

RHTC Minutes on January 28, 2020

Item #1- Minutes: The minutes from the last meeting were discussed. A motion was made to approve the minutes. It was seconded and the minutes were approved.

Item #2- Finances: Tony reported that the balance is \$5,615.50. RHTC is hoping to get a reimbursement for recent expenses from the city of \$5,000.

- The board agreed that there is enough money to have 2 coaches 1x/month for Thursday & Saturday events
- We need to make a drive to post more information & pictures on website.

- To be held on Saturday May 2nd
- Per person fee not determined yet
- Vision for event was to focus on tennis players and social residents. In previous years we have tried to attract more children with limited success.

A new machine which should be a/c electric not a battery machine would be easier for residents to use and would not need charging like the current broken machine.
