcame in the making of this movie?

Unless you have huge, bankable stars working for no money, it's so hard to put together an indie project. Just finding a financier that believed in us and the project was our biggest hurdle. We almost gave up. Then Connie Hoy, my producing partner found our Executive Producer Michael Wallace of Red River Studios. He was a pleasure to work with, and let us have our creative process

What was the biggest surprise?

I was surprised that we were able to make a small budget indie look like a much bigger budget film. We had such creative people and everyone rallied to put their all into it.

What did you learn from this experience?


I know now that I can not only direct a film but produce a film as well. I really learned all aspects of film making on this project. A trial by fire as I like to call it. I also learned that a good caterer is way more important than you think.

What would you like audiences to take away from this film after seeing it?

Obviously, I hope people can enjoy the film on multiple levels. I still believe that people want to see stories about real human beings and not just super-heroes and Aliens. I hope I captured these characters well enough that people can go on their journey with them till the end. Maybe even wonder what those characters would be doing now, what happened to them. Spark the imagination. Isn't that what storytelling is about?



THE CAST



Bill Skarsgård ("Henry")

reached a whole new level of fame for his terrifying portrayal of Pennywise the Dancing Clown in Stephen King's "IT" this year. He is currently filming another of King's characters in Hulu's "Castlerock" series. He also starred opposite Theo James, Miles Teller and Shailene Woodley in a newly introduced lead role in Robert Schwentke's ALLEGIANT, which is the third installment of the Summit/Lionsgate DIVERGENT franchise. He played opposite Adrien Brody in EMPEROR directed by Lee Tamahori. And, he completed the third and final season of Eli Roth's Netflix/Gaumont hit series. HEMLOCK GROVE. In the series, Bill stars as "Roman Godfrey", the teenage heir to the Godfrey fortune and a seemingly haughty rich kid with a deep dark secret.

In his native country of Sweden, Bill was last seen in SIMON AND THE OAKS, SIMPLE SIMON and BEHIND BLUE SKIES.



Claire van der Boom ("Alison")

is a Logie Award-winning Australian film and tv actress. She is best known for her role as Stella in HBOs THE PACIFIC, and for her recurring role playing the ex-wife of Det. Danny Williams in the 2010 remake of HAWAII FIVE-0. In 2012, Claire was cast in two Off-Broadway world premiere productions of internationally renowned playwrights. She played 'Karen' in David Rabe's An Early History of Fire and took over the role of 'Sally' in the extended season of Sam Shepard's Heartless.

Van der Boom also has an appearance in the film 5 FLIGHTS UP with Morgan Freeman and Diane Keaton. In November 2014, Universal Pictures secured the international distribution rights to the Australian feature LOVE IS NOW, starring Claire and Eamon Farren. She will next be seen in the films CHRONIC and DEAR ELEANOR.


THE CAST



Paula Malcomson ("Tallulah")

has had a diverse career across film, television and stage. She was recently seen reprising her role as Jennifer Lawrence's mother in THE HUNGER GAMES: MOCKINGJAY – PART 2 and had a starring role in the independent film Grass Stains opposite Tye Sheridan. Her film work includes THE GREEN MILE, A.I. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE and TOMBSTONE to name a few, but she is perhaps best known for playing "Trixie" in the critically acclaimed television drama DEADWOOD, and was nominated for a SAG Award® for 'Outstanding Performance by an Ensemble in a Drama Series' in 2007.

Delroy Lindo ("Arthur")

is a Satellite award-winning and Tony and SAG award nominated actor. He rose to prominence in the Spike Lee films MALCOLM X, CROOKLYN and CLOCKERS. He later had supporting roles in GET SHORTY, RANSOM, THE CIDER HOUSE RULES, and two action films with Jet Li, ROMEO MUST DIE and THE ONE. Since 2000 he has appeared in many major film releases including GONE IN 60 SECONDS, HEIST and UP.

Lindo has had numerous starring television roles in the last decade. In 2014, he starred in the NBC drama BELIEVE, and is currently a series regular on ABC's BLOOD AND OIL opposite Don Johnson. He was recently cast in ABC's MARVEL'S MOST WANTED pilot.


THE CAST

He first broke into the film scene when he starred in Screen Gem's THE COVENANT alongside Taylor Kitsch and Steven Strait and was also a lead in MGM/Lakeshore's FEAST OF LOVE with Morgan Freeman and Greg Kinnear. He soon booked a role in Fox Searchlight's Oscar nominated film BLACK SWAN, directed by Darren Aronofsky and IN TIME with Justin Timberlake, Amanda Seyfried and Olivia Wilde. On the television front Toby recurred as a guest star on FOX's THE FINDER alongside Geoff Stults and Michael Clarke Duncan.

Toby has also starred recently in THE SILENT THIEF opposite Frances Fisher, PLAYBACK opposite Christian Slater, and 1 OUT OF 7 opposite Laura Ramsey. Alison Eastwood (Director)

has established herself as an actor, producer, and film director with the feature RAILS AND TIES starring Kevin Bacon and Marcia Gay Harden (Warner Independent Pictures).

Born in Los Angeles and raised in beautiful Carmel, CA, she moved back to LA to study acting after graduating high school. Alison made her film debut at age 11 opposite her father, actor-director Clint Eastwood, in the 1984 thriller TIGHTROPE. She starred on stage in several west coast productions including Woman in Control, followed by classic, The Philadelphia Story as Tracy Lord. She went on to appear in her father's features ABSOLUTE POWER and MIDNIGHT IN THE GARDEN OF GOOD AND EVIL and sang the famed Johnny Mercer tune, "Come Rain Or Come Shine," on the soundtrack. She began to branch out, alternating between leading and supporting roles in such films as BLACK AND WHITE, JUST A LITTLE HARMLESS SEX, NBC's THE SPRING and BREAKFAST OF CHAMPIONS with Bruce Willis. She won kudos for her performance as a pool-shark's girlfriend in POOLHALL JUNKIES opposite

Christopher Walken and Rod Steiger. Alison ventured into film directing in 2007 after finding the powerful script, RAILS AND TIES, and deciding that directing is her ultimate calling even though she has a lot to live up to. A passionate animal advocate, Alison has worked for Nat Geo Wild & is currently working on film/TV projects to help raise awareness for animal welfare.





Connie Hoy (Producer) has worked in the film industry for over twenty- five years.

She began her independent film journey by working under such directors as the Coen Brothers on RAISING ARIZONA, Jim Jarmusch on DEAD MAN and MYSTERY TRAIN, Kathryn Bigelow on NEAR DARK, and co-produced the 2009 documentary THE HEART IS A DRUM MACHINE. In 2010 Connie produced the feature film QUEENS OF COUNTRY starring Lizzy Caplan, Ron Livingston, Joe Lo Truglio & Matt Walsh. Connie was presented with the 1998 Arizona Women in Film "Vision" award for her contributions to the Arizona film community and her directorial debut HACK.



Anthea Anka (Screenwriter)

began her professional writing career in an editorial capacity, working at GQ magazine in London. After several years in magazines, she left GQ to pursue screenwriting full time in Los Angeles. Her first script ACROSS THE POND was optioned by Jerry Weintraub Productions & Warner Brothers Studios. She followed with another project set up with Arnold Kopelson attached to produce and Howard Deutch attached to direct.

In 2014, in addition to BATTLECREEK, she went into production on a second film in London, directed by lan Bonhôte, starring Eleanor Tomlinson, John Hannah and John Lynch.



KRISTIAN DANE LAWING

(Director of Photography) began his career as an Art Director for advertising agencies including Grey, Lowe, and Rapp Collins. Currently based out of Los Angeles, he's proven himself as versatile as he is skilled, Shooting 27 episodes of the James Beard Award-winning show, "Bizarre Foods with Andrew Zimmern" (Travel Channel) and 37 episodes of "What Not To Wear" (TLC) amongst a long and varied list of television programs.

In addition to BATTLECREEK he has also shot PONIES with John Ventimiglia and Kevin Corrigan, THANKSGIVING with Seymour Cassel, as well as the award-winning short, THE LOST CAUSE for Oscar winner, Jim Taylor. His documentary work spans the globe from the streets of Northern Iraq to the projects of Northern New Jersey with films including the Academy Award considered "Quest for Honor," Morgan Spurlock's "Comic Con IV: A Fan's Hope," "The Street Stops Herem" (PBS), "TEA Party America" (BBC) and "Man with a Violin," currently in post production.



Gary Roach, ACE (Editor)

has worked with Clint Eastwood since 1996. Beginning as an apprentice on ABSOLUTE POWER, Roach quickly moved up to Assistant Editor on MIDNIGHT IN THE GARDEN OF GOOD AND EVIL. He continued as an Assistant Editor on TRUE CRIME, SPACE COWBOYS, BLOOD WORK, MYSTIC RIVER, MILLION DOLLAR BABY, FLAGS OF OUR FATHERS, and was nominated for an Oscar with Joel Cox for AMERICAN SNIPER. In between productions for Malpaso, Roach found time to work as an Assistant Editor on CATWOMAN for Warner Bros.



LINETTE SHORR

(Production Designer) has worked in the film industry for over twenty-five years. Her career began with directors Joel and Ethan Coen, Barry Sonnenfeld, Michael Mayer to name a few. For BATTLECREEK, Linette had the opportunity to be involved in the project from previsualization designs to designing the film on location in Mississippi.

In 2010 Linette Production Designed the feature film QUEENS OF COUNTRY starring Lizzy Caplan, Ron Livingston, Joe Lo Truglio and Matt Walsh. In 2012 Shorr was awarded a Telly Award for her work with singer Gretchen Peters. Currently Linette is at work on pre-visualization for her next independent film.



KYLE EASTWOOD

(Composer)Since the release of "From There To Here", Kyle's first album as a leader, the multi-talented double bassist, composer and producer has forged a dynamic musical path. While continuing to develop his career as a composer and arranger on his legendary father Clint's Oscar nominated films MYSTIC RIVER, MILLION DOLLAR BABY, and LETTERS FROM IWO JIMA, Eastwood has reaffirmed traditions while creating truly contemporary, lyrical and melodic jazz. He flirted with electro-jazz cool on "Paris Blue" (2004); delved into 70s-tinged "smooth jazz" accents and grooves on "Now" (2006); and gone "arty" urban chic on "Metropolitan" (2009). Eastwood's latest release "Time Pieces" is all at once a fresh landmark in Eastwood's discography and a culmination of a recent reassessment of his personal and artistic aesthetic that began with the release of "Songs From the Chateau" in 2011. The new phase of his career has involved a quintet of young English musicians: starting with Andrew McCormack (piano), Quentin Collins (trumpet and flugelhorn) and now including Brandon Allen (tenor and soprano sax) and Ernesto Simpson (drums).
