Our scrubbing machines are versatile enough to clean other types of flooring in your home including tile, LVT, carpet, rubber and epoxy finishes.

QUARTZ CARPET CARE INSTRUCTIONS

YOU LOVE IT, KEEP IT LOOKING NEW!

It is vitally important to follow all care instructions outlined in this document to keep your Quartz Carpet floors looking and feeling brand new. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Do not wash the floors for one week following the application. It can take up to 7-10 days for the floors to fully cure.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE TIPS

- Vacuum floors at least once weekly, more in high traffic areas.
- Clean with mop when needed, be sure to rinse thoroughly to prevent any soap/detergent residue build up.
- For spilled liquids, clean immediately with neutral detergent and hot water. Vacuum dirty water immediately or blot small area spills with sponge.
- Use recommended floor scrubbers for more thorough cleaning. See reverse for details, always following the recommended manufacturers operating procedures.

OPEN PORE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Use a vacuum to remove large pieces of dirt and debris.
- Clean Daily with a soft bristle broom.
- Garden blowers may be used to remove dust and debris that may have settled.
- Exterior applications may be hosed down with a low-pressure hose.
- Use a sponge to dab or vacuum to remove wet spills, don't wipe as this will cause spreading and staining.

PORE FILLED CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Clean floor with soft bristle broom or vacuum.
- Mopping may be done with a string mop and a diluted neutral pH cleaner. Be sure to wring thoroughly as to not flood with excess water.
- Scuffs can be removed with excess mop pressure or white scrubbing pad with small amount of soapy water.
- When scrubbing out scuffs be sure to never use brushes with metal, wire or overly abrasive materials.
- Do not use strong cleaning agents or agents with high acidic or alkaline levels as these may strip the sealer.

USEFUL TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR INVESTMENT

- Always clean all spills from the surface immediately.
- Use felt protectors on furniture and workstation mats to prevent damage from furniture legs and desk chairs.
- Use walk-off mats in high traffic areas to collect debris.
- Always clean surrounding walls and joints with natural cleaners prevent damage to floors.
- Always use a natural cleaner that has low acidity or alkaline properties.
- Do not use high pressure washing equipment or nylon grit rotary brushes.
- Never use bleach, ammonia, vinegar, or other cleaners with high acidic or alkaline properties.
- Never use body oils, degreasers, or strippers on the surface.
- Do not place hot objects directly on surface.
- Do not prepare food directly on the surface.
