

Safe Start Training Awareness of First Aid for Mental Health

This course is suitable for everyone within a workplace as it provides learners with the knowledge to identify suspected mental health conditions as well as the skills to start a conversation and be able to signpost a person towards professional help

Course The minimum classroom contact time of 4 hours should be delivered over a minimum of half a day. The course can be spread over a maximum of 2 weeks, ensuring that each session is a minimum of two hours.

Entry Requirements



Age restrictions Learners must be a minimum of 14 years of age upon course commencement.

A Level 1 Award in the Awareness of First Aid for Mental Health will be issued to the learner, subject to successful assessment. The qualification does not have an expiry date, but refresher training and keeping up to date with changes to policies, procedures and new legislation through ongoing CPD is vital.

It is recommended and annual refresher course is completed
