

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HOUSING: YOU TAKE THAT UTILITY BILL TO A SOCIAL SERVICE AGENCY LIKE DOUGLASS COMMUNITY SERVICES, NECAC, OR SALVATION ARMY. THEY USE UNITED WAY FUNDS TO COVER THE UNEXPECTED HIGH WATER BILL.





HEALTHCARE: YOU GO TO A SOCIAL SERVICE AGENCY AND THEY HELP YOU APPLY FOR MEDICAID FOR YOUR CHILDREN. YOU AND YOUR SPOUSE RECEIVE FREE, NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AT THE HANNIBAL FREE CLINIC.





FOOD: YOU GO TO A SOCIAL SERVICE AGENCY AND THEY HELP YOU APPLY FOR SNAP BENEFITS. YOU ALSO LEARN ABOUT LOCAL UNITED WAY AFFILIATED FOOD PANTRIES AND HELP YOUR DISABLED PARENTS RECEIVE FOOD FROM A LOCAL SENIOR CENTER.





TRANSPORTATION: REMEMBER THE BLOWN TIRE? YOU GO TO A UNITED WAY SOCIAL SERVICE AGENCY AND EXPLAIN SITUATION AND HOW YOU'RE AT RISK OF LOOSING JOB IF YOU CAN'T GET THERE. THEY USE UNITED WAY FUNDS TO PAY FOR A NEW TIRE.





CHILDCARE: YOU LEARN ABOUT HEAD START, A PROGRAM OF DOUGLASS COMMUNITY SERVICES, AND ENROLL YOUR 4 YEAR OLD. YOU ALSO LEARN ABOUT AFTER SCHOOL CARE AND SUMMER PROGRAMS AT THE YMCA. YOUR FAMILY **QUALIFIES FOR A SCHOLARSHIP** 



SO YOUR 9 YEAR OLD CAN ATTEND.



REMEMBER THE BEDBUGS? YOU HAD TO THROW OUT MANY OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD ITEMS. FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES TOGETHER (FACT) HELPS YOU GET NEW BEDS AND BEDDING THROUGH THEIR UNITED WAY FUNDED HOME RESOURCE PROGRAM.



2,245 seniors receive food and other services at a United Way funded senior center.




