THE EDUCATION PROGRAMME

- BSc (Hons) SPORT AND EXERCISE SCIENCE WITH MANAGEMENT

Awarded by Loughborough University 15 hours of study per week, per academic year for 3 years.

- BENG (Hons) SUSTAINABLE ENGINEERING

Awarded by Loughborough University 15 hours of study per week, per academic year for 3 years.

DESCRIPTION

Students will develop your knowledge and understanding of sports and Exercise Sciences and gain a scientific appreciation of the disciplines that underpin them including physiology, biochemistry, biomechanics, motor control and psychology. The Management module equips the learners with vital skills in marketing, organisational management, and accounting .

The degree will cover all the fundamental principles of mechanical and electrical/ electronic engineering, with each aspect - ranging from fluid mechanics and thermodynamics to power transmission and microcontrollers - being focused on the impact of products, systems and processes on the environment and on making those products (and their manufacture, packaging and distribution) more sustainable.
